LAST GAME

The Baysox fell back into the loss column on Saturday night, dropping the fifth game of their series with Hartford 4-3. Each side relied on home runs early, as Hartford used three solo home runs, including two by Ezequiel Tovar, while Bowie got their offense from a two-run home run by Maverick Handley, and a solo shot to center field by Shayne Fontana. Garret Stallings spun six innings in a quality start, striking out seven batters and not surrendering any walks. Hartford broke the 3-3 tie in the eighth inning by capitalizing on one of three Bowie errors, scoring an unearned run the proved to be the difference maker.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Hartford and Bowie have settled to some very similar numbers over the first six weeks of the season. Entering the series, both teams have scored exactly 155 runs, while Bowie does have a slightly higher ERA, compared to Hartford's 4.40. Hartford has relied plenty on their speed, as they lead the league with 62 stolen bases, despite only having two players with double-digit steals so far this year. Hartford has had to coast on their early offense this season, as their starting pitchers have the third-highest ERA in the league, while their bullpen arms have the second-lowest ERA in the league.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Noah Davis, a top Rockies prospect and member of the Colorado 40-man roster, had been off to a tough start to the season, but spun seven strong innings against Bowie in the first game of this series. While he did go 3-1 with a 3.60 ERA in six starts with Hartford at the tail end of 2021, his seven starts in 2022 have lead to an 1-3 record with a 6.89 ERA. While he has allowed multiple home runs in three separate starts, including two to Gunnar Henderson on Tuesday, the issue for Davis has been in the walks in the past. Over his last three starts, Davis has walked 12 batters, while striking out only 11. Traded to Colorado from Cincinnati, Davis features a mid-90s fastball, a high-80s slider, as well as a curveball and a chanegup.

SUGAR SHAYNE

Bowie outfielder Shayne Fontana has broken through for consistent contact at the plate after a slow start to 2022. While Fontana did open the year on an 0-for-11 stretch, things turned around halfway through April. Since April 17th, Fontana is hitting 25-for-74 (.338) at the plate with three doubles, four home runs, 13 RBI, and 16 runs scored. Over the span, Fontana has drawn 16 walks, and only struck out 20 times. In a span from 5/10-5/20, Fontana drew a walk in 10-consecutive games, the longest streak in the Eastern League, and tied for the longest streak in all of baseball.

SLIM MARGINS

Bowie had an early handle on one-run games this season, as they opened the season at an even 3-3 in games decided by one run. However, since the start of their first full series in May, the Baysox have been on the wrong end of six-of-seven one-run games. Bowie is 4-9 in one run games in total, the lowest winning percentage in the Eastern League, while tied for the third most games decided by one run in the league this season.

POWER PACKED

Bowie has been relying on their home runs recently. In their last seven games, Bowie has scored 15 of their 29 runs on home runs. Bowie has scored about 35% of their runs on home runs this season, sitting in the middle of the league.

THE UPPER HALL

Following a stint on the Injured List that lasted just over two weeks, outfielder Adam Hall has returned to his normal spot at the top of the Baysox lineup. After batting sixth on Opening Day, Hall took over the top spot of the lineup, and lead the Eastern League with eight hits at the start of an inning before he hit the IL Hall is ranked as the Orioles #28 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #27 according to Baseball America. Also listed as the fastest baserunner in the organization by Baseball America.

Garrett Stallings, Bowie Starter and Watson's Throwing Partner: "He's put a ton of work on this offseason. Moving better, a lot more aware of his body. Honestly, I think he's just out there not thinking too much. When a pitcher is in a groove, the gears start turning. He's the most electric guy on the team right now, and he's trying extremely hard to get better, and that's a dangerous combination."
