ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Sea Dogs beat the Rumble Ponies 8-1 on Friday night, taking advantage of free passes and Binghamton mistakes to pile on the runs, despite a slow night at the plate. Brooks Brannon hit his seventh home run of the month, his 17th of the season. Sea Dogs pitchers recorded fifteen strikeouts, while allowing just two hits. Portland has allowed three or fewer runs in five straight games. Portland starting pitching has allowed one earned run through four games this week.

FAREWELL FRANKLIN Infielder Franklin Arias was assigned to Triple-A Worcester on Friday following a phenomenal stint with the Sea Dogs. He will make his debut batting leadoff today. At the time of his departure, Arias was batting .318, good for second best among qualified Eastern League players, and led the league in OPS (.994). He was intentionally walked more than anyone else in the Eastern League (five times), and was top five in hits (4th, 90), home runs (3rd, 19), total bases (2nd, 166), OBP (3rd, .407), and SLG% (2nd, .587). Arias batted leadoff in 70 of the Sea Dogs' first 92 games.

WATCH OUT FOR WINNAY! On Wednesday, infielder Jack Winnay snapped a 13 game hit streak that tied Johanfran Garcia for the longest by a Sea Dog this season. He was hitless last night, but walked three times, and has a team-best .396 on-base percentage. Winnay has a hit in 17 of his first 22 games as a Sea Dog with eight multi-hit games. Overall, Winnay is batting .321 (26-for-81) with five doubles, three home runs, 15 runs scored, nine RBI, and nine walks. Winnay showed a propensity for walks (53) and home runs (11) through 56 first-half games with the High-A Greenville Drive.

BRANNON'S BAT Brooks Brannon leads the Eastern League in SLG% (.604) and has the second best SLG% in Double-A baseball. Brannon has a hit in 12 of 14 games in July with six multi-hit games. Last night, his two-run homer was his 17th of the season, well beyond last year's career high season total of ten homers. In July, Brannon is batting .358 and slugging .887, with 47 total bases in 53 at bats. Of his 19 total hits in July, seven are doubles and seven are home runs. He's batted in 17 runs.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS Infielder Franklin Arias, the no.1 prospect in the Red Sox organization, was assigned to Triple-A Worcester on Friday. RHP Patrick Halligan was also assigned to Worcester. Infielder Max Ferguson, who began the season with the Sea Dogs, was reassigned to Portland. Ferguson batted .309 with nine doubles and eight home runs through 27 games in Portland this season. RHP Blake Wehunt was assigned to Worcester last Tuesday. In a corresponding move, LHP Tyler Davis was assigned to join Portland from High-A Greenville.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY July 25, 2014 – Brian Johnson fanned a career-high 12 batters over 7 scoreless on just one hit, leading the Sea Dogs to a 1-0 win at New Britain...The lone run was on a sacrifice fly by Sean Coyle in the third.

ON THE MOUND RHP Anthony Eyanson (4-0, 1.56 ERA), the top pitching prospect in the Red Sox system, will make his tenth appearance and ninth start for the Sea Dogs this season, after making five starts for High-A Greenville in April and early May (0-0, 0.44 ERA). Eyanson recently earned the win for the American League in the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game. Eyanson earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month in April after recording a 0.54 ERA in four starts. After his second start in Double-A, Eyanson earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week. He did not allow a run or a hit while striking out four batters in 5.0 innings pitched. Overall for Portland, Eyanson has allowed eight runs, seven earned, on 22 hits with 45 strikeouts in 40.1 innings pitched. After winning the 2025 MCWS with LSU, Eyanson was drafted by the Red Sox in the third round of the 2025 MLB First-Year Player Draft.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.

2026 in Portland After his second start in Double-A, Eyanson earned Eastern League Pitcher of the Week. He did not allow a run or a hit while striking out four batters in 5.0 innings pitched. He recently represented the American League in the 2026 MLB All-Star Futures Game, earning the win. Overall, he has allowed eight runs, seven earned, on 21 hits with 17 walks and 37 strikeouts in 35.1 innings pitched.

2026 in Greenville earned South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month honors in April for his work opening the season with the Red Sox' High-A affiliate, the Greenville Drive. Eyanson recorded a 0.54 ERA in four April starts, allowing one run on six hits over 16.2 innings, with 27 strikeouts and no walks. Overall, Eyanson made five starts for Greenville to the tune of a 0.44 ERA, allowing seven hits and one run with 34 strikeouts in 20.1 innings of work.

CAREER: Ranked as the top pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect in the Red Sox system by MLB.com. He is the No. 51 overall prospect in baseball according to MLB.com.

PERSONAL: Attended the University of California, San Diego (2023-24) and Louisiana State University (2025)...In 2025, posted a 3.00 ERA (36 ER/108.0 IP) with 152 SO (3rd-most in Division I baseball) helping lead LSU to a National Championship...Earned the win in the championship clinching game vs. Coastal Carolina (6.1 IP, 3 R, 7 H, BB, 9 SO)...Was tabbed a First Team All-American by Baseball America, and a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball, ABCA, NCBWA, and Perfect Game...Also named Second-Team All-SEC and to the First-Year SEC Academic Honor Roll...In 2024 at UC San Diego, was a Second-Team All-Big West honoree...In 2024, played summer baseball with the Cotuit Kettleers of the Cape Cod League...Graduated from Lakewood High School (CA)...Notable MLB alumni include, J.P. Crawford, Travis d'Arnaud, and 2013 World Series Champion Mike Carp...Also played football his freshman and junior year as a quarterback, wide receiver, safety, and kicker.
