The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) are scheduled for a doubleheader on Thursday. Express RHP Jack Leiter is scheduled to take the mound for the first game against Baseball Club RHP Ben Casparius with first pitch set for 4:35 p.m. CT. RHP Johnny Cueto is slated to throw in game two for the E-Train against an OKC pitcher to be determined. Both games will be seven innings in length with game two to start approximately 30 minutes after the conclusion of game one.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock claimed a 4-3 win over Oklahoma City on Wednesday night as the teams completed Tuesday's suspended game. On Tuesday night, Round Rock plated a run in the top of the first. 1B Blaine Crim knocked a double to score LF Dustin Harris, who had worked a leadoff walk then stole second base. Inclement weather in the area forced the game to be suspended before it was continued on Wednesday. In the bottom of the first, Oklahoma City CF James Outman hit a solo home run to tie the game at 1-1. The Express tallied three runs in the second inning to take over, 4-1. A single from CF Jose Barrero plated two runners and a Davis Wendzel sacrifice fly scored Barrero. Baseball Club 3B Andre Lipcius knocked a solo shot in the third frame before SS Trey Sweeney recorded a sacrifice fly to score Outman and make it a one-run game. Both teams went without a run over the final six innings to secure the 4-3 final for Round Rock.

LEITER ON THE BUMP

Express RHP Jack Leiter will take the mound in Thursday's game one and is coming off his shortest outing of the season. He tossed 1.2 innings and allowed six earned runs in a loss against El Paso last Wednesday. The right hander has 44 strikeouts in 32.0 innings this year.

CUETO GETS GAME TWO

Reigning Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week RHP Johnny Cueto is slated to start game two of the twin bill. Cueto tossed 6.0 scoreless innings and recorded six strikeouts on May 30 against El Paso to earn the league honor.

ONE DAY, TWO GAMES

Heading into Thursday's doubleheader, the E-Train holds a 37-17 record in doubleheaders, including a whopping 24-3 in game ones, since the start of the 2015 season. Today will mark the third twin bill of the season for Round Rock and the second against Oklahoma City. At Dell Diamond on April 10, the Express claimed two wins in one day over the Baseball Club.

SERIOUS ABOUT SAMPSON

Round Rock RHP Adrian Sampson earned a winning decision on Wednesday night and is now tied for the lead in wins among Pacific Coast League pitchers with seven on the season. The righty is tied with Tacoma LHP Jhonathan Diaz. His winning percentage of 77.8 percent is second in the league and ERA of 4.37 is fourth among qualified pitchers.

AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

With 17 games remaining in the first half of the season, Round Rock is 6.0 games back of first-place Sugar Land in the overall standings. The winner of the first half gets home field advantage in the PCL Championship Series. Sacramento is only 1.0 game back while current opponent Oklahoma City is 3.5 behind.

ALCS EXPRESS REUNION

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.

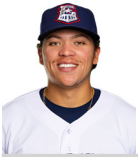
