**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Greensboro stunned Brooklyn for the second-consecutive night as SS **Francisco Acuna** hit a go-ahead two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning against LHP **Andrew Edwards** to deliver the Grasshoppers to a second-consecutive come-from-behind victory over Brooklyn 2-1. RHP **Carson Seymour** had one of Brooklyn's most brilliant pitching performances in six years, striking out 11 over 6 2/3 innings in the no-decision. OF **Jaylen Palmer** yanked an RBI double down the left field line in the bottom of the fifth to give Brooklyn an early 1-0 lead.

**DONOVAN IN THE HOUSE:** NBA Superstar Donovan Mitchell Jr. returns to Coney Island tonight to celebrate "What Could Have Been Night." Mitchell Jr., before his basketball career, spent time with his father, Donovan Mitchell Sr., who was the Cyclones hitting coach in 2002, 2004, and 2005. While here, Mitchell Jr. spent time as the bat boy, shagged flies, and took batting practice. Tonight, he is scheduled to throw out a first pitch and the first 2,000 fans will receive a Donovan Mitchell Jr. Bobblehead.

**CARSON COLLECTS 11 Ks:** RHP **Carson Seymour** struck out 11 batters Friday night, becoming the ninth pitcher in Brooklyn Cyclones history to fan 11 batters. It's the first time a Cyclones arm has struck out 11 hitters since 2016 when LHP **Thomas Szapucki** achieved the feat on August 6th at Tri-City. That year, three Cyclones struck out 11 batters between July 23-August 6: RHP **Nabil Crismatt** vs. Aberdeen, RHP **Harol Gonzalez** at Vermont, and LHP **Thomas Szapucki** at Tri-City.

**CON SWAGGER:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** put the team on his back Wednesday afternoon, going 4-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and five RBIs. Consuegra doubled three times for the first time in his career, while he tallied four hits for the second time in his career and five RBIs in a game for

**vs. GREENSBORO:** The Pittsburgh Pirates affiliate comes to Maimonides Park, setting up a match-up with Brooklyn for the first time in team history. Greensboro is in the North Division and hosts three of Pittsburgh's Top 30 prospects including former Mets minor leaguer No. 6 C Endy Rodriguez. He is joined by No. 11 RHP Jared Jones and No. 19 OF Hudson Head. The Grasshoppers play at First National Bank Field in Greensboro, North Carolina.

**NIC KNOWS:** C **Nic Gaddis** has enjoyed a power play stretch at the plate, homering three times in his past 13 games with a .516 slugging percentage. Since June 21, Gaddis has a .434 OBP and a .950 OPS, reaching in 18 of his past 20 games.

**PEROZA POP:** INF **Jose Peroza** has collected 30 total bases in his past 14 games with four doubles, one triple, and three home runs.

**HELP! I NEED SOMEONE:** Brooklyn ranks 118 out of 120 Minor League teams with 316 runs scored and 117 out of 120 teams in batting average (.216) and 114 out of 120 in home runs (48).

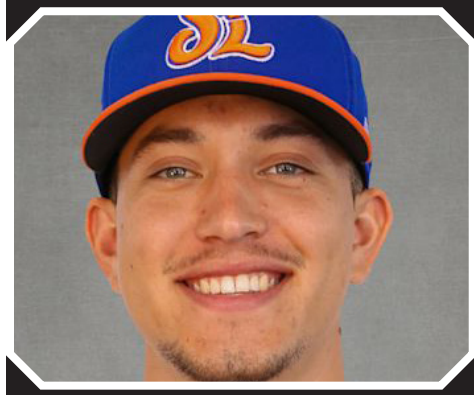
**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs across two games in Coney Island, Brooklyn has turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 41 home runs in the past 51 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**PROSPECT POP:** Brooklyn is home to seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline. Offensively, OF **Alex Ramirez** ranks as the No. 4 prospect along with No. 14 OF **Jaylen Palmer**, No. 19 prospect 1B **JT Schwartz**, and No. 29 prospect INF **Jose Peroza**.

**DOM DEBUT:** Dominic Hamel makes his second start with the Brooklyn Cyclones, facing Greensboro for the first time.

**PROMOTED:** Dominic Hamel, who is the Mets No. 9 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, earned the promotion from Low-A St. Lucie, joining the Cyclones on the Fourth of July.

**ST. LUCIE:** With the Low-A St. Lucie Mets, Hamel made 14 appearances and 13 starts, posting a 3.84 ERA in 63 1/3 innings. Hamel posted a 27% strikeout rate, 11% walk rate, and a 3.91 FIP.

**DOM-INANT JUNE:** Hamel posted a 2.84 ERA in June, making five starts. He struck out 30 and walked 10 in 25 1/3 innings.

**BEGINNINGS:** The Arizona native was drafted by the Mets in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft, signing for \$755,300 and made two appearances for the Florida Complex League Mets.

**COLLEGE DAYS:** Hamel pitched at Dallas Baptist in 2020 and 2021 after two seasons at Yavapai College. At Dallas Baptist in his senior season, Hamel set a school record with 136 strikeouts in 91 2/3 innings.
