LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn clinched at least a series split with Hudson Valley, thanks to a 7-1 victory on Friday night...CF **Stanley Consuegra** clobbered the first grand slam of the season for the Cyclones in the fourth, to give Brooklyn a 5-0 lead at the time...All nine Cyclones collected at least one hit, while RF **Nick Morabito** and DH **Wilfredo Lara** enjoyed multi-hit contests...RHP **Douglas Orellana** fell one out shy of recording what would have been his first win (or decision) of the season, tossing 4.2 shutout innings with five strikeouts...RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** took the baton the rest of the way, hurling 4.1 innings of one-run ball en route to the victory.

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF **Stanley Consuegra** has been on a tear lately...Brooklyn's all-time leader in extra-base hits (72), home runs (32), and RBI (107) crushed a grand slam in Friday's win over Hudson Valley...Over the past six games, Consuegra is slashing .333/.482/.857 with an OPS of 1.339, while launching three home runs and two doubles during that span to go along with five runs and four walks...The 23-year-old is also two hits away (162) from matching OF **Alex Ramirez's** (164) franchise record for base knocks...He is also four doubles (34) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)... On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

GRAND SLAM-LEY: CF **Stanley Consuegra** blasted the Cyclones' first grand slam of the 2024 season in the fourth inning of Friday night's victory vs. Hudson Valley...The four-RBI blast was the first for Brooklyn in 2024 and the first since DH **Omar De Los Santos** clubbed one on July 23, 2023, at Hudson Valley...In fact, since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones' three grand slams have all been drilled against the Renegades...3B **Mateo Gil** also smashed one in Hudson Valley on May 18, 2023...Consuegra's grand slam was the first by Brooklyn at Maimonides Park since CF **Jaylen Palmer** powered one vs. Aberdeen on June 12, 2022.

NICK THE QUICK: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old is second in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.488), fourth in batting average (.364), seventh in stolen bases (23), and 13th in wRC+ (179)...Morabito stole three bases last Wednesday and did it again last Saturday...That mark is tied for the most by a Cyclone in the previous 23 years...The McLean, Va. native enters the day tied for 10th in the South Atlantic League in stolen bases (12) despite playing just 14 games.

DO NOT ENTER: RHP **Douglas Orellana** lowered his ERA to a minuscule 1.06 in Friday's win over Hudson Valley, spinning 4.2 shutout innings...Among arms with 34.0+ innings of work, Orellana leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (1.06), sixth in batting average against (.175), and eighth in WHIP (1.06)...Orellana's 1.06 ERA (4 ER in 34.0 IP) is the fourth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 34.0+ innings of work...Orellana set a personal and team season-high with 10 strikeouts on May 11 at Rome, the second double-digit strikeout game of his career...The Caracas, Venezuela native punched out a career-high 11 over four frames in Game 2 of a doubleheader for the Florida Complex League Mets on July 14, 2022...Orellana was the first Cyclone to strike out 10+ hitters in a single game since RHP **Robert Colina** punched out 10 in six innings in a win at Greenville on September 2, 2023.

LONG BALL LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched two more home runs in Thursday's loss to Hudson Valley...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, the 2023 draftee is third in slugging (.537) and OPS (.912), tied for third in extra-base hits (17), tied for sixth in RBI (24), and tied for ninth in total bases (66)...His 155 wRC+ is also tied for fourth in the circuit...Among Mets' minor leaguers, Lorusso is tied for second in extra-base hits (17), tied for third in doubles (9), fourth in slugging (.537) and OPS (.912), and tied for fifth in home runs (6).

KADE YOU DIG IT: RHP **Kade Morris** put on a show in his High-A debut on Wednesday afternoon against Hudson Valley...The 2023 third-round selection by the Mets tossed 6.0 innings, giving up only one run on four hits, while striking out seven and walking only one batter, all en route to earning his first career win...RHP **Jonah Tong** tossed 6.2 innings in a win vs. Hudson Valley on Tuesday, marking the first time Brooklyn has received quality starts in consecutive days since RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (6.0) accomplished the feat on July 5 and 6, 2023, at Wilmington...Among Mets' farmhands with 34.0+ innings pitched, Morris is fourth in innings pitched (40.2) and seventh in strikeouts (45) and ERA (3.32).

