LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn snapped a 3-game losing streak with a 8-5 win over Hudson Valley...Renegades jumped out to a 2-0 lead through one and a half innings and led 4-1 entering the bottom of the 4th...Cyclones took the lead with 5 runs in the bottom of the 5th...CF **Alex Ramírez** and LF **Ryan Clifford** ripped game-tying singles before RF **Stanley Consuegra** cranked a go-ahead, 3-run home run...Consuegra also added a solo home run in the 2nd inning...C **Drake Osborn** added a solo blast in the 7th...Ramírez, Clifford, 3B **Jacob Reimer**, Consuegra, 1B **William Lugo**, and 2B **D'Andre Smith** all registered multi-hit games...SS **Jared Serna**, C **Antonio Gómez**, LF **Christopher Familia**, and DH **Grant Richardson** all accrued multiple knocks for Hudson Valley...RHP **Jace Beck** (2.2 IP) and RHP **Joshua Cornielly** (2.1) combined for 5.0 innings of 1-run relief to earn the win and save, respectively.

I'M A FANCY BOY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** fancied himself another multi-home run game in Brooklyn's win over Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 22-year-old blasted a solo home run off RHP **Leonardo Pestana** in the bottom of the 2nd and added a go-ahead, 3-run clout off LHP **Joel Valdez** in the bottom of the 5th...The multi-home run night marked the second of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C **Kevin Parada** (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only two players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF **Nick Evans** accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs. Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Saturday, Consuegra (21) is one home run behind C **Francisco Álvarez** (22) for Brooklyn's all-time home run record.

HELLO, CLIFFORD! OF **Ryan Clifford** was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF **Drew Gilbert** from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP **Justin Verlander** on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Saturday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.513)...Greenville's INF **Blaze Jordan** (.533) is 1st...He is also tied for 3rd in home runs (18) and 4th in OPS (.857)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.257), and 6th in wOBA (.378) and wRC+ (129).

WANT TO GET NUTS? LET'S GET NUTS!: In 29 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhylan Thomas** has put up bonker numbers...He is slashing .360/.409/.460 with a .869 OPS at the dish and a 140 wRC+...Thomas has added 13 runs scored, 4 doubles, 2 home runs, 13 RBI, and 9 walks to only 7 strikeouts...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .370/.414/.494 with a .908 OPS and 150 wRC+ in 23 games...Thomas already has more RBI (13) than he did in St. Lucie (9) in 16 fewer plate appearances (139 to 123)...Since the start of July, Thomas ranks 2nd in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.350) and has 4 fewer strikeouts (8) than any other batter (min. 100 PA).

THE SUMMER OF JETT AND JACOB: INFs **Jett Williams** and **Jacob Reimer** made their Cyclones debuts on August 1 and have been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .320/.480/.567 with a 1.047 OPS, 18 runs scored, 11 doubles, 2 triples, 3 home runs, 8 RBI, 29 walks, and 12 stolen bases in 29 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...On the season, Williams is 8th in Minor League Baseball in walks (83)...Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in MiLB...Since June 1, Reimer has recorded a .297/.433/.448 slash line with a .881 OPS, 36 runs scored, 8 doubles, 6 home runs, 32 RBI, 34 walks, and 9 hit-by-pitches in 52 games between 3 levels in the Mets' system.

IT'S REAL AND IT'S SPECTACULAR: INF **Jacob Reimer** collected 4 hits — all singles — a run scored and an RBI in Brooklyn's loss to Hudson Valley on Friday night...The 4 knocks were a career-high...Reimer became the first teenager to record 4-or-more hits for the Cyclones in a single game since INF **Gavin Cecchini** accomplished the feat twice on August 17, 2013, vs. Vermont and on August 3 at Jamestown...IB **Nick Evans** is the only other teenager to accomplish the feat since 2005...He went 4-for-4 vs. Staten Island on September 1, 2005...Reimer is the youngest of the three to accrue a 4-hit night.

