#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN:** After dropping three of four to Clearwater last weekend, Bradenton is off to a 17-19 start in the second half, currently 1.5 games behind the Threshers and 1.0 game behind Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 31 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After taking two of three from the Mighty Mussels last week, they have secured the season-series win which gives them the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders don't have the head-to-head advantage with Clearwater.

**TEJADA TOES THE RUBBER:** Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game one of the series for his team-leading 19th start. Over a career-best 70 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.11ERA and completed five innings or more five times. Last Wednesday vs Fort Myers, Tejada tossed four frames of two-run ball while walking a career-high out six hitters. Despite command struggles, the right hander navigated traffic well, and completed his outing mainting a tie score. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.189 ERA). Before his last two starts, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he hasaveraged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9

good for his hardest pitch of the season. 13 of his 14 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-36 against it (.111). His splitter has also surrendered just six hits this season (.182) and has generated a 41.1 percent whiff rate.

TONY TATORS: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. demolished his first two Single-A homers last week. On Wednesday night, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A this season, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. He also demolished a walk-off three-run homer on Saturday that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MilB this season. Only five batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (3) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (2) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 83 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second in Class-A (San Jose - California League, 89). 129 of their 462 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.9%). They're 30-23 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-29 when not homering at all. They've seen four players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino)

**BURNING THE BASE PATHS: Yordany De Los Santos** stole his 40th stolen base of the season on Friday, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). In the process, he passed **Jesus Castillo** (2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. He ranks first in the Florida State League and seventh in Single-A. Moreover, he sits only behind **Konnor Griffin** (44) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilB history. The two are approaching **Rich Thompson** for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer when he stole 58 in 2005 between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School in California (0.39 ERA/53.1IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider. Other notable selections included C Easton Carmichael (3rd Rd., Oklahoma), SS Gustavo Melendez (4th Rd., HS) and 1B Jared Jones (9th Rd., LSU) among others.

Right hander **Clevari Tejada** will toe to rubber for the Marauders in game one of the series for his team-leading 19th start. Over a career-best 70 innings this season, Tejada has pitched to a 4.11 ERA and completed five innings or more five times. Last Wednesday vs Fort Myers, Tejada tossed four frames of two-run ball while walking a career-high out six hitters. Despite command struggles, the right hander navigated traffic well, and completed his outing mainting a tie score. Over his five outings in July, Tejada was dominant, allowing just four earned runs over 19 innings of work (1.189 ERA). Before his last two starts, he has tossed 12 innings without allowing a run to begin the month. Tejada's fastball saw a major uptick in velocity in July, as he hasaveraged 94.9 miles per hour and topped out at 96.9 -

good for his hardest pitch of the season. 13 of his 14 hardest thrown pitches this year have come during his last five outings. Tejada's slider has been a plus offering to both left-and-right-handed hitters, as opposing batters at just 4-for-36 against it (.111). His splitter has also surrendered just six hits this season (.182) and has generated a 41.1 percent whiff rate.
