LAST GAME

Due to the Sunday rainout at Delmarva, the last game Lynchburg played was on Saturday. A four run 4th from Lynchburg in that game did the heavy lifting as the 'Cats were able to narrowly escape with the weekend win by a final of 5-4.

'CATS AND NATS IN 2025

Overall, Lynchburg owned the 2025 regular season series over Fredericksburg 13-8. Both teams had the advantage at home with Lynchburg going 9-4 at the Bank of the James while the Nats owned an even 4-4 mark in Fredericksburg.

TALE OF TWO TEAMS

The 'Cats were a very different team in the two separate halves of the 2025 season. In the first half Lynchburg held a league best 41-25 record. In the second half, the 'Cats held a mediocre record of 29-34, while going an even 5-5 over their last 10.

BEEN A WHILE

Lynchburg has not been playing post-season baseball since the 2022 season. Interestingly enough, that Carolina League North Championship matchup was the Nats versus the 'Cats as well. The 'Cats won that series in a nailbiting 3 game set.

OAKIE VS SULLIVAN

Joey Oakie and Liam Sullivan both pitched against their playoff opponents and each other on 8/28. Joey Oakie went for 5 no hit innings and struck out 11 in that game. While Sullivan got the boot after 4 innings, allowing 3 runs and taking the loss.

MEET THE STAFF

HILLCATS MANAGER JORDAN SMITH



Jordan Smith will enter his third year as the head skipper of the 'Cats. In 2024, he led the team to a 67-62 record, finishing second in the first half and fourth overall in the Carolina League North Division. In 2023, he finished 67-64, third in the division.

A native of Wilmar, Minnesota, Smith's coaching experience began following the conclusion of his playing career, of which he spent its entirety in the Cleveland Guardians organization. He began his coaching career in 2019 as the bench coach of the Lake County Captains, where he returned to the same role in 2021. His first managerial position was with the 'Cats and he has stuck around in the Hill City ever since.

BENCH COACH ERLIN CERDA

Cerda will enter year two of his stint in Lynchburg, serving as the bench coach under Smith in 2024. A native of the Dominican Republic, he transitioned from a player to a coach in 2023, in the same position with Cleveland's complex league team.
