#### RIDERS FALL IN CLOSE OPENER TO WIND SURGE:

RIDERS FALL IN CLOSE OPENER TO WIND SURGE:

Alejandro Osuna hit a solo home run and an RBI triple, but the Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series opener versus the Wichita Wind Surge 5-4 on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field. In the top of the fourth, Wichita (13-9) struck first when Kala'i Rosario flipped a sacrifice fly to put the Wind Surge up 1-0. Frisco (14-8) answered in the bottom of the fifth when Osuna ripped an RBI triple to tie the game at 1-1, his second three-bagger of the season. Wichita then regained the lead in the top of the seventh when Olivar hit a two-run single to take a 3-1 lead. In the top of the eighth, Ben Ross hit an RBI double and Kyler Fedko hit an RBI single to put the Wind Surge in front 5-2. Osuna came through again in the last of the eighth when he corked a solo home run, his second long ball of the season, to cut the Wichita lead to 5-2. The Riders rallied in the bottom of the ninth when Keyber Rodriguez poked a two-run single to put Frisco within a run. Wichita reliever Cody Lawyerson then struck out Frainyer Chavez to secure his third save of the season. Wind Surge reliever Jarret Whorff (1-1) picked up the win while RoughRiders reliever Travis MacGregor (0-1) took the loss. Frisco starter Daniel Missaki spun four innings, allowing just one run on one hit while striking out four.

Over the season, the RoughRiders have had solid starting pitching, ranking fourth in the league with a 4.02 ERA from their starters. In their last seven games, the starting pitching has been even better, owning a 2.30 ERA (7ER/27.1IP). Starters **Trey Supak**, **Kohl Drake**, **Josh Stephan** and **Mitch Bratt** have combined for a 3.04 ERA (23ER/68IP) this season.

STRIKING UP STRIKEOUTS:
This week at Corpus Christi, Frisco's pitching staff has whiffed 91 batters through seven games (13.0 per game). That is the best in Minor League Baseball among teams' last seven games. Over the last seven games, the Riders 2.95 ERA is first in the Texas League and 13th in Minor League Baseball.

SCORE, SCORE SOME MORE:
Outfielder Alejandro Osuna is off to a great start scoring runs in 2025. Osuna's 21 runs scored are tied for the most in franchise history through 22 games played, Osuna's 21 runs scored are also the most in the Texas League this season. The outfielder is currently on an 12-game hitting streak, batting .370 (17-for-46)/.436/.565/1.001 with 11 runs scored in the 12 games with five walks to four strikeouts

**KEYBERRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE: Keyber Rodriguez** has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 17 games this season, he is hitting .328 (20-for-61)/.394/410/.804. In his last nine games, he is slashing .382 (3-for-34)/.432/.500/.932 with one double, a home run, six RBIs, two runs scored, three walks and four stolen bases. Over the season, he has four multi-hit games.

LITTLE SEBASTIAN? BIG SEBASTIAN:
Top prospect Sebastian Walcott has been off to an incredible start with the RoughRiders. The 19-year-old is the second-youngest player in the Texas League in 2025. During an 14-game on-base streak, which ended on Tuesday, he hit. 313 (15-for-48)/.469/.521/.990 with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBIs, 14 walks, 13 runs scored. After striking out 10 times to two walks in his first six games, he has walked 14 times while striking out 13 times in his last 15 games. His .802 OPS through the first 22 team games is the eighth-best in Double-A as 19-year-old since 2005 (min. 50 ABs).

**POWER BRINGS WINS:**The RoughRiders have shown off their punch to begin the season and have been great on offense during their first 22 games. Frisco's 22 home runs through 22 games are second in the Texas League. While the power has been substantial, Frisco has faltered on offense recently. In their last 13 games, Frisco is just hitting .225/.318/.343/.661 while scoring 4.4 runs per game (5th in the league).

HATCHIN' HITTIN':
Josh Hatcher was incredible for the RoughRiders in 2024 and he has picked up right where he left off in 2025. Hatcher hit .300/.350/.448/.798 over 107 games with Frisco last season. He was one of just three qualified hitters in all of Double-A baseball to hit .300 or better. To start 2025, he reached safely in all 15 of 18 games he's played in, batting .342 (26-for-76)/.350/.566/.916 with five doubles, four home runs, 19 RBIs, a stolen base and 12 runs scored. His .342 batting average is tied for second in the Texas League. Hatcher already has eight multi-hit games and is 7-for-13 when putting the first pitch of an at-bat in play with two home runs.

<u>VERSUS THE WIND SURGE</u>:
The Riders have gone 17-19 against Wichita in the Wind Surge's five seasons in the Texas League. Last season, Frisco went 7-5 against the Twins affiliate, owning a 3.33 ERA as a team. In 12 games, Frisco allowed just five home runs. The Riders took down the Wind Surge in the 2022 Texas League Championship Series, sweeping them in two games.

#### **ABOUT KOHL**

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins. Knapp is now at UNC, but will miss the whole season with Tommy John Surgery.

#### 2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
