TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 7-game set with Bowie.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona swept Bowie in a doubleheader with a pair of one-run wins, 3-2 and 1-0. **Braxton Ashcraft** and **Justin Meis** made a 3-run 3rd inning stand up in game one and **Liover Peguero's** solo homer to leadoff game two was Altoona's only baserunner in a 1-0 win.

A BIZARRE DOUBLEHEADER: Altoona swept Bowie in a doubleheader on June 21 in which Curve pitching held the Baysox to just two total runs. In Game two, **Liover Peguero** swatted a leadoff homer off Connor Gillispie who then proceeded to set down each of the next 18 hitters he faced. **Nick Dombkowski**, **Omar Cruz** and **Oliver Garcia** combined on a three-hitter to stand up a 1-0 win. It was just the second time in the last three seasons that Altoona has won both ends of doubleheader.

NEED A CLUTCH KNOCK: The Curve are last among Double-A teams when batting with a runner in scoring position at two outs, hitting just .180.

GOTTA KEEP IT IN THE PARK: Altoona set a new franchise record for consecutive games with a home run allowed, surrendering a homer in 13 straight games; with the streak ending in game two of the doubleheader on June 21 against Bowie. The Curve went 4-9 during this stretch of play and ended the streak with a 3-hit shutout in a 7-inning game.

THE BIG LEFTY: Altoona welcomed lefty **Anthony Solometo** to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. The 20-year-old left-hander was Pittsburgh's second round pick (37th overall) in 2021 out of Bishop Eustace Prep (NJ). At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in the Eastern League behind Somerset's Jasson Dominguez (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17.

MOVING SEASON: Altoona saw four key members of their pitching staff earn promotions to Triple-A during the team's week at Somerset. On June 16 RHP **Travis MacGregor**, who was 2nd among Eastern League relievers with 43 strikeouts in 32.1 IP, and RHP **Kyle Nicolas**, who ranked 10th in the league in strikeouts with 63, each moved to Indy. In their place, Altoona welcomed back RHP **Sean Sullivan** from the injured list and received the No. 9 prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline: LHP **Anthony Solometo**. Then on Tuesday, June 20, RHP **Jared Jones** and RHP **Juan Minaya** were each promoted to Triple-A. Jones, who is ranked the No. 89 overall prospect in baseball by *Baseball America* allowed two runs or fewer in each of his ten starts this season, while Minaya had a 2.39 ERA in 22 appearances out of the Curve bullpen.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted **Henry Davis**, Altoona welcomed C **Abrahan Gutierrez** to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 9-of-11 games played including 3 2B, 2 HR and 6 RBI, including a game-tying 2-run homer on Sunday, June 11 to aid Altoona to a 5-4 comeback win in 10 innings. Gutierrez was acquired from the Phillies in exchange for LHP Braeden Ogle in July of 2021 and the two worked as the battery on Friday, June 9.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Thursday, June 22, Altoona has struck out 518 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball.

WE'LL TAKE TWO: Altoona was T-2nd among all Double-A teams with 58 double plays turned entering play on June 21.

PROSPECT PARTY: The Curve roster features several top Pirates prospects according to MLB Pipeline led by No. 6 INF **Liover Peguero**, No. 9 LHP **Anthony Solometo**, No. 17 OF **Matt Gorski**, No. 23 OF **Matt Fraizer** and No. 29 RHP **Braxton Ashcraft**.

THE SOX THAT HAIL FROM THE BAY: Managed by Kyle Moore for a second straight season, the Baysox roster is highlighted by top prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 8 INF Coby Mayo, No. 11 LHP Cade Povich, No. 17 RHP Chayce McDermott, and No. 19 OF John Rhodes.

THE FIRST TOSSER: Peter Van Loon, Baltimore's 16th round pick in 2021 out of UC Irvine, starts for Bowie tonight. A year ago, he swung between the Aberdeen rotation and bullpen going 11-4 with a 3.25 ERA in 24 games, 14 starts, he struck out 97 batters in 88.2 IP. On June 18, 2022 he tossed 5.0 hitless innings in a combined no-hitter for the Ironbirds. Van Loon began his collegiate career at Division 3 Ohlone college before transferring for Irvine for his final two years of collegiate eligibility, he is the oldest of 6 kids and truly loves his mom's pot roast.

Tossed 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings to begin his Double-A career, longest by a Curve pitcher since Roansy Contreras threw 18.2 IP to start the 2021 season... Matched his career-long outing with 6.0 innings of 2-run ball against Akron on May 11... Did so again in his next outing on 5/17 at Bowie, retiring 15-of-16 batters to begin his start... Tossed a career-high 7.0 innings on 5/23 vs. Hartford, took a no-decision after leaving with a 3-0 deficit and Altoona rallied for 6 runs in the 8th in a 6-3 win... Shaved his head on 5/31 in solidarity with cancer survivors at Altoona's Game of Hope... Placed on 7-Day IL on 6/9 (retro 6/8) with a calf injury, activated on 6/16...

2022: Spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro... Made 20 appearances with 15 starts, going 2-5 with a 4.68 ERA in 75.0 innings... Made his professional debut on 4/13 at Winston-Salem, allowing one unearned run on three hits in 3.0 innings... Struck out career-high 11 batters on 5/31 vs. Wilmington, allowing four runs on four hits in 5.0 innings... Picked up five or more strikeouts in 5 appearances during the season...
