Andújar went 3-for-3 with an RBI, finishing the day a homer shy of the cycle. His eighth-inning sacrifice fly was within feet of clearing the fence for the cycle. Iowa surged for six runs on six hits in the third inning off Indians reliever J.C. Flowers. The inning featured four RBI singles and a sacrifice fly by major league rehabber Cody Bellinger. The I-Cubs tacked on an insurance run in the sixth and seventh innings. Major league rehabber Edwin Rios singled in a run in the sixth and an RBI double by right fielder Darius Hill brought home lowa's eighth and final run of the game. Indianapolis broke the shutout in the eighth following a leadoff double off the right-center wall from catcher Henry Davis. Davis went on to score on Andújar's sacrifice fly. The 23-year-old is 7-for-25 with a double, triple, home run, three RBI and five walks through his first seven games. He drew a season-high three walks on Saturday night, his most since drawing three on Sept. 1, 2022 vs Akron with Double-A Altoona. Pittsburgh selected him first overall in the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Louisville.
