LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox had their series finale against Erie rained out on Sunday. On Saturday, the Baysox fell to the Erie SeaWolves by a final of 8-4. Bowie mustered just one run and went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position through the first eight innings. Defensively, the Baysox committed a pair of errors and the pitching staff walked a season high eight batters in the defeat. Erie never trailed during the game and after taking an early 2-0 lead, the SeaWolves scored runs in the 4th, 5th and 6th innings along with three in the 8th.

REVIEWING THE RUBBERDUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best record in the Eastern League at 18-9. The Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians has won 12 of their last 13, including at one point winning 10 in a row. A league-low 2.38 ERA has helped the RubberDucks win their last two series against Altoona and Richmond. Four of the Guardians' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- IF Kahlil Watson (No. 14), OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), RHP Andrew Walters (No. 25) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jordan Jones makes his first career Double-A start tonight in his 49th Double-A appearance. The 27-year-old is in his third season in Akron after serving as a reliever all of last year. Jones threw 63 innings last season and struck out 63 to a 2.00 ERA in 37 appearances. This season, Jones has thrown 10.2 innings in eight relief appearances but hasn't thrown more than two innings in an outing. Jones was drafted in the 16th round of the 2019 Draft by the Guardians out of the University of Washington.

HAYS IS HERE

Orioles outfielder Austin Hays begins his rehab assignment tonight. The 2023 AL All Star has been on the injured list since April 22 after suffering a left calf strain. The 28-year-old slashed .275/.325/.444 with 36 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs, 76 runs scored and 67 RBI last season. Hays was named to his first career All Star Game last year and started in center field. The former Baysox outfielder and No. 1 Orioles prospect played in Bowie from 2017-2019.

BASALLO HITS BOMBS

C Samuel Basallo enjoyed his best week of the season last week, thus far, in 2024. After driving in another run in the ninth on Saturday, the Orioles No. 2 prospect now has four home runs and 10 RBI over his last five games played. Basallo has three multi-hit games and three 3 RBI games over his last five played. The 19-year-old leads the Baysox in home runs and is tied for fifth in the league in home runs with five.

ON-BASE BOWENS

After doubling last night, 1B TT Bowens is currently on an 8-game hit and on-base streak, which is the longest active hit and on-base streak on the team. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is fourth in the Eastern League with 20 RBI. The undrafted free agent is sixth in the league in AVG (.324), fourth in SLG (.577) and fifth in OPS (.972).

SERVIN' IT UP

IF Anthony Servideo enjoyed arguably his best series so far at the plate this season against Erie. On Saturday, Servideo delivered his first three hit game of the season and homered for a second straight game. He was a triple shy of the cycle. In the series, the 25-year-old went 6-for-12 with two homers, three RBI, and eight runs scored. Servideo now has four career three-hit games.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox are one of just seven teams across all of Double-A to have won at least 10 games at home, thus far, and have won six of their last eight here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (90), first in home runs (21), and first in OPS (.827). Bowie clinched its third consecutive home series win after taking three of five against Erie.

READY FOR PHAM

RHP Alex Pham makes his sixth start of the season and his 15th career start at Double-A. Pham lasted just 3.2 innings on Tuesday in the series opener vs Erie, allowing four runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts in a no decision. All four runs were given up in the first inning, including surrendering two homers. The Orioles No. 24 prospect put up a 2.68 ERA at home last season over 23.2 innings pitched but so far this season, he has put up a 10.13 ERA over 10.2 innings at Prince George's Stadium. This will be Pham's third time facing the RubberDucks in his career.

2023: Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. In most recent start on 4/30 vs ERI, gave up four first inning runs, including two homers, but did not give up any more runs after first inning and pitched into fourth. Has a 10.13 ERA at home in three home starts. Looking for first career Double-A win.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
