LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn clinched at least a series split with Hudson Valley, thanks to a $7-1$ victory on Friday night...CF Stanley Consuegra clobbered the first grand slam of the season for the Cyclones in the fourth, to give while RF Nick Morabito and DH Wilfredo Lara conjoyed multi-hit ant one hit RHP Douglas Orellana fell one out shy of recording what would have been his first win (or decision) of the season, tossing 4.2 shutout innings with five strikeouts...RHP Jawilme Ramírez took the baton the rest of the way, hurling 4.1 innings of one-run ball en route to the victory.
HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra has been on a tear lately...Brooklyn's all-time leader in extra-base hits (72), home runs (32), and RBI (107) crushed a grand slam in Friday's win over Hudson Valley...Over the
past six games, Consuegra is slashing $.333 / .482 / 857$ with an OPS of 1.339 while launching three home runs and two doubles during that span to go along with five runs and four walks...The 23-year-old is also two hits away (162) from matching OF Alex Ramírez's (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramírez's franchise mark (38)... On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C Francisco Alvarez for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by Ronny Mauricio in 2021.

GRAND SLAM-LEY: CF Stanley Consuegra blasted the Cyclones' firs grand slam of the 2024 season in the fourth inning of Friday night's victory vs. Hudson Valley...The four-RBl blast was the first for Brooklyn in 2024 and the first since DH Omar De Los Santos clubbed one on July 23, 2023, at Hudson Valley...In fact, since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones' three
grand slams have all been drilled against the Renegades. 3B Mateo Gil also grand slams have all been drilled against the Renegades...3B Mateo Gil also
smashed one in Hudson Valley on May 18, 2023...Consuegra's grand slam was the first by Brooklyn at Maimonides Park since CF Jaylen Palmer powered one vs. Aberdeen on June 12, 2022.

NICK THE QUICK: OF Nick Morabito has been as good as any offensiv player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old is second in Mino League Baseball in on-base percentage (.488), fourth in batting average (.364), seventh in stolen bases (23), and 13th in WRC+ (179)...Morabito stole for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years. The McLean, Va native enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 14 games.

DO NOT ENTER: RHP Douglas Orellana lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with $34.0+$ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06), sixth in batting average against (.175), and eighth in WHIP (1.06),.. Baseball among pitchers with $34.0+$ innings of work...Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome, the second dou-ble-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caraças, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out $10+$ hitters in a single game since RHP Robert Colina punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23 -year-old launched two more home runs in Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley...Amongst South Atlantic tied for third in extra-base hits (17), tied for sixth in RBI (24), and tied for ninth in total bases (66)...His 155 wRC+ is also tied for fourth in the circuit...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in extra-base hits (17), tied for third in doubles (9), fourth in slugging (.537) and OPS (.912), and tied for fifth in home runs (6).

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP Kade Morris put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round se while striking Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits his first career win...RHP Jonah Tong tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP Tyler stuart (6.0 IP) and RHP Blade Tidwell (6.0) accomplishe farmhands with 34 feat on July 5 and 6, 2 23, at Wimington....Among (40.2) and seventh in strikeouts (45) and ERA (3.32).

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong earned his first High-A and South At lantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP Jordany Ventura tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP José Butto accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Sin-gle-A...Over his final eight appearances (seven starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP Danny Wilkinson (49) who was second...De La Cruz went $1-2$ with a 4.33 ERA ( 17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB\%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1\%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22 -yearold led the circuit in strikeout rate ( $28.7 \%$ )...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5\%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances ( 19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
