LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn dropped their third-straight game, 6-5, to Wilmington on Sunday afternoon...CF **James Wood** hammered a game-tying solo home run in the bottom of the 7th and 3B **Trey Lipscomb** provided a go-ahead RBI single in the bottom of the 8th...SS **William Lugo** and 2B-3B **Mateo Gil** provided an RBI double and triple, respectively, for Brooklyn...1B **Joe Suozzi** walked twice, stole a base, and drove in a run for the Cyclones...Wood and Lipscomb each tallied 3 hits for the Blue Rocks...RHP **Tyler Schoff** recorded the final 5 outs for Wilmington, earning his 3rd win...RHP **Dylan Tebrake** hurled a scoreless inning of relief for Brooklyn.

WELCOME BACK, TEBRAKE: RHP **Dylan Tebrake** made his first appearance after being reinstated from the 7-day injured list on Sunday...The former Creighton Bluejay worked around a fielding error and a walk to hurl a scoreless frame in his first appearance since April 8 vs. Jersey Shore...Tebrake tossed 17 pitches and 10 strikes...Tebrake was the Mets' 8th-round selection last season.

STU-PER DUPER: RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the SAL in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 8.0 innings with 5.0 scoreless frames at Wilmington on Saturday...Entering Tuesday, Stuart leads the league in ERA (1.40)...He is also tied for 6th in batting average against (.202)...The right-hander is also 4th in strikeout rate (32.1%) and 5th in xFIP (3.45) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.92).

NEW MONTH, NEW MAN: C **Kevin Parada** has been on a tear since the calendar flipped to May...In 11 games during the season's second month, the 21-year-old is slashing .300/.378/.550 with a .928 OPS...Parada is 12-for-40 at the dish (.300) with 5 runs scored, 5 doubles, a triple, a home run, and 5 RBI...In that time frame, the Los Angeles native holds a .412 wOBA and a 145 wRC+...In the month of May, Parada is tied for 3rd in the South Atlantic League in doubles (5) and tied for 5th in extra-base hits (7)...For the entire campaign, the Georgia Tech alum is tied for fifth in the SAL in two-base hits (9).

SAY HEY, JAY: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has reached base safely in 9-straight games entering Tuesday...Dating back to May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 22-year-old is 7-for-30 at the dish (.233) with a .661 OPS...Palmer has picked up 6 runs scored, 2 doubles, driven in a tally, and walked 6 times...The Canarsie native is also 4-for-5 on stolen base attempts in that span...Palmer is also 7-for-7 on stolen base attempts against Wilmington in 2023 and tied for the team lead with 13.

ALEX SMACKS: OF **Alex Ramírez** had his team-season-long 19-game on-base streak snapped in game one on Wednesday, but has reached in 22-of-23 games dating back to April 12...In that span, Ramírez is slashing .284/.370/.352 with a .722 OPS and a 103 wRC+...Alex is 25-for-88 at the dish with 9 runs scored, 4 extra-base hits, 1 home run, 14 RBI, 10 walks, and 4 stolen bases in 5 attempts...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (50), hits (91) and doubles (21)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** in extra-base hits (28) and total bases (132).

NONE SHALL PASS: LHP **Daniel Juárez** has been as dominant as can be out of the bullpen for the Cyclones in 2023...In his first 10 outings of the campaign, the southpaw holds a 2-0 record with 1 save...He has not permitted a run on 4 hits and 4 walks, striking out 17 (13.12 K/9)...In 15 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez has yielded only 1 unearned run in 16.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 23 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with Single-A St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Since then, he is 4-0 with 9 hits allowed, 13 walks, and 32 strikeouts in 26.1 innings...Since the streak began, no pitcher in Minor League Baseball has thrown more innings without allowing an earned run.

