#### FROM THE CROWS NEST

FLY FLY AWAY: The Marauders earned a dominant 16-5 victory over the Tortugas last night, marking their largest single-game run total this year. Bradenton collected 15 hits, drew eight walks and also took advantage of six Daytona errors. In the process, they also matched a season high with three homers, their tenth such output this season. It also marked the ninth time in franchise history they had brought home 16 or more, and the first time since 2023 when they pushed across 18 versus Fort Myers. Overall, their 95 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and Single-A, as they've now passed San Jose (California League, 93). 147 of their 539 total runs have been generated via the long ball (27.2%). They're 35-28 when leaving the yard at least once, and 20-34 when not homering at all. They've seen five players launch 9+ home runs this season, more than any other team in the FSL (A. Plaz, Y. De Los Santos, K. Griffin, J. Severino, E. Florentino).

**KELLINGTON TAKES THE BALL:** Right hander **Owen Kellington** will take the ball in game four of the series versus Daytona. During his previous start at Palm Beach on Saturday, he fired 2.2 innings of one-run ball. He has surrendered just that one run over his last four outings and 11.2 innings. Moreover, of his ten hits allowed with Bradenton (.165 BAA), all but three have been singles. Between his FCL rehab stint and Single-A, he has allowed just five extra-base hits and one homer. After undergoing formmy John Surgery in 2024, Kellington made his return to the mound in June with three rehab outings with the FCL Pirates. Kellington was activated by the Marauders on July 12 when he tossed 2.1 innings versus the St. Lucie Mets. Over five total outings with the Marauders, Kellington has fanned 13 hitters and walked five over 14.1 innings (4 ER). Tonight marks his third game started since 2023 when he made 18 starts and tossed a career-high 80 innings for the Marauders in 2023 (3.94 ERA). The 2023 fourth-round pick mixes in a four-seamer (91 mph), curveball (78.2 mph), changeup (85.0 mph) and slider (81.4 mph). Opponents are just 2-for-24 against his heater (.083) this season and have struck out six times, the most of any of his pitches.

RACE TO 50: Yordany De Los Santos stole his 48th and 49th stolen bases on Sunday afternoon, adding to a career-best mark (34 between FCL/Single-A in 2024). He is now tied with Daytona's Kyle Henley for the most in the league - the next to swipe a base will be the first FSL player to steal 50 since Seth Stephensen (LAK -62) and Emartion Boyd (CLR -56) reached the threshold in 2023. In the process, De Los Santos also passed Jesus Castillo (39 - 2023), for the most single-season stolen bases by a Marauder in franchise history. Him and Henley are tied for sixth in Single-A. Moreover, De Los Santos sits only behind Konnor Griffin (60) for the most swipes in the Pittsburgh Pirates system. They are the ninth and tenth 40+ stolen-base seasons in Pirates-MilLB history. The two are approaching Rich Thompson for the most in a season by a Pirates minor leaguer since 2005 when he stole 58 that season between Double-A Altoona and Triple-A Indianapolis.

**WELCOME TO THE STRETCH RUN:** As we approach the end of the second half, Bradenton is 25-26, currently 5.0 games behind the Threshers for the FSL West's final playoff spot (also up 2.5 games up on Dunedin). With 15 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance 2021 when they won their second FSL title. After dropping the season series with Clearwater, the Threshers have the tie-break advantage if the two teams finish with even records at the end of the season. The Marauders currently lead their season series with Dunedin 8-7 and will face the Blue Jays at LECOM Park for six games to complete the regular season.

He remains the only Marauders player to be honored this season by Minor League Baseball. Over the 23-game stretch, Florentino slashed .301/.433/.663 with 16 stolen bases and 17 walks. His eight home runs and 23 RBI were the most of any player throughout the Florida State League and Single-A. Florentino was also one of three Single-A players, and the only in the FSL, to tally 15 or more walks and ten or more extra-base hits. Florentino is the Pirates No. 5 ranked prospect according to MLB Pipeline and was promoted to Single-A Bradenton on June 21.

**TONY TATERS:** Pirates No. 30 prospect (MLB Pipeline) **Tony Blanco Jr.** demolished his first two Single-A homers during the Marauders previous homestand. On July 30, he sent a fastball 415 feet to left field, that cleared the confines of LECOM Park. The ball left his bat at 118.9 miles per hour, marking the hardest-hit ball in Single-A at the time, clearing the next closest batted ball by 4.4 mph. Three nights later, he also demolished a walk-off three-run homer that left the bat at 119.8 mph - the hardest-batted ball in MiLB this season. Only three batted balls at the Major-League level have been hit harder this season. He joins Oneil Cruz (122.9 mph) and Vladamir Guerrero Jr. (120.4 mph) on the list. Only him and Cruz (122.9 mph) have left the yard with such batted ball quality. He was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter.

Right hander **Owen Kellington** will take the ball in game four of the series versus Daytona. During his previous start at Palm Beach on Saturday, he fired 2.2 innings of one-run ball. He has surrendered just that one run over his last four outings and 11.2 innings. Moreover, of his ten hits allowed with Bradenton (.165 BAA), all but three have been singles. Between his FCL rehab stint and Single-A, he has allowed just five extra-base hits and one homer. After undergoing Tommy John Surgery in 2024, Kellington made his return to the mound in June with three rehab outings with the FCL Pirates. Kellington was activated by the Marauders on July 12 when he tossed 2.1 innings versus the St. Lucie Mets. Over five total outings with the Marauders, Kellington has fanned 13 hitters and walked five over 14.1 innings (4 ER). Tonight marks his third game started since 2023 when he made 18 starts and tossed a career-high 80 innings for the Marauders in 2023 (3.94 ERA). The 2023 fourth-round pick mixes in a four-seamer (91 mph), curveball (78.2 mph), changeup (85.0 mph) and slider (81.4 mph). Opponents are just 2-for-24 against his heater (.083) this season and have struck out six times, the most of any of his pitches.
