JUMBO SHRIMP DROP WILD GAME WITH SOUNDS Jacksonville mashed 17 hits on Saturday, but the Jumbo Shrimp coughed up a four-run lead in a 10-9 loss to Nashville. The two clubs scored in 12 of Saturday's 17 halfinnings. The Jumbo Shrimp plated four runs in the first, and Nashville did not lead until scoring the game-winning run at 10-9 in the eighth inning. While Jacksonville was 7-for-20 with runners in scoring position, the club stranded at least one runner in every inning for a total of 15, matching a season-high. The only pitcher to not allow a run was Clayton Andrews, who worked 1.1 frames to earn the win.

THE EAGLE HAS LANDED IS STRANDED

Jacksonville has stranded 53 runners on-base in 45 offensive innings thus far in their series in Nashville, going just 16-for-58 (.276) with runners in scoring position during these five games and exacerbating a huge issue of late for the club. Over the last 26 games, the Jumbo Shrimp have stranded 195 runners, an average of 7.5 per game, mainly by hitting a woeful 49-for-221 (.222) with runners in scoring position. Jacksonville has had multiple hits with runners in scoring position in just 12 of these 26 games, with more than two hits over these situations in only eight affairs of this stretch.

ODDS & ENDS ON 2023

After five straight losing seasons from 2015-2019, Jacksonville earned consecutive winning campaigns in 2021 and 2022. However, with three games remaining in the 2023 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are sitting at a 70-77 (.476) record, unable to record its third straight winning season. The Jumbo Shrimp also finished the 2023 home slate with a 35-39 (.473) record. The last time Jacksonville suffered a losing home record was in 2018, when they went 27-41 (.397).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

From Opening Day through August 15, 61 of Jacksonville's 114 games (53.5 percent) were decided by three runs or fewer. However, in the 34 games since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have played 24 affairs (70.6 percent) determined by no more three runs. Over these last 34 games, Jacksonville has posted a 9-15 (.375) record in these narrowly decided affairs. In comparison, through August 15, the Shrimp were 30-31 (.492) in contests decided by three runs or fewer.

'PEN PAIS

Over the last month-plus, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 40 games the club has played since August 8. Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 74 runs. 61 earned. on 134 hits (8.2 H/9) in 146.2 innings for a 3.74 ERA. During this stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp relief corps has combined to strike out 167 batters (10.2 K/9) against 93 walks (5.7 BB/9).

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 50 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 64-for-198 (.323/.403/.520/.923) with 13 doubles, one triple, eight home runs and 33 RBIs. Johnston reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-base streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 116 runs in 134 games this season, which leads MiLB. He is the first Marlins' minor leaguer to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals (Johnston has 26 and 24, respectively) since 2008.

ROAD RAGE

From 2015-19, Jacksonville failed to post a winning record on the road in any campaign, going a combined 137-210 (.395). However, upon joining the Triple-A level in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp's road fortunes rapidly improved. In 2021 and 2022, the club posted a combined mark of 81-58 (.583) on the road. However, in 2023, Jacksonville has registered a 35-39 (.473) mark away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Interestingly, while the club has posted nearly identical OPS' at home (.749) vs. on the road (.756) in 2023, the Jumbo Shrimp have pitched much better at home. At home, Jacksonville has allowed the third-fewest runs (365) in the IL with a 4.56 ERA. On the road, the club has ceded the second-most runs (452) in the league with a 5.76 ERA.

SHRIMP BITES

Jordan Groshans has reached base in 16 of his last 26 plate appearances, going 8-for-18 with five RBIs and eight walks over the last five games... Jacksonville has lost eight of their last 10 games... The 2024 Jumbo Shrimp schedule begins on March 29 vs. Gwinnett at 121 Financial Ballpark.