'DASH' LOS SANTOS: In addition to his 13 stolen bases in 14 attempts in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 83 stolen bases in that span, which is 5th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (91), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (86), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (86), and Athletics OF **Esteury Ruiz** (85) have swiped more...De Los Santos has also snagged 48 more bases than

vs. HUDSON VALLEY: Brooklyn heads continues their 2 week road trip with a 6-game set against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades boast 3 of New York's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...OF **Spencer Jones** (6), RHP **Drew Thorpe** (8), and C **Antonio Gómez** (27) are featured...The Cyclones went 14-16 in 30 matchups against Hudson Valley in 2022...Brooklyn held a 8-10 record at Heritage Financial Park last year...The Cyclones are 126-134 (.485) all-time against the Renegades dating back to the 2001 season.

any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 35...Omar is already 19 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

JUMPIN' JOE: OF/1B **Joe Suozzi** comes in to Tuesday's series opener riding a 5-game on-base streak...The Glen Cove, N.Y. native is 4-for-his-last-14 (.286) with 3 runs scored, a double, 3 RBI, 3 walks, and a stolen base...Suozzi has registered a .746 OPS in those 5 contests...Dating back to April 26 at Jersey Shore, the 25-year-old has registered at least one base knock in 8-of-11 games.

WIZARD OF OS: C **Drake Osborn** enters Tuesday's fixture on a season-long 6-game on-base streak...Since registering his first multi-hit game as a Cyclone on May 3 vs. Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 6-for-21 at the plate (.286) with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 4 RBI, and 2 walks...Osborn holds an .967 OPS since the streak began.

GEBER FEVER: RHP **Jordan Geber** has been dominant over his last 3 outings for Brooklyn...Since his first start of the season on April 22 vs. Wilmington, the 23-year-old holds a 1-0 record with a minuscule 0.64 ERA (1 ER in 14.0 IP) over 3 appearances...Geber has permitted only 5 hits and 2 walks, in addition to racking up 13 strikeouts...Since that date, Geber has the 5th-lowest ERA (0.64) in the SAL among pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched...The right-hander's WHIP (0.50) is also the lowest in the circuit during that time frame (min. 10.0 IP).

TIME TO MAKE THE DONUTS: Brooklyn pitching did nothing but post zeroes on the scoreboard in Sunday's 3-0 win vs. Aberdeen...It was the Cyclones' first shutout victory of the season...It was Brooklyn's first shutout win since September 9, 2022, at Winston-Salem...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** (7.0 IP) and RHP **Daison Acosta** (2.0) combined on a 3-hit, 3-0 blanking of the Dash...It was the first for the Cyclones at Maimonides Park since August 5, 2022, also against Winston-Salem...LHP **Keyshawn Askew** (4.1), RHP **David Griffin** (3.2), and RHP **Dylan Hall** (1.0) united on a 6-hit, 2-0 victory.

ATOP THE WONDER WHEEL: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 2 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (3/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (6/9)...INF **William Lugo** (26/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (29/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 20 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss of the season in game two of a doubleheader last Wednesday vs. Wilmington...Brooklyn served as the home team at Frawley Stadium, making up for a game postponed on April 23 on Coney Island...Permitted a season-high 7 runs and 11 hits over 5.1 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 4...Tossed 85 pitches (56 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Jace Beck** in the top of the 6th with a man at 1st, 1 out, and the Blue Rocks leading, 7-1...Wilmington went on to win the 7-inning game by that score.

PROSPECT RADAR: Entering the 2023 season, *Baseball America* deemed Colón one of the Mets’ “14 Prospects to Watch Beyond The Top 30”

JEFE JEFFREY: Colón became the first Cyclone pitcher to work into the 7th inning in 2023 on May 3 vs. Aberdeen... The 23-year-old was the first Brooklyn pitcher to work into the 7th inning since he did it himself in a win at Winston-Salem on September 9, 2022.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie from extended spring training on June 1...Registered a 3-0 record with a 3.23 ERA (17 ER in 47.1 IP), 2 saves, and 57 strikeouts in 13 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER in 25.1 IP), 2 saves, and 27 strikeouts in 6 appearances (3 starts) for the Cyclones.

FINISHING STRONG: After joining the Cyclones on August 8, Colón was one of the most dominant pitchers in the South Atlantic League through the remainder of the season... Among pitchers with at least 25.0 innings pitched, the right-hander was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (1.07)...He also yielded the fewest hits (13), tied for the fewest runs allowed (3), and ranked 3rd in WHIP (0.79) and batting average against (.153).

FLORIDA’S FINEST: During his stint with St. Lucie, Colón was among the elite producing arms in the Florida State League...From June 1 until the time of his promotion to Brooklyn, the Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native was 2nd in the circuit in ERA (3.23) and tied for 3rd in strikeouts (57)... He was also 3rd in WHIP (1.10), 4th in innings pitched (47.1), and 5th in batting average against (.227).
