### Saturday in the Park

The Fightin Phils continue their first home series of the season on Saturday night against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the fifth-of-24 matchups between the teams this season, and fifth-of-12 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2025 season-series 11-7, which included taking four-of-six in the teams' lone series at America's Classic Ballpark. Reading leads the season-series 3-1 and will search for its first series victory of the season on Saturday night.

### Fightin' Their Way Back

The Reading Fightin Phils clawed back from a 6-3 deficit to defeat the Hartford Yard Goats 9-6, earning their third consecutive win at FirstEnergy Stadium. Both starters opened with scoreless frames before Alex Binelas broke through with a solo home run, giving Reading a 1-0 lead. Hartford responded with a four-run fourth inning, highlighted by a three-run homer from Conner Capel, and extended the lead to 6-3 in the fifth on Aiden Longwell's two-run double. Reading answered quickly, getting an RBI double from Austin Murr and a sacrifice fly from Jordan Dissin to make it 4-3, then completed the comeback in the sixth when Dissin doubled home a run and Bryson Ware launched a go-ahead three-run homer. The Fightin Phils added insurance in the seventh as Aroon Escobar tripled in a run and Raylin Heredia followed with a sacrifice fly. The bullpen took over from there, retiring the final 12 hitters without allowing a baserunner. Dante Nori led the offense with three hits, while Heredia and Murr each recorded multi-hit performances as Reading secured its third straight win after starting the season 0-4.

### Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff has been excellent to begin the 2026 season. Through seven games, Reading's 3.54 ERA (24 ER, 61.0 IP) ranks as second-best in the Eastern League. This came after the R-Phils pitching staff finished last in the league in ERA in both 2025 and '24, and also was 11th in 2023. The Fightins' pitching staff has also struck out 66 batters this season, which is eighth in the league and their 19 walks allowed ranks as fewest surrendered in the Eastern League. So far this series with Hartford, the R-Phils bullpen has allowed two-earned runs over 18.2 IP, good for a 0.96 ERA on the week.

### Espresso Man Strikes Again

Phillies No. 7 Prospect Dante Nori, whose World Baseball Classic performance and Espresso Shots took notoriety recently, has had a strong start to the season for Reading. After missing the season opener at Akron last Thursday, Nori has rattled off a six-game hit streak to start the 2026 season. He posted a season-high three hits, along with a double on Friday night, marking his third multi-hit game in his first six contests this season. The Phillies selected Nori in the first round (27th overall) of the 2024 draft out of Northville High School in Michigan. Nori's father is a current assistant coach on the Minnesota Timberwolves and his grandfather was one of Kyle Schwarber's coaches at Indiana.

### Murr Making his Mark

Austin Murr's impressive start to the season continued on Thursday night when he launched a two-run walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th inning. He then added two hits, two runs, a double and RBI on Friday night. Murr has reached base in all six games he's played in this season and is slashing .429/.478/.619 (1.097 OPS). Murr has also shown defensive versatility, playing first base and both corner outfield spots. The Phillies selected Murr in the Minor League Rule Five Draft last December from the Detroit Tigers. The 27-year old spent 2025 between West Michigan (A+) and Toledo (AAA), combining to slash .274/.376/.445 (.821 OPS), with eight home runs and 51 RBI.

### Here Come the Homers

After not launching a home run during the first weekend of the season in Akron, the Fightin Phils have hit six through this week's first four games. Alex Binelas leads the team with three, homering on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Bryson Ware hit his first on Wednesday and second on Friday and Austin Murr added number one on Thursday. Ironically, the only three R-Phils to homer this season have consistently been placed in the bottom half of the lineup, showcasing the depth of Al Pedrique's lineup.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

April 11, 2023: At Reading, the R-Phils open up their 2023 home schedule against the Hartford Yard Goats. It is the first game played with a new home run wall, lights and much more, amongst ongoing construction during the season. The R-Phils fell to Hartford 8-6 in front of 6,417 fans. Reading also debuted its new "Reading Keystone" jerseys it will wear in 2023 to celebrate the 275th Anniversary of Reading.

### Hey Hartford

Hartford finished their 2025 campaign with a 69-68 record, which was the third-best overall record in the Eastern League Northeast Division. The Yard Goats opened up the 2026 campaign taking two-of-three games from Chesapeake at home. Following this week, Hartford returns home and takes on Richmond. Five of Colorado's top-30 prospects (MLB Pipeline) are on Hartford's roster: Jared Thomas (3), Griffin Herring (9), Roc Riggio (10), Cole Messina (21) and Konner Eaton (26).

### Who's On The Bump for Hartford?

Righty Jack Mahoney makes the start tonight for Hartford. He made his season debut last Saturday against Chesapeake and earned the win, tossing five innings, allowing two runs on four hits, with four walks and six strikeouts. Mahoney spent all of last season with Hartford, going 3-10, with a 5.93 ERA over 24 starts, which included 81 strikeouts over 104.2 innings of work. Against Reading in 2025, Mahoney was 0-2 across three starts, with a 6.00 ERA (10 ER, 15.0 IP). He split 2025 between Fresno (A) and Spokane (A+), and began his pro career in 2023 with the ACL-Rockies (ROK). Colorado took Mahoney in the third round of the 2023 draft out of South Carolina, after pitching for the Gamecocks in 2021 and '23. He did not pitch in 2022.
