LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox won their third game of the series on Friday night with a 5-1 victory over the Erie SeaWolves. The win is Bowie's fourth out of its last five and the tenth at home this season. The Baysox used three homers to clinch the victory, including solo homers from Jud Fabian and Anthony Servideo and a three-run home run by Samuel Basallo. Kyle Brnovich pitched four shutout and hitless innings of relief to earn the win and Nick Richmond finished out the night with two shutout innings to seal the victory for the Baysox.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Troy Melton gets the start for the SeaWolves tonight. The 23-year-old is coming off his longest start of the season vs Harrisburg, going five innings, allowing three runs (two earned) on seven hits and no walks with four strikeouts, receiving his second loss of the year. Melton is in his first season with the SeaWolves after pitching last season in Single-A Lakeland and High-A West Michigan. The Tigers' 4th round pick in '22 struck out 94 batters over 92 innings last season to an ERA of just 2.74 across both levels.

BASALLO HITS BOMBS

C Samuel Basallo has enjoyed his best week of the season, thus far, in 2024. After hitting a threerun go-ahead homer in the fourth, the Orioles No. 2 prospect now has four home runs and nine RBI over his last four games played. Basallo has three 3 RBI games over his last four played. The 19-year-old leads the Baysox in home runs and is tied for fifth in the league in home runs with five.

ON-BASE BOWENS

1B TT Bowens is currently on a 7-game hit and on-base streak, which is the longest active hit and on-base streak on the team. After playing just 47 games last year due to injuries, Bowens is tied at the top of the Eastern League leaderboard with 20 RBI, along with New Hampshire's Josh Kasevich. The undrafted free agent is seventh in the league in AVG (.324), fourth in SLG (.574) and fifth in OPS (.956).

HOME SWEET HOME

The best home record in the Eastern League belongs to the Bowie Baysox, thus far. At 10-3, no other Eastern League team has won ten games at home. The Baysox are one of just three teams across all of Double-A to have won 10 games at home, thus far, and have won six of their last seven here at Prince George's Stadium. At home this season, the Baysox are first in runs scored (86), first in home runs (20), and first in OPS (.831).

RELIEVERS STAY READY

The Bowie bullpen has carried a large load so far this year. Baysox relievers lead the Eastern League in innings pitched (116.1) and strikeouts (152). Bowie starters have thrown the fourth-fewest innings in the league (97.2). The bullpen has also recorded the third-lowest WHIP (1.18) and the fifth-fewest walks (46) amongst other Eastern League bullpens. Bowie is one of just two teams remaining in the league that has yet to have a win go to a starting pitcher.

SUPERBAD SETH

RHP **Seth Johnson** makes his fifth start of the season and his sixth career Bowie start. The 25-year-old is coming off his best road start of the season in Richmond last Sunday, going four innings, allowing two runs on three hits with just one walk and a season-high six strikeouts in a no decision. Prior to the start, Johnson had not made it past the third inning in either of his two road starts. Johnson, who is on the Orioles 40-man roster, made five rehab starts last season while recovering from Tommy, John Surgery, The former Campbell arm was originally drafted by the Rays in the 1st round of the 2019 Draft but was then traded to the Orioles in August 2022 at the trade deadline in a three-team deal that involved Trey Mancini going to the Astros.



Delivered four shutout innings in home debut on 4/17 vs ALT.

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of Mil.B's "Copa de la DiversiónTM" or "Fun CupTM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.
