♦ Everything was working for the Reno Aces in a dominant 9-2 victory over the Albuquerque Isotopes in Tuesday's series opener... **Logan Allen** collected his sixth win of the campaign after limiting the Isotopes to two runs across six solid frames, walking four, and punching out three. The southpaw has posted a 5.45 ERA in the second half, good for 10th in the Pacific Coast League... **Tim Tawa** continued to mash, belting a 445-foot home run into deep center field in the second inning. The 25-year-old has been red-hot since his promotion to Triple-A Reno, leading the PCL in HR (10), hits (34), extra-base hits (19), and total bases (74) while tying with Las Vegas's Logan Davidson for first in RBI (24)... **Adrian Del Castillo** made his return to the Aces lineup after recently completing his first MLB stint with the Arizona Diamondbacks. The backstop made an immediate impact, launching his 25th big fly into right-center field for a two-run shot in the third inning. Despite not playing with Reno since August 7, Del Castillo still leads the PCL in extra-base hits (64), SLG (.612), and OPS (1.013)... The Aces will drive this momentum into Wednesday's matchup against the Albuquerque Isotopes, with the first pitch scheduled for 6:35 p.m. PT.
♦ Reno leads Triple-A in AVG (.286), and Hits (1441)... 2nd in Total-Bases (2390), Runs (881), and RBI (844)... 2nd least amount of strikeouts (1094).
♥ This is the 8th of 12 matchups between the two clubs this season... Albuquerque took the first series, coming out on top in four out of six matchups.

He struggled in his last outing, allowing seven runs on eleven hits in four innings against Sugar Land, walking two with just one punchout... Kauffmann has reached 5.0+ innings just three times since the beginning of July... The 27-year-old owns an 8.95 ERA with 70 strikeouts and 72 walks in 124 2/3 innings of work heading into the matchup.

♦ **Humberto Castellanos** is ready to make his 20th start (21st appearance) in Thursday's matchup against Albuquerque... The right-hander was dominant in his lone outing vs the Isotopes this season, surrendering just one run across seven frames, walking three, and punching out five. It was his longest outing of the season... He was solid in his previous performance, collecting his fifth quality start of the campaign after limiting the Sugar Land Space Cowboys to two runs in six innings with one walk and seven strikeouts... Over his last eight appearances, Castellanos has posted a 2.47 ERA with 33 strikeouts and 10 walks in 43 2/3 innings... He owns a 3.84 ERA with a 94:37 K: BB in 98 1/3 frames this season.
