#### **Leading Off**

Welcome to the start of the 2023 R-Phils season. After last night's postponement, Reading and Richmond are set to get the 2023 campaign underway with two 7-inning games today. In 2022, Reading and Richmond split their lone series, with each team winning three games. Following tonight, the R-Phils will play tomorrow afternoon before heading back north to Reading for the home opener on Tuesday against Hartford.

#### **Looking Back**

Reading closed out 2022 with a 61-77 record. Even though the R-Phils failed to make the playoffs, it was still an exciting season. Many former R-Phils helped contribute to the Phillies NL Championship run, such as Rhys Hoskins, Aaron Nola, Bryson Stott and much more. In Baseballtown, plenty of enticing prospects came through Reading. On Tuesday night, the R-Phils took a trip to the Jersey Shore to scrimmage the BlueClaws. Reading won 3-2, thanks to strong pitching. David Parkinson, who missed all of 2022, led the way with four-strong innings.

#### Aces Aplenty

When looking back at the 2022 R-Phils roster, the word ace certainly comes to mind. Pitching was Reading's strength in 2022 and three guys who contributed to that were Andrew Painer, Mick Abel and Griff McGarry. All three came to Reading in last summer and dominated in the starting rotation. Abel returns to Reading to start the season with the R-Phils, while Painter and McGarry are currently on the injured list.

#### New Skipper

With Shawn Williams' relocation to the Phillies complex in Clearwater, the R-Phils welcome Al Pedrique as the manager for the 2023 season. Pedrique brings years of both playing and coaching in the minor leagues. Most recently, he served as the third-base coach for the Miami Marlins. Prior to that, Pedrique managed Miami's triple-A affiliate, Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp. He also has experinece coaching within the Diamondbacks, Astros, Yankees and many more organizations.

#### Looking Up

The big club, Philadelphia Phillies, opened up its 2023 home schedule with a 5-2 win over the Cincinatti Reds yesterday. The two teams return to the field today at 4:05. Former R-Phils Bryson Stott and Alec Bohm have started the season red hot. Stott enters today leading the Phillies with a .407 average and Bohm comes in fourth at .333.

#### **Loaded with Prospects**

Reading's Opening Day lineup features five of the Phillies top-30 prospects. Mick Abel ranks second, Johan Rojas sixth, Carlos De La Cruz ninth, Ethan Wilson 14th and Andrew Baker 17th. All those players spent time in Reading last season.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

**April 8, 2016:** At Reading, Jorge Alfaro goes 4-for-5 with a double, 2 RBIs and run scored in the Fightin Phils' 8-3 win over Portland. Angelo Mora chips in 3 extra base hits, going 3-for-4 with a homer, 2 doubles, a walk, 3 runs and 2 RBIs.

#### The Flying Squirrels

Richmond enters this season after a unique 2022. The Flying Squirrels won the Eastern League Southwest in the first half, clinching a playoff spot, but finished the season 66-71. Richmond went on to lose two games to none to Erie in the first round of the Eastern League playoffs.

#### Squirrel on the Bump

Richmond will trot out righty Carson Seymour to open up their season. Seymour was traded from the Mets to Giants in last year's Darin Ruf deal. He split the season at three levels and went 7-8 with a 3.08 ERA. Starting game two will be lefty Nick Zwack.
