In the losing cause, **Grant Judkins** celebrated his 27th birthday with four hitless innings, striking out seven.

Congratulations: The Midland RockHounds swept the Texas League's Honors of the Month, with 2022 Nut **Denzel Clarke** named the Player of the Month, slashing .371/.436/.671, led the league in average (.371), stolen bases (10), slugging percentage (.671), OPS (1.107) and triples (four), and 2022-23 Nut **Blake Beers** winning Pitcher of the Month: 3-0, 1.50 ERA in four starts, four earned runs on 15 hits and two walks over 24.0 innings, while holding opponents to a .176 average, and a league-leading 0.71 WHIP. Last night served as an encore: Clarke went 4-for-4 with a double and a triple while Beers tossed six scoreless two-hit innings with seven strikeouts in a 4-1 victory over Frisco.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the Midwest League in at-bats (3,427), base hits (858), total bases (1,306) and triples (35); 2nd in batting average (.250), runs (514), doubles (168) and OPS (.720); and 3rd in slugging percentage (.381) and on-base percentage (.339).

Independence Day Back Home: The 2025 Lugnuts home schedule was released this week! After hosting Michigan State University in the Crosstown Showdown on Tuesday, April 1, the Nuts open the 2025 home campaign on Tuesday, April 8, with the start of a six-game series with the Great Lakes Loons, concluding on Sunday, August 31, with the finale of a six-game series against the Lake County Captains. The schedule also sees the Fort Wayne TinCaps come to Jackson Field on the 4th of July, returning Independence Day baseball to Lansing after a one-year hiatus, the first year without the 4th since 2008.

The Future is Here: Lugs right-hander **Luis Morales**, tomorrow's starting pitcher, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

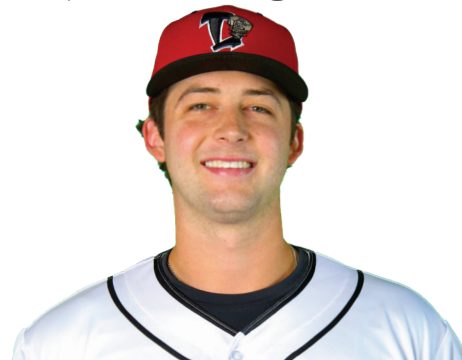

In a Nutshell: Pitched in 2023 with the Nuts, returning to the Midwest League this season... spent the offseason training in Alabama with Tyler Baum... opened the season in a tandem with Opening Day starter James González... González was promoted on May 8, so Myers made the next four starts without a piggybacker... has since pitched in tandems with Chen Zhang-Ao Zhuang, Grant Judkins and Wander Guante... notable splits:
 - Home: 3.12 ERA, 49 IP, 1.12 WHIP, .241 avg. | Road: 5.46, 29 2/3, 1.58 WHIP, .306 avg.
 - Starter: 4.28 ERA, 54 2/3 IP, 1.39 WHIP, .285 avg | Relief: 3.38, 24 IP, 1.08 WHIP, .222
 - vs. Left: .302/.349/.403, 4 HR, 12 BB, 29 K | vs. Right: .230/.278/.355, 4 HR, 7 BB, 43 K

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Monkey Ball*... he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.

Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.
