**Today's Game**  
The Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, Double-A affiliate of the Toronto Blue Jays. It is the ninth-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-12 games at FirstEnergy Stadium. The Fightin Phils won the first series between the teams 4-2 from May 13-18. Reading heads to New Hampshire from Aug. 5-10. The season-series is tied at four games a piece.

**Game 57 Recap**  
It was another one-run affair the Fightin Phils were on the wrong side of Wednesday night. Braeden Fausnaughtb started and allowed one-earned run over six innings, with four strikeouts. New Hampshire scored two runs in the third inning, with one being on a solo homne run from Eddinson Paulino and the other being an unearned run following an error by Carson DeMartini and a dropped fly ball. Felix Reyes homered in the fourth to make it 2-1. Reading then took the lead with two runs in the sixth, thanks to back-to-back triples from Hendry Mendez and Felix Reyes. The Fisher Cats re-took the lead with three runs in the seventh off Andrew Bechtold to make it 5-3. The Fightin Phils scored a run in the eighth and had another taken away when Alex Binelas was thrown out at home trying to tie the game at five in the eighth inning. Reading was not able to scratch across a run in the ninth and fell 5-4.

**It's Been Close**  
Entering Thursday, all eight matchups this season have been decided by one run between Reading and New Hampshire. It has been as even of a series matchup. with each team winning four-of-eight games so far. The Fightin Phils have struggled with RISP this week, going a combined four-for-32 (.125).

**It's Miller Time**  
Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller continues to be a threat on the base paths. After two-more stolen bases on Wednesday night, Miller is alone in first place in the Eastern League with 24 stolen bases, three clear of second place. In the Phillies organization, Miller is second, behind Oscar Mercado, who has 25.

**Trip Trip Triples**  
The Fightin Phils set a new season-high with two triples in Wednesday night's game. It was the first time Reading hit two triples in a game since Aug. 20, 2024, at Binghamton. Felix Reyes became the first R-Phil with multiple triples this season as he has one in back-to-back games he's played in, after tripleing on Sunday at Harssiburg. Hendry Mendez and Reyes had triples in back-to-back at bats in the sixth inning on Wednesday night.

**Moore Doubles Please**  
Robert Moore hit two-more doubles on Wednesday night, giving him two-straight nights with a pair of doubles. It was the third two-double game of the season, with the other instance outside of Tuesday and Wednesday, being May 7 at Binghamton. Moore is the first Fightin Phil to double in back-to-back games since Johan Rojas did it from Sept. 1-2, of the 2022 season.

**Beer, Beer, Beer**  
Seth Beer has turned it on as of late for the Fightin Phils. Following a stretch in which he went 0-for-27 over seven games (May 23-June 3), Beer has followed that with hits in five-straight games from June 4. Over the last five games, Beer is 7-19, which is good for a .368 average. Beer has two hits in two-straight games.

**Hall of Fame Night in Baseballtown**  
Thursday night will feature the enshrinement of the 2025 Hall of Fame Class in Reading. It is the first Hall of Fame induction since Carlos Ruiz was inducted in 2021. Dusty Wathan, Darin Ruf and Trevor May are featured in this year's class. Wathan managed the R-Phils from 2012-16 and is the winningest manager in Reading baseball history. Wathan went on to be hired as the Phillies third base coach following the 2017 season and has held that post for eight seasons now. Ruf played for the Fightin Phils in 2012 and hit a then-franchise record 38 home runs. Ruf made his big-league debut with the Phillies in 2012 and remained with the team until 2016. May led the Eastern League with 151 strikeouts in 2012 with Reading. Following the season, May was traded to the Twins in the Ben Revere trade and he remained with Minnesota until 2020.

**This Day in Baseballtown History**  
**June 12, 2006:** At Philadelphia's Citizen Bank Park, Brandon Gemoll's double drives home Angel Chavez with the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th as Reading beats Altoona, 5-4. Joey Hammond goes 4-for-5 with a home run and three RBI for Reading.

**Here Come the Cats**  
New Hampshire enters tonight with a 27-31 record, which is fourth in the Northeast Division and 12.5 games out of first place. The Fisher Cats were home against Altoona last week and took five-of-six games, shutting out the Curve in the first four contests. After this week, New Hampshire hosts the Somerset Patriots. New Hampshire's roster has six players on the Blue Jays' top-30 prospects list (MLB Pipeline): Trey Yesavage (2), Charles McAdoo (12), Juaron Watts-Brown (15), Jace Bohrofen (22), Dasan Brown (27) and Peyton Williams (28).

