

Κ 3 The Baysox won their fifth-consecutive game on Saturday night, with a 6-2 triumph over the Erie SeaWolves. It was another fast start for Bowie, who pushed three runs across against Erie right-hander Wilmer Flores in the top of the first inning via a Cesar Prieto sacrifice fly, a John Rhodes RBI triple, and a Shayne Fontana RBI infield single. Right-hander Peter Van Loon had his best start of the season for the Baysox. Though he only went 3.2 innings, Van Loon only allowed two runs, one of which were earned on a solo home run to Colt Keith, on three hits and struck out five. Right-hander Jensen Elliot helped navigate Bowie through the rest of the fourth inning, before right-hander Garrett Stallings went the rest of the way. Stallings allowed no runs on just two hits through his five frames that earned him the win. The Baysox tacked on three more runs against the Erie bullpen - a Maverick Handley RBI single in the sixth and a two-run home run from Fontana in the seventh, to cruise their way to victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter the series finale with a record of 29-27 - one game behind the Altoona Curve atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, this week will be Erie's first series loss since April. The SeaWolves had won or split each of their last five series, including take four of six from the Baysox in Bowie at the beginning of May, and were 21-9 in their last 30 games entering action this week. No. 2 Tigers /No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads a SeaWolves offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.776) and slugging (.422). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.332) and hits (70), while leading the league in OPS (1.001) and slugging (.597). He was also named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Brant Hurter is expected to take the ball for the SeaWolves in the series finale. Hurter has had his two worst starts of the season in his last two outings against Bowie. After taking the loss on Tuesday, after allowing five runs (three earned) on six hits through 4.1 innings, Hurter has now allowed 11 runs (nine earned) in his last six innings against the Baysox, including three of his five home runs surrendered on the season. Hurter still sits fourth in the Eastern League in ERA (2.65) and third in WHIP (1.10). This will be Hurter's fourth start of the season against the Baysox, as he also started against them on 5/2, collecting the win after five innings, allowing just one, unearned run on three hits, with a walk and seven strikeouts. Originally a 7th round pick by Detroit in the 2021 draft out of Georgia Tech, Hurter's arsenal features a low-mid-90s sinker, a mid-80s slider, and a changeup.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is third with 28 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles / No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has an extra-base hit in nine of his last 13 games, to go along with nine walks in his last seven contests and nine multi-walk games. May be leads the Baysox with 34 walks and a .919 OPS. He is in the midst of a 24-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 27 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the fourth-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 75 hits and a .362 average. Prieto has been on fire this week. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect is 11-for-23 on the week with 9 RBI, with at least three-hits in all three of the five games this week, including his second four-hit performance of 2023 on Thursday. Prieto has nine contests on the season with at least three knocks through his first 52 games. Overall, Prieto has feasted on Erie pitching in 2023, batting .435 (20-for-46) against the SeaWolves with four doubles, a home run, and six multi-hit performances in 11 games. In addition, Prieto sits third in the Eastern League with his .409 on-base percentage.

GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS

Saturday night's 6-2 victory over Erie extended Bowie's season-long winning streak to five games. The Baysox are tied for the third-longest winning streak in the Eastern League this season, and are in an 10-way tie for the longest active streak in Minor League Baseball. This comes after Bowie was the last team in the Eastern League to win three-straight games this season when they did so from 5/21-24, with a victory over Altoona and two wins over Akron. The last winning streak of at least four games for the Baysox came back on 7/30-8/7 of 2022, when Bowie won eightstraight games (two against Altoona, six against Harrisburg). That marks a span of 90 games across both seasons between the last two winning streaks of at least four games for the Baysox.



Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Darner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022

- Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings
- Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning) Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit, Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.

For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.


Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japlaying career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pltching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization, Hermann also served as a pltching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pltching Performance center in Missouri. He pltched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox develo-other filling the same role for Aberdean last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time n 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
