THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On August 5, 2013, the Sounds scored two runs in the bottom of the ninth inning to defeat the Tucson Padres, 5-4. Eugenio Velez tied the game with two outs on a base hit up the middle. Sean Halton's walk-off single to left field scored Khris Davis to win the game for the Sounds.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Toledo Mud Hens play game four of a seven-game series tonight. The Sounds scored five runs in the second inning and six runs in the fifth inning on their way to an 11-7 win in game two of a doubleheader at First Horizon Park Wednesday night. The win earned the Sounds a doubleheader split after dropping the first game, 5-2. Left-hander Aaron Ashby will start for Nashville against right-hander Logan Shore for the Mud Hens.

Aaron Ashby: 23-year-old Aaron Ashby makes his 20th appearance (11th start) for the Sounds tonight. In 56.1 innings, Ashby has allowed 53 hits and ranks second in the Triple-A East with 87 strikeouts. He last pitched on July 31 against Columbus and allowed one run on one hit and struck out six in 3.2 innings. Despite the solid outing, Ashby was tagged with his fourth loss. In Ashby's 2019 campaign, he went 5-10 with a 3.50 ERA in 24 games (23 starts) with Advanced-A Carolina and Single-A Wisconsin. He was named the Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Year and a Mid-Season Midwest League All-Star. He spent 2020 at the Brewers Alternate Training Site.

Logan Shore: 26-year-old Logan Shore makes his seventh start for Toledo tonight. The right-hander is making his first start for the Mud Hens since June 8 vs. Louisville. He faced the Sounds on May 7 and gave up four runs on four hits in 2.2 innings and took the loss. In 2019, Shore went 4-7 with a 3.43 ERA in 23 games (16 starts) with Double-A Erie. The Minnesota native was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 2nd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 51, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Let's Play the AL: After Nashville's doubleheader split, the Sounds are 21-11 against American League affiliates compared to 25-23 against National League affiliates. The designated hitter spot in the Nashville lineup has hit .275 (30-for-109) with 9 doubles, 5 home runs, 16 RBI and 25 walks with an OPS of .914.

Couple of Big Innings: In game two of last night's doubleheader, the Sounds scored five runs in the second inning and six runs in the fifth. It was the sixth time the offense has scored five runs in a frame (last - 9th inning, 6/23 vs. Charlotte) and the fourth time they have scored six in an inning (last - 10th inning, 7/21 at Jacksonville).

Ashby Splits: Aaron Ashby will make his 11th appearance at First Horizon Park tonight, the left-hander has struggled at home going 2-3 with a 9.25 ERA (25 ER/24.1 IP). When pitching away from First Horizon Park, Ashby is 3-1 with a 1.69 ERA (6 ER/32.0 IP) and has 53 strikeouts.

Turang's Promotion: Infielder Brice Turang received a promotion to Nashville from Double-A Biloxi Tuesday. Turang batted .264 (76-for-288) with 40 runs, 14 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs and 39 RBI in 73 games with the Shuckers. He played shortstop in all but two of those games in which he served as the designated hitter. The California native was drafted by the Brewers in the first round (21st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft. He entered the season as Milwaukee's #2 prospect according to both Baseball America and MLB Pipeline.

Loud Bark: Luke Barker delivered another scoreless inning in game two of the doubleheader last night. He has allowed just two earned runs since the start of July, going 2-1 with a 1.65 ERA and 17 strikeouts. He is holding opponents to a .193 average and has a 0.73 WHIP.

Another Rehab Assignment: Right-handed pitcher Justin Topa had his MLB rehab assignment transferred to Nashville from Double-A Biloxi Saturday. Topa is the 13th Brewer to join the Sounds on rehab assignment this year. The list includes Josh Lindblom, Jace Peterson, Derek Fisher, Tim Lopes, Daniel Robertson, Christian Yelich, Eric Yardley, Bobby Wahl, Angel Perdomo, Lorenzo Cain, Travis Shaw and Daniel Vogelbach.

Wilson's Red-Hot July: Infielder Weston Wilson had an impressive month of July at the plate. In 26 games, Wilson batted .310 (27-for-87) with 19 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs, 21 RBI, 10 walks and 4 stolen bases. In the month of July, Wilson was among Triple-A East League leaders in home runs (T-3rd), RBI (T-6th), slugging percentage (.611, 8th), runs (T-9th) and total bases (55, T-10th).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,077-1,956. The 2,077 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