IS THAT A TITLEST?: OF **Alex Ramírez** is shooting for the number top spot like a hole in one and is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native passed INF **Luke Ritter** (80) for 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 8 (83) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (36), is 2nd in total bases (228) and hits (155), tied for 2nd in walks (68), and 3rd in runs scored (81).

MAN HAND-LED: RHP **Joander Suárez** continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...With his 7 strikeouts vs. Hudson Valley on Friday night, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is now tied with RHP **Blade Tidwell** for the franchise single-season record in strikeouts with 112...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen last Friday night...Over his last 11 appearances (10 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.73 ERA (21 ER in 50.2 IP), 15 walks (7.1 BB%), and 73 strikeouts (34.4 K%)....Narrowed down to his last 7 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.16 ERA (13 ER in 37.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.2 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (35.1 K%)....Since the start of July, Suárez ranks 2nd among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (57) trailing only Greensboro's RHP **Thomas Harrington** (59).

THAT'S A SHAME: RHP **Joander Suárez** put hitters to shame and became the 5th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 11 IronBirds last Friday night...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen last Wednesday, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has had more pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frías** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

THESE PRETZELS ARE MAKING ME THIRSTY: Between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie, LHP **Eli Ankeney** has left batters thirsting for knocks and has accrued a 1.51 ERA (6 ER in 35.2 IP) in 23 appearances (1 start)...Among Minor League pitchers with 35.0-plus innings pitched and 1-or-fewer starts, Ankeney is 9th in ERA (1.51)...Ankeney is also tied for 2nd in the fewest hits allowed (17)...Since making his Brooklyn debut on June 3 at Jersey Shore, the Phoenix, Ariz. native is 2nd among South Atlantic League relievers with 25.0-plus IP in hits allowed (15), 3rd in ERA (2.03), and 4th in batting average against (.167).

JIMMY CRACK CORN-IELLY: RHP **Joshua Cornielly** has hit his stride for the Cyclones' bullpen...Since allowing 5 runs in 0.1 innings on April 15 at Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has been as

vs. WAPPINGERS FALLS: Brooklyn continues a 2-week homestand with 6 games against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Bubble Boys possess 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Spencer Jones** (6), INF **Jared Serna** (17), and LHP **Brock Selvidge** (29)...Brooklyn and Wappingers Falls are meeting at Maimonides Park for the 2nd and final time and the first time since Brooklyn captured 4-of-6 from June 20-25...The Pretty Boys are 13-9 (.591) against the Bubble Boys in the first 22 meetings of the campaign...Dating back to their first meeting in 2001, Brooklyn is 139-143 all-time against Wappingers Falls (.493).

consistent as any relief arm on the staff...Dating back to April 21 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly holds a 2-2 record with a 2.18 ERA (10 ER in 41.1 IP) and 1 save in 23 appearances (1 start)...The Caracas, Venezuela native has permitted 33 hits, walked 11 (6.5 BB%), and struck out 49 (29.2 K%)....Since July 30 vs. Wilmington, Cornielly has made 5-straight scoreless appearances...The right-hander has not allowed a run on 3 hits over his last 9.1 innings without issuing a walk and striking out 10 (32.3 K%).

FESTIVUS FOR THE REST OF US: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 3.12 ERA (243 ER in 700.0 IP) over their last 80 games, holding a 44-36 record in that span...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.36) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 2nd in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.7% and a walk rate of 10.7%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 2nd lowest opposing OPS (.623), in addition to the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (6.98) and batting average against (.212) in that period.

LIKE DATING MAD LIBS: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at finishing off games like a game of Mad Libs in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.39) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 3rd-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.17) leads MiLB and Hudson Valley (3.60) is 2nd in the SAL...5 of the top 20 SAL relievers in ERA (min. 20.0 IP) have pitched for the Cyclones this year...RHP **Benito García** (0.76, 1st), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (1.17; 3rd), RHP **Brendan Hardy** (1.61, 6th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (1.72, 8th), and LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.85; 12th).