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on Tuesday, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work was the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn returns home to play a six-game series against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades possess six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (18), INF **Jared Serna** (19), and OF **Jace Avina** (28)...INF **Jorbit Vivas** (15) and INF **Tyler Hardman** (25) have also joined the team this week on Minor League rehab assignments...The Cyclones went 14-10 against Hudson Valley in 2023, including a 6-6 record at Maimonides Park and a 8-4 mark at Heritage Financial Park in Wappingers Falls...Since 2001, Brooklyn is 143-145 all-time (.497) against Hudson Valley in 288 matchups.

run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames...In nine appearances (even starts) between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the 20-year-old is 2-0 with a 0.95 ERA (4 ER in 38.0 IP)...Tong is second among qualifiers in Minor League Baseball in ERA (0.95)...Only Arizona's LHP **Spencer Giesting** (0.66) at High-A Hillsboro has a lower mark...The Markham, Ont. native is fifth among qualifiers in MiLB in strikeout rate (38.3%) and his strikeout-to-walk rate (28.6%) is eighth...Tong's 59 strikeouts are tied for 11th-most in the minors.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.79...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.58 runs better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.37)...That ERA is also second at the High-A level and sixth among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.27).

MAIMONIDES MAGIC: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 15-7 record at Maimonides Park, but an 8-13 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn holds the ninth-best home ERA (2.58) in Minor League Baseball...Chicago AL's Double-A Birmingham (2.01) has the lowest mark in MiLB...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 4.70.

WALK ON THE WILD SIDE: The Cyclones' offense worked a season-high 12 walks in last Saturday's win over Bowling Green...Brooklyn's previous season-high was 11 on April 21 at Jersey Shore and April 24 vs. Wilmington...Saturday's 12 free passes tied the Cyclones' franchise record...Brooklyn also coaxed 12 team walks on April 7, 2023, vs. Jersey Shore and on August 11, 2016, vs. Vermont...Individually, INF **William Lugo** has accumulated walks in droves in 2024...Lugo's 35 free passes are the second most in the league...Lugo's 21.7% walk rate is also second in the league and fifth in Minor League Baseball.

AND THEY'RE OFF! Brooklyn swiped a season-high seven bases in last Saturday's triumph at Bowling Green...LF **Omar De Los Santos** and RF **Nick Morabito** each stole three bases, while CF **Stanley Consuegra** added a single swipe...The Cyclones' previous season-best was four on three occasions, most recently on May 8 at Rome...Brooklyn fell one stolen bag shy of matching the franchise record of eight set on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...DH **Walter Rasquin** and RF **José Miguel Medina** each stole three bases in that affair, while 2B **Edgardo Fermin** and CF **Quinn Brodey** snatched the other two...The seven steals were the most in a game for the Cyclones since they also stole seven bases on August 15, 2018, vs. Vermont.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,005-848 (.542) in 1,853 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 207-217 (.488) in 424 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 53 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.57 ERA (24 ER in 84.0 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 21 and striking out 72.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his second win of the season last Saturday night at Bowling Green...Permitted one run on four hits over a season-high-tying 5.0 innings...Walked a season-high four and struck out four...Tossed a season-high 94 pitches and 57 strikes (60.6%)...Relieved by RHP **Jeffrey Colón** to start the bottom of the sixth inning with the Cyclones leading 9-1...Brooklyn went on to win, 9-4, snapping a season-long five-game losing streak.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

LEAGUE LEADERBOARD: Entering Saturday's contest, the 22-year-old is tied for eighth in the South Atlantic League in ERA (3.15)...Among Mets' minor leaguers with at least 34.0 innings of work, De La Cruz's 3.15 ERA is sixth-lowest.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A...Over his final eight appearances (seven starts), De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
