**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** The Vancouver Canadians ended a season-high five game losing streak with a dominant 10-5 win over the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Friday night that featured 17 hits and six scoreless innings from the pitching staff.

Rafael Lantigua got the scoring started on the fifth pitch of the game when he tattooed his fourth home run of the season - and second in as many nights - to make it 1-0 Vancouver, but the 'Sox managed to take the lead with two runs on four hits in the bottom of the inning.

After a scoreless second, the C's went in front for good with two runs in the top of the second. Tanner Morris doubled and went to third on a wild pitch before a Sebastian Espino walk then scored on another errant toss to the plate to tie the game. Luis De Los Santos doubled home the go-ahead run later in the frame to make it 3-2 C's.

A three-run fourth scored the eventual game-winning run. Vancouver sent eight men to the plate and scored their three runs with four hits. Phil Clarke singled then Davis Schneider doubled before a throwing error brought in the first run of the stanza. Morris singled home a pair in next at-bat to put the Canadians up 6-2.

Everett scored a run in the fourth but the C's got it back in the fifth. DJ Neal led off with a triple and Eric Rivera plated him with a base hit to centerfield. The Frogs would get two more in the bottom of the inning but reliever Cobi Johnson (W, 1-1) escaped the jam with an inning-ending strikeout on a 3-2 pitch to leave the bases loaded and keep Vancouver in front.

Morris slugged the second home run of the game and his second of the year to start the sixth and the C's added two more in the eighth on a Lantigua double, an Espino RBI single and a wild pitch/fly ball out/passed ball combination that completed the scoring.

Parker Caracci and Roither Hernandez combined on four shutout innings of relief to secure the 10-5 win and not only end the Canadians' losing stretch but also snap Everett's seven-game winning streak.

Vancouver's 17 hits were one shy of their single-game season high. Lantigua and Morris both finished a triple shy of the cycle, the first time two C's have come a hit short of accomplishing the feat in the same game. The former scored thrice and drove in two while the latter plated three and scored twice. De Los Santos finished with three hits and extended his hitting streak to a team-best nine consecutive games.

**FEELING FUNKO-Y:** The Canadians arrive in Everett this week for their first of three visits to Funko Field this season. These two teams have already seen each other twice and split the first 12 games with six wins apiece, though the 'Sox have outscored the C's 72-51 in those games.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

**ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY:** July 3, 2015 - Vancouver used a four-run eighth inning to beat Spokane 10-6 at Nat Bailey Stadium. Doubles by Earl Burl III and Lane Thomas plus a single from Juan Kelly brought in the runs that put the C's ahead for good. Thomas was the hero of the day; he went 3-for-5, finished a triple shy of the cycle, scored thrice and drove in a career-high six RBI.

**BASES, TOTALLY:** Vancouver racked up 30 total bases in yesterday's win, the most they've logged in a single game this season.

**EXTRA EXTRA:** The C's five doubles yesterday were their most they've slugged in a game this year and their eight extra base hits (five doubles, a triple and two home runs) is also a new single-game best.

**OF THE SAINTS:** Luis De Los Santos is in the midst of one of the finest stretches of the season for any C's hitter. He has set a new team high with a hit in nine straight games where he's 16-for-38 (.421) with three home runs, five doubles, 111 RBI and six runs scored. His 38 RBI are the second most in the High-A West.

**LANTI LONGBALL:** Rafael Lantigua has powered up against the AquaSox in recent weeks. His four home runs this year have come in his last five games against Everett and he's gone deep in back-to-back games. Lantigua's leadoff homer yesterday was the first since Tanner Kirwer did so on May 18 at Hillsboro.

**ON THE HILL:** Right-hander Brian Rapp is on the bump for Vancouver for his third start in the Blue Jays organization. He was signed out of independent ball at the end of last month and made his debut on June 22 in Eugene, where he went five innings and allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts but took the tough-luck loss. He labored through 111-degree heat at PK Park in his second turn on June 27, when he lasted three innings and surrendered five runs on five hits with three free passes and two K's. Rapp, 25, was originally drafted by Minnesota in the 26<sup>th</sup> round (784<sup>th</sup> overall) of the 2018 draft out of Boston College. He last pitched in affiliated baseball in 2019, when he went 5-1 with a 5.62 ERA in 33 games (three starts) for Low-A Cedar Rapids. He's from Mendham, NJ.

The 20<sup>th</sup> overall pick in the 2019 draft and Seattle's #4 prospect George Kirby gets the ball for Everett. In his last start on June 26 at Tri-City, the right-hander allowed four runs (two earned) on six hits in six innings of work; that night he walked one and struck out a season-high nine Dust Devils. Kirby, 23, was beat up by Vancouver on June 20 in Hillsboro when he allowed season highs in runs (six), earned runs (4) and hits (9) and matched a season low with only three strikeouts. He's from Rye, NY and went to Elon.