VANDELAY INDUSTRIES: Brooklyn's looking to manufacture a second-straight playoff appearance and has dropped just 1 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-1-2 in their last 9 sets...The Cyclones are 27-19 in the second half and are tied atop the North Division of the SAL with Jersey Shore (27-19) and 20 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

THE R-C WAS ANGRY THAT DAY, MY FRIENDS: RHP **Robert Colina** has been on a tear since he struck out a season-high 7 on June 21 vs. Hudson Valley, which was matched on August 1 at Jersey Shore...After matching a season-high 5.1 innings in his start on Tuesday, Colina holds a 3-1 record with a 2.34 ERA (9 ER in 34.2 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 27 hits and walked 6 with 42 strikeouts over his last 9 appearances (4 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 2.9 percent (31.3 K%) and the walk rate is down 2.8 percent (4.5 BB%) during the period.

NICE GAME, PRETTY BOYS: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

YADA, YADA, YADA, ANOTHER SHUTOUT: Brooklyn collected their 10th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking of Aberdeen last Sunday afternoon...LHP **Joey Lucchesi** (4.2 IP), RHP **Paul Gervase** (3.1), and LHP **Eli Ankeney** (1.0) combined on a 3-hitter...On Friday night, 2 different pitchers combined on a 3-hit, 5-0 shutout...RHPs **Joander Suárez** (6.0 IP) and **Brendan Hardy** (3.0) united to blank the IronBirds...4 of Brooklyn's 10 shutouts have come against Aberdeen...With Sunday's performance, the Cyclones have tied the franchise record for shutouts in a single season with 10...Before 2023, it had happened on 4 separate occasions...It last happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 10 shutouts are tied for 5th-most in all of Minor League Baseball and tied for 2nd among South Atlantic League squads.


I LOVE A GOOD NAP: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (118), Mariners farmhand OF **Jonatan Clásé** (116), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (114), D'Backs prospect OF **Wilderd Patiño** (114), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (111), and Cardinals prospect OF **Mike Antico** (109) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 48.

Allowed 5 runs on 8 hits over 2.2 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 2...Tossed a wild pitch...Hurled 55 pitches and 35 strikes (63.6%)...Relieved by RHP **Luis A. Rodríguez** with a man at 2nd and 2 out in the top of the 3rd and St. Lucie trailing 5-2...Palm Beach held on to defeat the Mets, 10-7.

ON THE MEND: Geber is set to make his first appearance with Brooklyn since landing on the 7-day injured list on May 14...The 24-year-old joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on July 19...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 6.75 ERA (4 ER in 5.1 IP) with 6 strikeouts over 3 appearances (2 starts)...Rehab transferred Single-A St. Lucie on August 6...Went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (8 ER in 5.1 IP) with 4 strikeouts in 2 appearances (1 start).

2022: Signed with the Mets as an undrafted free agent on August 3...Prior, made 4 appearances (3 starts) with the Frederick Keys of the MLB Draft League...Went 2-1 with a 4.96 ERA (9 ER in 16.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts...Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on August 5...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 5.00 ERA (15 ER in 27.0 IP) and 25 punchouts in 6 outings (4 starts)...Transferred to Double-A Binghamton on September 16...Permitted 3 runs on 4 hits in 2.0 innings, striking out 3, in his lone Rumble Ponies effort on September 18.

MOUNT HOKIE: Geber split his college career between Mount St. Mary's University (Emmitsburg, Md.)...Spent 4 seasons with the Mountaineers...Named to the All-Northeast Conference First Team as a reliever in 2021...Tallied a 2-3 clip with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER in 60.1 IP) with 68 K's in 11 outings (10 starts)...Transferred to Virginia Tech for his graduate season in 2022...Accrued a 1-2 record with a 5.40 ERA (21 ER in 35.0 IP) and 40 whiffs in 16 appearances (7 starts) for the Hokies.

FIRST DRAFT: Geber became one of the first two players to sign with a Major League franchise straightout of the brand new MLB Draft League in 2022...The 23-year-old was the first member of the Keys to sign with a parent club since the league formed prior to the 2021 season...Fellow Mets' farmhand RHP **Joe Joe Rodriguez** — who is currently with Single-A St. Lucie — was the first MLB Draft Leaguer to sign.
