PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

IT'S THE FINAL COUNTDOWN

With one game left in the regular season, an Omaha win to end the year would accomplish a pair of significant milestones.

- Omaha set the franchise record for wins in a season Tuesday, the club's 87th win of the year passed the 1990 Omaha Royals that went 86-50.
- A win today would also set the franchise's single-season record for winning percentage in a single season, passing the 1969 Omaha Royals at .607 (85-55), the only season with a winning % greater than .600 ... a win today will have Omaha's 2024 winning percentage end at .608, while a loss would drop it to .601, still the 2nd-best in a single-season for the Triple-A Omaha club.
- If Omaha wins today, it would not only win this week's series, but also would secure a winning record in September and give the 2024 Storm Chasers a winning record in every month of the regular season ... a loss would be the team's only losing month of the season and first losing month since August 2023.

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today 31 games over .500 with an overall 89-58 record (.605 winning percentage).

- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .605 winning percentage overall this year is the 8th-best in the Minors ... the Palm Beach Cardinals (Cardinals Single-A) are the best team in Minor League Baseball at 83-47 (.638 winning %).
- 89 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, behind Triple-A Sugar Land (92 wins) ... Omaha is 1 of 4 Minor League teams with 85+ wins.
- The Chasers were previously 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day between May 25 and September 6 ... Omaha also held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

86 of Omaha's 147 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (59%), including 34 of 58 losses in 2024 (58%), with 18 of 58 losses by just one run (31%).

- Omaha is 27-18 in 1-run games this season ... the Chasers are tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron leads the Minors with 33 wins by 1 run.
- Omaha's 40 saves are the 2nd-most in the International League, the 3rd-most at the Triple-A level and rank tied 5th in Minor League Baseball.
- Evan Sisk's 15 saves overall this year rank 4th in the International League ... Evan has 13 of the team's last 14 saves ... he is the 15th pitcher in Triple-A Omaha history to save 15 games in a season ... the last to do so was **Jesse Chavez**, with 16 saves in 2011, which represents the Storm Chasers-era record.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 792 to 656 this season, a +136 run differential.

- A +136 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level, well ahead of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (+123).
- Omaha is 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland Rockhounds lead the Minors in run differential at +180 (674 to 494).

LOUISVILLE SLUGGING

In the final week of the regular season, the Storm Chasers have been the International League's best team at the plate this week.

- 340 average leads the International League this week, with a few Storm Chasers hitters having an excellent week so far.
- Omaha leads the league this week in batting average (.340), on-base percentage (.391), slugging percentage (.631), OPS (1.022), hits (69), total bases (128), triples (4) and home runs (13), 2nd in runs scored (40) ... the AVG and 3B represent single-series bests for Omaha, while 35 strikeouts is the fewest in a 6-game series.
- Drew Waters** might be the league's Hitter of the Week, going the 13-for-23, with 4 doubles, 1 triple, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and 2 walks ... he has hits in all 5 games this series, with 4 straight 3-hit games through Saturday, the 2nd player the Minors to do so this year ... his 13 H & 25 TB this week are the most for an Omaha hitter in a series this year.
- 9 Omaha players have homered this week, of 15 that have taken a plate appearance in the series ... twice this year, 10 players have homered in a series ... **Cam Devanney**, **Tyler Gentry**, **Brian O'Keefe** and **Waters** each have 2 homers in Louisville.

TODAY'S START

- Guerrero is making his **5th start with Omaha**, his **25th overall start** this season and **27th appearance in 2024** ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Tyson made 22 appearances for the Naturals (20 starts) before being promoted to Omaha on Monday, August 29.
- In 2024, ranks 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in starts (24), tied 2nd in strikeouts (123) and 5th in innings pitched (120.0)... among qualified Royals full-season arms, ranks tied 2nd in opponents' average (.222), 7th in WHIP (1.28) and 8th in ERA (4.28).
- Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the **No. 27 Royals prospect** ... Ranked by Baseball America as the **No. 24 Royals prospect**.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 17 @ LOUISVILLE

Made his 4th Triple-A start and took his 1st win with Omaha, allowing just 1 run over 5.2 innings, with 7 strikeouts and 0 walks ... opened the game with 4.0 scoreless innings, with his first 7 retired and 1-2-3 innings in the 1st, 2nd and 4th innings ... allowed a 2-out solo homer to Francisco Urbazec in the 5th ... got the first two outs of the 6th inning, but also allowed a single, was removed with a runner on and two outs, did not get a chance to get the final out of the inning.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Over his first 14 appearances (12 starts in Double-A, pitched to a 5.88 ERA (37 ER in 56.2 IP) with a 1.48 WHIP and .264 opponents' batting average (.58-for-22) ... over his final 8 starts with the Naturals from July 6 to August 22, worked a 0.99 ERA (6 ER in 45.2 IP) with a 0.85 WHIP and .141 opponents' average (.22-for-156) and 41 strikeouts.
- Threw 6 quality starts with NW Arkansas (AA), including 5 straight between July 27 and August 16, with a pair of 7.0-inning starts in that span, 7/30 @ Wichita (MIN) and 8/16 vs. Corpus Christi (HOU).
- Pitched 5 scoreless starts with NWA, including 3 straight from July 24 to August 4, part of a career-best 22.0-inning scoreless streak.
- Named the Texas League's Pitcher of the Week for his effort the week of August 3-10 ... threw 2 quality starts and 13.0 scoreless innings on the road against the Wichita Wind Surge ... allowed just 3 hits and 3 walks with 11 strikeouts.

CAREER NOTES
