

#### Leading Off

Tonight, Reading continues a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats. The R-Phils lead the season series 7-6 after last night's win. Righty Tyler Phillips gets the start opposite Case Williams.

#### **Looking Back**

Reading turned in its best all-around effort of the season in a 14-2 win over Hartford last night. Victor Vargas was excellent, allowing zero-earned runs over six innings. The offense matched a season-high with 14 runs scored, which included eight multi-hit games and five home runs. Reading scored ten runs on nine hits in the fourth inning, its first double-digit inning since Apr. 17, 2012 at Richmond.

#### De La Cruzin'

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 28-game on-streak and is hitting .294 over that stretch, which dates back to May 12. Overall, De La Cruz is hitting .293 on the season, which ranks 10th in the Eastern League.

#### Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he hit .423 last week and is .482 against Hartford so far. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks fourth in the Eastern League with a .307 average.

#### A Look at Last Night

Reading matched a season-high with 14 runs and fell one-hit shy of a season-high in hits. The ten-run fourth was a season high for runs in an inning and most in a frame in 11 years. Victor Vargas went a season-high six innings, which also matched an R-Phils season high. Ethan Wilson hit two home runs, which is the second time an R-Phils' has done that this season with the last being Rojas on May 28 vs Harrisburg. It was the first time Reading won a game by 10-or-more runs since Sept. 9, 2022 vs New Hampshire. Matthew Kroon, Ethan Wilson and Casey Martin all had multiple hits in the fourth inning, and Kroon had multiple extra-base hits in the frame. Finally, Martin made his double-A debut with Reading last night and had two hits, two RBI, while also flashing stellar defensive play at the shortstop position.

#### Around the Organization

Last night, the Phillies beat the Diamondbacks 15-3 and continue a four-game series tonight at 9:40. Lehigh Valley fell to Toledo last night 8-7 at home, but Christian Pache had two hits, a home run and four RBI. Jersey Shore fell 7-0 at Wilmington and only had four hits, with two of them coming from Marcus Lee Sang. Clearwater beat Tampa 10-4 to improve to a Florida State League best 41-16 on the season. Lastly, the FCL Phillies fell 9-8 to the FCL Blue Jays, but Baron Radcliff had a hit as he continues his rehab back after an April injury.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

June 14, 1911: At Lauer's Park in Reading, pitcher George "Jake" Northrop throws the first perfect game in Reading baseball history as the Pretzels defeat Lancaster, 8-0, in a Tri-State League contest. Northrop strikes out the final five Red Roses to end the game.

This is the third series of the season between Reading and Hartford. The Yard Goats currently sit in fifth in the Northeast Standings, two games ahead of Reading. Last week, Hartford dropped five-of-six games to Somerset at home, winning on Wednesday. After this week, the Yard Goats return home to host Erie for a six-game series to close the first half. Reading is hitting .331 against Hartford this season.

#### Goat on the Bump

Righty Case Williams gets his third start of the season against Reading, where he is 0-1, with 11 earned runs allowed over 8.2 innings pitched. Reading roughed him up for eight runs over three innings on May 3. Tonight is his tenth start, and Williams is 1-5, with a 7.59 ERA. Williams hasn't pitched since May 26, due to an IL stint. At Altoona that day, he went four innings, allowing two runs on five hits in a no decision.