**Pitching for the Fisher Cats**  
Righty, and Blue Jays' No. 2 prospect, Trey Yesavage makes his Double-A debut tonight. Yesavage made seven starts with Dunedin (A) and four with Vancouver (A+), combining to go 4-0, with a 2.13 ERA (12 ER, 50.2 IP). He last pitched last Friday at Tri-City earning the win, allowing one run over five innings, with nine strikeouts. Yesavage was a first round pick (20th overall) of the Blue Jays out of East Carolina in 2024. He played for the Pirates from 2022-24, posting a 2.03 ERA and 11-1 record in 2024, striking out 145 over 93.1 IP (13.93 SO/9.0 IP). Yesavage played at Boyertown High School and was born in Pottstown.

**LAST START:** 6/6 at HBG: ND, 6.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 HR, 1 BB, 7 SO, 90 pitches (62 strikes)... The Fightin Phils lost to Harrisburg, 3-2, at FNB Field. Cabrera matched a season-high with six innings pitched for the third time this season and surpassed 90 pitches for just the second instance. He surrendered just one walk for the third-straight outing as his command continues to improve. After posting scoreless frames in the first and second, Cabrera ran into some trouble in the third. He hit Jonathan Thomas to begin the inning and after a strikeout, Thomas stole second and took third on a throwing error. He allowed two singled and then a wild pitch scored the second run of the inning. Cabrera settled in though to finish the start with three-straight scoreless innings before giving way to the bullpen. Cabrera was relieved by Josh Hejka in the bottom of the seventh inning.

### 2025 Season:

- Prior to the 2025 season, Cabrera was added to the Phillies 40-man roster (on 11/19/24) to protect him from the Rule-5 Draft; optioned to Reading (AA) on March 8
- Appeared in relief for the Phillies in the Spring Breakout Game (3/14 vs PIT) and tossed two innings following Moises Chace, who started the game
- Opened the season ranked as the Phillies No. 11 Prospect (MLB Pipeline)
- Tabbed as Reading's Opening Day starter Apr. 4 vs Portland (ND, 4.2 IP, 2 H, ER, 4 BB, 3 SO)
- Lone win of season Apr. 16 vs Binghamton (5.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 7 SO)
- Season-high six innings on three occasions: Apr. 22 at Portland, May 8 at Binghamton and June 6 at Harrisburg
- May 8 at BNG: 6.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 SO; eight strikeouts was season-high
- Walked season (and career-high) five batters twice: May 1 vs HBG and May 20 at POR
- Issued season-low one walk in three-straight starts: May 25 at POR, May 31 vs ERI and June 6 at HBG
- Posted seven strikeouts June 6 at Harrisburg, which was tied for his second-most in a game this season
- Over five home games, has a 3.55 ERA (10 ER, 25.1 IP), compared to 4.18 ERA (15 ER, 32.1 IP) across five away contests
- Holding RHH to .164/.270/.221 (.491 OPS) slash line
- Wish RISP, opposing hitters are slashing .167/.250/.250 (.500 OPS)
- Entering the week, Cabrera ranked T-8th in the Eastern League in strikeouts (54), 3rd IP (57.2) and 5th in BAA (.200)
- Entering the week, was tied for the most walks issued in the Eastern League (33)

### 2024 Season:

- Began season with Jersey Shore (A+), where he made 14 starts prior to promotion to Reading (AA) on July 9
- Limited LHH to a .190/.261/.286 (.547 OPS) slash line
- Fanned a career-high 14 batters on July 12 vs Wilmington, which was the second-most strikeouts in BlueClaws history
- Collected first Double-A win on Aug. 23 at Binghamton, in his final start of the season
- Over five April starts, posted a 2.25 ERA (7 ER, 28.0 IP)

### CAREER:

- Spent 2023 with Clearwater (A), where he ranked second in the FSL with 3.91 SO/BB ratio
- Also spent all of 2022 with Clearwater, striking out 23.9% of hitters faced
- Recipient of Paul Owens Award in 2021, becoming first 19-year old pitcher to win it since Carlos Carrasco in 2006
