#### On The Road Again

The Fightin Phils continue a two-week road trip on Friday night at the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. It is the 16th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and seventh-of-nine at TD Bank Ballpark. Somerset leads the season-series 9-6, and can clinch it with one more win.

#### **Double Trouble**

The Fightin Phils dropped their fifth-straight game after falling in both ends of Thursday's contests. Reading fell 4-3 in 10 innings in the resumption of Wednesday's suspended game. Marcus Lee Sang and Ethan Wilson each homered, and Konnor Ash struck out three over two-scoreless relief innings. In game two, the R-Phils fell 2-1. Braeden Fausanught punched out eight over six-quality innings. He allowed two runs on four hits, but suffered the defeat. Reading was held to just four hits, with the lone RBI coming on an infield single from Andrick Nava with bases loaded.

#### Marcus Mashing

After a recent slow stretch. Marcus Lee Sang is swinging the bat well again. Sine August 13, Lee Sang is slashing .310/.341/.548, with an .889 OPS. He's added seve runs, two doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI. This comes after a stretch that saw Lee Sang go 7-72 (.097) from July 4-August 10.

#### Carson Cruising Again

After going 0-for-10 in his first three starts at Binghamton last week, Carson Taylor has locked back in ever since. Taylor is currently riding a five-game hit and seven-game on-base streak. During the hit streak, Taylor is slashing .471/.571/.588, with a 1.159 OPS. He's added one run, two doubles and four RBI over that stretch. Taylor's strong season has seen him littered amongst the Eastern League leaderboards. Those rankings are: 7th AVG (.288), T-4th HR (16), 2nd RBI (72), 1st OBP (.398), 1st SLG (.495), 1st OPS (.893), T-3rd BB (59) and 6th TB (165).

#### Crawford Cruising

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford has continued to look strong at the top of the Fightin Phils lineup since his Double-A debut on July 19. Through 28 games with Reading, Crawford is slashing .316/.362/.419, with a .781 OPS. He's added 17 runs, nine doubles, one home run and 17 RBI. Crawford is also 12-13 in stolen bases so far with the R-Phils. Crawford currently owns 11 multi-hit games, with five of them being three-hit games. Most recently, he had three hits and a Double-A high three runs scored last Saturday at Binghamton. Since his Reading debut, Crawford is third in the Eastern League in average, tied for fourth in hits and tied for first in stolen bases. Also tied for first with 12 stolen bases in that stretch is Gabriel Rincones Jr.

#### Swiper Yes Swiping

The Fightin Phils enter Friday night's game tied for fifth place in the Eastern League with 134 stolen bases on the season. That mark passes last season's total of 119, which ranked 10th in the Eastern League. Reading is on pace to finsih this season with 150 stolen bases on the season. Since the All-Star Break, Reading is fourth in the Eastern League with 49 stolen bases. That has coincided with the debut of Justin Crawford and return of Gabriel Rincones Jr., who each own 12 stolen bases over that stretch. The R-Phils 134 stolen bases is their most in a season since swiping 130 in 2010. The next-best mark was 145 back in 2003.

#### Going Going Gone

This week's series matches up the two teams with the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. Somerset is in first place with 131 home runs and Reading sits in second with 127 long balls. Reading is on pace for 143 home runs this season, which would be the first time the R-Phils hit over 140 home runs in consecutive seasons since 2017 (153) and 2018 (141).

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

August 30, 2023: At Reading, Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel tossed his second-straight strong start, going five innings, allowing one run on two hits, with five strikeouts. Carlos De La Cruz hits his 22nd homer of the season and Baron Radcliff hits a ball that lands on Route 61 as Reading falls 5-3.

#### Sup Somerset

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with a 32-20 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took four-of-six at Portland. Following this week, Somerset goes to Binghamton. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Chase Hampton (6), Brock Selvidge (7), Zach Messinger (17), Cam Schlittler (25), Trystan Vrieling (28) and Rafael Flores (30).

#### **Patriots Pitcher**

Righty, and Yankees' pitcher, Cody Poteet makes his third rehab appearance with Somerset tonight. He went two-scoreless on Aug. 20 at Portland and 3.2 innings of one-run ball on Aug. 25 at Portland as well. Poteet has made four starts for the Yankees this season and is 3-0, with a 2.14 ERA over 21 innings. He was placed on the 15-day IL on June 18 and moved to the 60-day on Aug. 1 with a right triceps strain. He was signed by the Yankees in January after being released by the Royals. He's also pitched in the big leagues for the Miami Marlins in 2021 and 2022. Poteet and Reading Manager Al Pedrique were on the same Marlins team in 2022. Miami drafted Poteet in the fourth round of the 2015 draft out of UCLA. He made his Major League debut on May 12, 2021, with Miami.
