TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) get ready for the series finale at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark on Sunday. The E-Train fell 10-9 on Saturday night. Round Rock opened the game with three straight doubles to take a 2-0 lead, but Oklahoma City tied it by the third and went up 4-3 in the sixth. The Express answered with four runs in the seventh to grab a 7-4 lead, only to see the Comets tie it again at 7-7. Round Rock briefly went back in front 9-7, but 1B Ryan Ward smacked a walk-off three-run homer in the ninth to give Oklahoma City a 10-9 win.

ONE-RUN PAIN

Round Rock has lost all three games this week in Oklahoma City by one-run and five of their last six losses have been by a run. The Express dropped to 1-6 in one-run games on the season. They own a -14 run differential this year. Salt Lake has the same record as the Express and owns a -48 run differential.

START TO THE YEAR

Round Rock's 4-10 start is tied for their worst start through 14 games since 2018 and the second fewest wins through 14 games in club history (3-11 in 2003). It's the third time the Express have opened a campaign 4-10 (2009, 2010). A loss today would be tied for the worst 15-game start in franchise history (4-11 in 2003, 2009, 2018).

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST

Round Rock posted a season-high nine runs on Saturday. They rallied for four runs in the seventh inning which is the first time they have scored more than three runs in an inning this year. The E-Train have a .279 batting average (50-179) in this series and they are averaging 10 hits per game. They entered this series averaging 6.8 hits per game on the year. Entering Saturday, the Express were 4-1 in games where they score more than five runs.

WALK IT OUT

Round Rock issued a season-high 10 walks last night. The Express entered yesterday with the second-lowest walk per nine-inning figure in Triple-A (3.56). Despite the walks, Round Rock relievers are eighth in the PCL in ERA (3.82) and eighth in WHIP (1.33).

ZAVALA ZINGERS

OF Aaron Zavala went 2-for-4 with a double, two runs scored, an RBI and a walk. It's his first multi-hit game of the season. He has reached base in each of his last three games and is 3-for-10 with two doubles, an RBI, three runs scored, four walks and a strikeout. All four baseballs Zavala put in play were over 95 mph.

DEATH, TAXES AND FOSS

INF Justin Foscoe has reached safely in 13 consecutive games, while recording a hit in 12 of the 13. The 13-game on-base streak is third in the league. Foscoe finished Saturday 2-for-6 with a double, an RBI and a run scored.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - WEDNESDAY, APRIL 12, 1989

In his second outing as a member of the Texas Rangers, 42-year-old Nolan Ryan flirted with his sixth no-hitter against the Milwaukee Brewers at Milwaukee County Stadium. Ryan tossed 8.0 innings of one-hit baseball with two walks and 15 strikeouts on a cold, 40-degree evening. Ryan had a perfect game into the seventh inning before walking Robin Yount. In the eighth inning, 30-year-old Terry Francona ended the no-hit bid with an opposite-field single. Francona was in the lineup due to an injury to regular first baseman Greg Brock.

After the game, Ryan discussed the pitch to Francona: "The location was more of a problem than the pitch itself. He's had good at-bats against me." Francona heard Ryan's comment and said, "Let's put it this way--when I read his name in the pitching probables, I don't run to the ballpark."

Ryan's 15 strikeouts set a Rangers team record. Ruben Sierra continued his monster start to the 1989 season, going 4-for-4 with two doubles, a home run and two RBI, while Julio Franco drove in four runs with a 3-for-4 day. Rob Deer accounted for two of Ryan's 15 strikeouts. After the game, he discussed watching Ryan growing up: "I remember as clear as day going to Anaheim as a kid and watching him pitch no-hitters. He's one of a kind. The amazing thing is that he got by all night without his curveball. He couldn't get it over and just went with his fastball and changeup."

While Ryan did not throw a complete game, he had 10 complete-game one-hitters entering this outing and threw his sixth no-hitter at the age of 43 in 1990.
