TWO LATE HOMERS SPOIL SATURDAY NIGHT FOR FISHER CATS: The Fisher Cats pushed across a pair of runs in the bottom of the sixth inning to take a 3-2 lead, but the Somerset Patriots rallied with three in the eighth to earn a 5-3 win Saturday night at Delta Dental Stadium. Oswaldo Cabrera homered to lead off the top of the eighth to tie the game at 3-3. Hoy Jun Park walked and Dermis Garcia followed with a home run to give Somerset a 5-3 advantage.

MARTIN HAS TWO HITS: Toronto's #2 prospect Austin Martin rolled a single into left field to give the Fisher Cats the game's first run last night in the bottom of the fifth inning. He also had singled in the first to give him his first multi-hit game since opening night.

TAKE ONE FOR THE TEAM: Samad Taylor drew a bases loaded hit-by-pitch to plate a tying run in the bottom of the sixth, one batter after Vinny Capra was hit. Nick Podkul followed with the team's first sacrifice fly for a 3-1 lead. New Hampshire has been 15 times in the season's first 11 games.

EARLY STREAKS: Otto Lopez extended his hit streak to nine games with his first inning single. With a 2-for-4 night, Lopez is hitting .362, sixth best in the league – and second on the team only to lead-leader Gabriel Moreno. Moreno went just 1-5, but is hitting .455, and has an eight-game hit streak to open his career at the Double-A level.

COMING UP: The Fisher Cats welcome the Portland Sea Dogs (Red Sox Double-A affiliate) to Delta Dental Stadium next week. It will be the first of three trips to New Hampshire for the Sea Dogs, who are wrapping up a series in Hartford today. New Hampshire lost five of six at Hadlock Field to open the season.

ROSTER MOVES: May 15: Reliever Curtis Taylor transferred to Triple-A Buffalo yesterday, and reliever Sam Ryan and infielder LJ Talley added from Advanced-A Vancouver.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: May 16, 2018 – The Fisher Cats won 7-1 at Dunkin Donuts Park in Hartford behind Jordan Romano, who improved to 7-0. Cavan Biggio homered in a five-run third to pace, his 12th. Vlad went 4-for-5 with his seventh homer.

FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS: The Blue Jays blanked the Phillies 4-0 last night in Dunedin. Vlad homered again. Travis Bergen earned the win by pitching a scoreless fifth after coming on for Anthony Kay. Triple-A Buffalo topped Rochester 7-3, Vancouver (A+) won 4-2 over Spokane, and Bradenton no-hit Dunedin in a 2-0 win in a game played in Clearwater, Fla.

ON THE HILL: RHP Simeon Woods Richardson and RHP Shawn Semple in a rematch here of the series opener on Tuesday night. Woods Richardson matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in his five innings, allowing only a home run to Thomas Malone. Semple worked into the fifth inning, allowing four runs on four hits.

LAST TIME OUT: Had a second consecutive eight strikeout performance in home opener Tuesday vs. Patriots. Allowed only one hit, a fifth inning solo homer to Thomas Milone, and left with a 5-1 lead. Did not figure in decision in game NH won 6-5.

v. SOMERSET: Started the home opener for Patriots. Is 0-0, 1.80 in 1 career start vs. Somerset

2021: Matched a career-high with eight strikeouts in Double-A debut 5/6 G1 at Portland. Allowed 3 runs (1 earned) in 4.0 IP. Followed that up with another eight strikeouts in home opener vs. Somerset. Allowed only one hit (a HR) in his five innings vs. Patriots.

2019: Didn't miss a start while splitting time with Adv. A Columbia in the Mets system and with the Dunedin Blue Jays after the trade. Went 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in his six starts with Dunedin, with 29 strikeouts in 28.1 IP. Held FSL hitters to a .182 average. Finished the season with a combined 126 strikeouts in 106.2 IP.
