THE SURGE – The Wichita Wind Surge wrap up the six-game series this afternoon against the Arkansas Travelers, Wichita clinched its first winning home series with the win last night and lead four games to one. The Surge lead Tulsa by one game for first place and lead Arkansas by 4 1/2 games. Wichita and Springfield split their six-game series to start this 12 game homestand.

LAST GAME – The Wind Surge got a pair of home-runs from Caleb Hamilton and defeated Arkansas 6-4 on Saturday to win its third in a row.

ONE - The Wind Surge have the most wins in one run games within AA-Central play. (8-4)

DAY BASEBALL – Wichita is 3-1 in day games, all four games have had a rain delay. Arkansas is winless in four day games.

FORE - The Wind Surge have won three in a row four times this season, but have not been able to extend the win streak to four games.

ON THE HILL - Chris Vallimont is set to make his fourth start of the season for the Wind Surge.

GOING DEEP- The Surge matched a season high with a three-home run game last night. The club also got its second multi-home run game and its second game with back to back long-balls. Wichita has 24 home runs, seventh most in the league.

THE ROSTER – The Surge have made several roster moves in the past day activating a pair of pitchers from injured list and adding a pitcher from the development roster. The Twins and Surge lost Dakota Chalmers to a waiver claim to the Chicago Cubs, he will join the Tennessee Smokies.

THE HOMESTAND — The Surge are 30x113 .265 with runners in scoring position in the homestand and are batting .250 (103x369).279.

HOMEFIELD - The team is 10-7 at Riverfront Stadium. The Surge are hitting .259 at home and .264 on the road. The club has a 3.92 ERA at home and a 3.44 road ERA.

THE MIGHTY PEN – The Wind Surge bullpen has now allowed just seven runs in its last 31 1/3 innings pitched, 1.99 ERA. The pen is 15-4 on the season with a 2.63 ERA. Jovani Moran was recently named <u>Twins Daily</u> Minor League relief pitcher of the Month. Calvin Faucher earned the first Wichita save at Riverfront Stadium last night with his 2 1/3 inning effort.

MIRANDA - Infielder Jose Miranda 27 RBI lead the league, his seven home runs is 3rd in the league and his 37 hits is tied for the league lead, and his .322 average is 7th. He has a hit in eight consecutive games and has been hit by a pitch five times this season, third in AA-Central. Named *Twins Daily* Minor League Hitter of the Month for May. He has also started at all of the infield positions, 1b, 2b, 3b, and SS.

JERMAINE- Palacios has reached base in 27 of his 28 games this season, and is 5th best in the league with a .324 batting average. He is 20x48, batting .409 with 2HR and 8RBI in his last ten games. He has reached base in 12 consecutive games.

WALK-OFF CITY - The walk-off win Friday night was its second consecutive and its fourth of the season.

NOTES – Wichita is 4-1 in June, tied for the leagues best record with Midland.... Manager Ramon Borrego picked up career win number 394 last night. Wichita leads the league with a .261 team batting average. The Surge pitchers are second in the lead with 4 shutouts and third with a 3.72 team ERA. Wichita is 6-0 in games that the club has hit at least two home runs.

BALLPARK FACTS AND FIGURES

Riverfront Stadium is a new state-of-the-art venue along the banks of the Arkansas River in historic Delano neighborhood just south of downtown Wichita. The \$90 million stadium was built on the site where Lawrence-Dumont Stadium stood from 1934 to 2018.

The design-build team for the project includes a mix of national and local experts. DLR Group served as designer and baseball specialist; JE Dunn as lead design-builder along with local contractor Eby Construction; local firm PEC provided engineering services; and Wichita-based firm SCJF served as Architect of Record.

The stadium sits on 22 acres and accommodates more than 10,000 fans for a minor league baseball game, including more than 6,000 fixed seats and additional seating in berm, group party decks, and specialty areas for up to 4,000 spectators. Family-friendly amenities will include picnic areas, berm seating, a variety of terraced viewing spaces, and children-focused areas. Scattered throughout the park will be casual gathering spaces that will allow friends to gather and socialize while enjoying the game.

In addition to Wind Surge home games, Riverfront Stadium is a year-round facility designed to accommodate concerts, football, and soccer on the field and weddings and receptions, corporate trade shows, graduations, concerts, and various functions within the facility.

Adjacent to the ballpark will be a new Hall of Fame Museum that highlights the National Baseball Congress history in Wichita. The museum is slated to open in 2022.
