TONIGHT'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field for tonight's game, as your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes (Los Angeles Dodgers) host the San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants) in the final game of a six-game series. Today is IEHP Kids Eat Free Sunday! After the game, kids can "Run the Bases" thanks to San Antonio Regional Hospital. The home stand continues on Tuesday, as the Quakes welcome the Fresno Grizzlies (COL) to LoanMart Field. Tickets are available by visiting rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the sixth of 12 against the Giants here in 2024 and the last of six at LoanMart Field. Last season, the Quakes went 8-4 against the Giants, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: Samuel Munoz rescued the Quakes from what would have been a tough loss, as his walk-off single in the bottom of the tenth inning gave Rancho a 7-6 win over San Jose on Saturday night at LoanMart Field. San Jose's Cesar Quintas tied the game with a three-run homer with two outs in the ninth inning, as an error earlier in the inning kept the inning alive for San Jose. Munoz, who had a two-run homer (3) earlier in the night, overcame that speed-bump with the walk-off winner off Tim Manning (0-1), helping the Quakes to their second straight win and third in five games in the series. Rancho reliever Felix Cabrera (6-3) tossed a scoreless tenth, leaving two on base for the win.

HISTORIC NIGHT FOR DECKER: Cameron Decker missed the first three games of this series, after being hit by a pitch last Sunday at Inland Empire, but he had a week's worth of production on Friday. Decker had a career-night, matching a franchise record held by Mike Darr (1997) and Jorbit Vivas (2021) by going 6-for-6. He set a new franchise record with ten RBIs, surpassing the previous high of eight, set by Ibandel Isabel (2017), Quincy Lattimore (2017) and Jesus Galiz (2023).

THE SOUTH DIVISION RACE: The Quakes have won three of five in this series and eight of their last 11 overall, taking a one-game lead over Visalia. The Rawhide, winners of five straight over Stockton, are the biggest threat to Rancho making the 2024 playoffs, with Lake Elsinore (currently two games back in the South Division), already having won the first half. The Quakes must finish ahead of both Visalia and Inland Empire (currently six games back) in order to make the playoffs.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made multiple roster moves over the last few days. Earlier today, LHP Wyatt Crowell was moved up to Great Lakes of the Midwest League. On Saturday, they added RHP Samuel Sanchez, from the Arizona Complex League. On Friday, Rancho added RHP Marco Corcho from the Arizona Complex League.

CHRISTIAN ZAZUETA: Right-hander Christian Zazueta makes his sixth start and ninth appearance for the Quakes, his second in this series against the Giants. In his last outing overall, he allowed three hits and three walks, striking out four over four scoreless innings in a no-decision on Tuesday, July 30. Zazueta went 3-0 with an ERA of 1.93 over 18.2 innings in the ACL before joining Rancho. Zazueta, originally signed by the Yankees in 2022 out of Mexico, was acquired by the Dodgers in a trade with New York this past February for former Quake Caleb Ferguson.

RYAN VANDERHEI: Right-hander Ryan Vanderhei will make his eighth appearance and his first start, his second appearance of this series against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed just one walk over three scoreless, hitless relief innings in a win on July 30. Vanderhei was drafted by the Giants tenth round of the 2023 draft out of Texas Christian University.
