#### Leading Off

Reading continues this week's series in Hartford with game three tonight. The R-Phils hold a 11-9 edge in the season series (6-2 at Hartford).

#### Powered to a Victor

Four home runs, including two from Oliver Dunn led Reading to a 8-4 win over Hartofrd last night. Five R-Phils releivers combined to hold Hartford to just two runs, featruing three-shutout innings from Adam Leverett. Madison Stokes scored three runs, while Jhailyn Ortiz and Baron Radcliff homered. Dunn and Ortiz went back-to-back in the fifth, marking the fifth time Reading has done that this season.

#### Pedrique Closing in on 1K

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just five wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (41).

#### Dunn's Nigh

It was a career-night for Oliver Dunn. His two home runs matched a season and career-high, with the other coming June 16 vs Hartford. He also had three extra-base hits, which matched a season and career best. The prior coming July 14 against Portland. Dunn set a career high with five RBI last night as well. That matched a season-high for RBI in a game by an R-Phils player. Dunn's two homers was also the sixth multi-homer game this season by an R-Phil. Dunn now ranks in the top-10 in the Eastern League in AVG, OBP, SLG, OPS, RBI, BB, amongst others.

#### McGarry's Month

Tonight's starter Griff McGarry was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Month on Thursday. The Phillies No. 4 Prospect made four starts in July, going 1-1 with a 2.01 ERA. He went six-innings on July 16, allowing just one run with nine strikeouts against Portland. Then, on July 21 at Altoona, McGarry twirrels seven-shutout innings, allowing just three hits and striking out a season-high ten batters.

#### Winning Formula

With last night's 8-2 win, Reading improves to 28-16 on the season when scoring more than five runs in a game. That record is an astonding 18-3 when on the road. Additionally, Reading is now 34-15 this season when outhitting opponents, and that record sits at 21-6 when the R-Phils accomplish the feat away from FirstEnergy Stadium.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Marlins in extra innings last night and finish their series this afternoon. Lehigh Valley fell to Buffalo 6-3 as Tyler Phillips went four innings in his first triple-A start within the Phillies organization. Jersey Shore fell to Brookyln 5-3 Gabriel Ricones Jr homered. Clearwater lost 10-6 to Lakeland as Justin Crawford singled and doubled and drove in two runs.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

#### **Hey Hartford**

Hartford enters tonight with a 12-15 second-half record, and are 41-53 overall in 2023. Last week, the Yard Goats took three-of five from New Hampshire. Next week, Hartford heads north for a series ar Portland. Hunter Goodman leads Hartford with 25 home runs, which is a new Yard Goats' single season record for home runs. Hartford ranks 11th in the Eastern League with a .231 average, and sit last with a 5.55 ERA.

#### Goats Pitcher

Lefty Joe Rock gets the start tonight for Hartford. It is just the 12th time this season Reading faces a left-handed starter, holding a 5-6 record in the previous matchups. It's the second start Rock is making against Reading in 2023, as he suffered the loss over 5.1 innings on June 15 (11 H, 3 ER, 3 SO). Overall, Rock is 1-6 with a 4.96 ERA across 12 starts this year (52.2 IP, 49 H, 26 BB, 57 SO). Rock last threw on July 27 at New Hampshire, allowing five runs on six hits in a no decision, with two walks and five strikeouts. Rock split 2022 between high-A Spokane and Hartford and made four appearences in 2021 in the Rockie Rookie League. Rock was also on the injured list from Apr. 14 to May 24. He was drafted by the Rockie in the Competitive Balance Round of the 2021 Draft out of Ohio, where he was a First Team All-MAC Selection in 2021.
