BERRY WALK-OFF SECURES SERIES WIN

Jacob Berry's walk-off single on Sunday spurred Jacksonville to a 3-2 win over Worcester. **Seby Zavala's** RBI double for the Red Sox opened up the scoring in the second before **Trayce Thompson** scampered home on a passed ball in the fourth to make it 2-0. The Jumbo Shrimp finally got on the board in the bottom of the fourth when **Troy Johnston** lifted a sacrifice fly to center field. Another sacrifice fly, this time from **Agustín Ramírez**, tied the score in the eighth before Berry's walk-off base hit won it for Jacksonville in the ninth. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen fired 5.0 hitless innings.

THE TWO TOWERS

After winning two of three in Nashville, the Jumbo Shrimp took four of six contests against Worcester. Thus, this marks just the fourth time since 2005 (2009, 2013, 2021) that the club started a season with consecutive series victories. Each of those prior three teams had winning records, with the 2009 squad going 82-58 (.586) en route to a Southern League championship, the 2013 Jacksonville Suns posting a 73-63 (.537) mark and the 2021 team going 75-55 (.577). Only the 2021 Jumbo Shrimp won each of their first three sets of the season, starting 13-5 (.722).

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in seven of their last eight games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have recorded two games with five stolen bases (March 29 at Nashville, April 5 vs. Worcester), a mark the club reached only twice in the prior three seasons. Jacksonville currently leads the International League with 23 stolen bases. Moreover, their 95.8 percent success rate ranks second in the IL entering play on Tuesday.

MAXIMO OVERDRIVE

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Maximo Acosta** is off to an absurd start to the 2025 season. In nine games thus far, the native of Caracas, Venezuela has recorded four multi-hit contests and two multi-RBI affairs. Acosta is 12-for-36 in total at the plate, slashing .333/.429/.444/.873 with one double, one home run, six RBIs, six walks, six runs scored and three stolen bases. He ranks tied for third in the International League in hits (12) and tied for 21st in RBIs (6).

BOOM OR BUST

With little in-between thus far in 2025, Jacksonville's offense has either been extraordinary or has really struggled depending on the game. In three of their nine contests thus far, the Jumbo Shrimp have plated double-digit runs - something they accomplished only 10 times in 149 games last season. However, in their other six contests, Jacksonville has plated a total of 12 runs.

'PEN PALS

Through eight games in 2025, Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone only 5.0 innings (and no further) just three times. The club's bullpen has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.35 ERA, the second-best such mark in the International League. The club's bullpen also ranks in a tie for first in the circuit in strikeouts (59), second in batting average against (.154) and fifth in fewest hits allowed (25). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 46.0 innings through nine games (5.1 per game), third-most in the IL and just 2.1 away from first-place Toledo.

DE LOS SANTOS CLAUS

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Deyvison De Los Santos** is coming off a monster 2024 season while playing for Jacksonville, Triple-A Reno and Double-A Amarillo. The 21-year-old native of Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic led all of Minor League Baseball in home runs (40), RBIs (120) and total bases (307). He also ranked in the top 20 in the minor leagues in hits (2nd, 158), extra-base hits (T-2nd, 67), slugging percentage (5th, .571), OPS (10th, .914) and runs scored (18th, 89). Of the 250 hardest-hit balls in Triple-A during the 2024 season, De Los Santos smacked 11 of them, including a 116.0 mile per hour (10th overall in Triple-A) single while playing for Reno on June 12, 2024.

SHRIMP BITES

Despite only averaging 3.9 innings per start, Jumbo Shrimp starters' 35.0 total innings thus far through nine games is the sixth-most in the International League. The rotation's 3.34 ERA ranks sixth in the circuit, with their five walks placing as the lowest in the circuit and their .208 batting ranking fourth... Jacksonville (109) and Charlotte (108) have struck out the most of any team in the IL.

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeting.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourth-most in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON
