CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: Lake County won its 3rd straight game with a 5-3 victory at Beloit on Sunday to win the series 3-2. RHP **Trenton Denholm** (7-1) picked up his Midwest League best-tying 7th win, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits while striking out 6 and walking 3 in 5 innings of work.

SS Angel Genao, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, wasted no time in getting the Captains on the board with his 1st High-A home run on the 1st pitch of the game. Beloit answered in the bottom of the 3rd when 2B Carlos Santiago hit a go-ahead 2-run home run.

Genao struck again in the top of the 5th, slashing an RBI single to tie the game at 2-2. 2B **Jose Devers**, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, and LF **Guy Lipscomb** ripped consecutive RBI singles in the top of the 6th gain a 4-2 advantage.

In the top of the 9th, CF **Jake Fox**, MLB Pipeline's No. 18 Cleveland prospect, clubbed an RBI double to extend the lead to 3. RHP **Allan Hernández** earned his 2nd Minor League save in 45 appearances, allowing 1 unearned run in 2 innings on a throwing error by 3B **Alex Mooney**, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, in the bottom of the 9th.

PITCH PERFECT: Lake County pitching surrendered just 1 earned run (2 total), 2 hits, and combined for 13 strikeouts. **The LC staff compiled 75 strikeouts against the Sky Carp, the 2nd-most in High-A during this span.**

HEY DRIVER: RHP **Jay Driver** pitched 2 shutout innings Friday to extend his scoreless appearance streak to 12 games, **the longest in the MWL this season**, and tied for the 4th-longest active streak in MiLB. **Driver** has tossed 15.1 consecutive scoreless innings during this span.

PROSPECTING: Captains INF **Angel Genao** was ranked Baseball America's No. 65 overall prospect on their updated Top 100 Prospects list. Other Cleveland minor leaguers on the list: OF **Chase DeLauter** (#31, Double-A), 1B **Kyle Manzardo** (#61, MLB), OF **Jaison Chourio** (#82, Single-A), and 1B **Ralphy Velazquez** (#85, Single-A).

MOVIN' ON UP: On June 3, INF **Nate Furman** and 1B/LF **C.J. Kayfus**, MLB Pipeline's No. 28 Cleveland prospect, were assigned to Double-A Akron, while INF **Angel Genao**, MLB Pipeline's No. 11 Cleveland prospect, was assigned to Lake County. **Kayfus and Genao are 2 of 4 MiLB hitters with a .335+ AVG, 60+ H, 30+ R, and a .920+ OPS in 2024.**

MOVIN' ON UP: Through 57 team games, INF **Alex Mooney** has recorded 19 stolen bases, 31 RBI, and 38 runs scored. **The 4 Midwest League players to do this since at least 2005 are: Mooney (2024), Henry Bolte (LAN, 2024), Byron Buxton (CR, 2013), and Mike Trout (CR, 2010).**

2-OUT HITTING: **Lake County's .268 AVG with 2 outs ranks 2nd in High-A, and 5th among all MiLB and MLB teams.**

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,791 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,407-1,384 (.504).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last 4 campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

OH, OH, OH, IT'S MAGIC: **Lake County's magic number to clinch the 1st half Midwest League East Division title is 7** with 9 games left in the 1st half. In 21 seasons, the Captains have won 8 First Half titles, most recently in 2019.

PARKER MESSICK NAMED TO TEAM OF THE WEEK: For the 2nd time in the last 3 weeks, LHP **Parker Messick** was named to MLB Pipeline's MiLB Team of the Week, being recognized as the top left-handed starting pitcher in Minor League Baseball during the week of 6/3-6/9. On June 6 at Beloit, **Messick** struck out professional high-tying 11 batters in 5.2 shutout frames, his most since 8/9/2023 versus South Bend.

WELCOME TO RAKE COUNTY: Through 57 games, the Captains have scored 303 runs, their most through 57 games since 2007 (327). **Lake County leads High-A in hits (506) and OBP (.358), while ranking 2nd in AVG (.265), RBI (283), fewest strikeouts (435), and OPS (.757).**

COUNT ADVINCULA: OF **Jonah Advincula** was named Captain of the Week for his series against Beloit. **Advincula led the team in hitting (.417), RBI (6), OBP (.563), SLG (.917), and OPS (1.480), while ranking 3rd in the MWL in SLG and OPS.**

ALL ABOARD THE "TUGBOAT": LHP **Matt "Tugboat" Wilkinson** has struck out 8+ batters in each of his first 3 High-A starts. **Wilkinson** leads MiLB with 96 strikeouts in 55.1 innings, which amounts to an astounding 1.74 strikeouts per inning. **For comparison, RHP Dwight "Doc" Gooden set the Minor League single-season record with 300 strikeouts in 191 innings for the Lynchburg Mets in 1983, which makes for an average of 1.57 strikeouts per inning.**

NO SURRENDER: The Captains own 3 of the top 4 spots on the Midwest League batting average leaderboard. INF **Nate Furman** (.338, T-1st), 1B/LF **C.J. Kayfus** (.338, T-1st), and OF **Guy Lipscomb** (.331, 4th) are Lake County's 3 qualified hitters batting over .300. INF **Alex Mooney** (.292, 12th), also ranks in top-15. Additionally, C **Cooper Ingle**'s .328 AVG ranks 6th among MWL hitters with 120+ ABs this season.

TOP QUALITY: Through 57 games, Lake County starting pitchers have recorded 18 quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer earned runs), which are tied for the 3rd-most in High-A, and tied for the 9th-most in MiLB. RHPs **Austin Peterson** (6), **Carter Spivey** (5), **Trenton Denholm** (4), and LHP **Parker Messick** (3), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, have all recorded quality starts for the Captains this year.

CAN'T START A FIRE WITHOUT A SPARK: The Lake County starting rotation is among the best in the Midwest League, leading the MWL in wins (23), innings pitched (286.2), strikeouts (294), and are 2nd in fewest walks (73) and WHIP (1.20). **Captains starters have only walked 2.24 batters per 9 innings, the lowest rate in MiLB (Single-A through Triple-A).**

HE COULD THROW THAT SPEEDBALL BY YOU: RHP **Austin Peterson** is the only pitcher in Minor and Major League Baseball to have 70+ strikeouts and 6-or-fewer walks in 2024. The right-hander leads the Midwest League in strikeouts (71), quality starts (6), and innings pitched (64.2) while ranking 2nd in ERA (2.92) and WHIP (0.91). The quick-working **Peterson** ranks 3rd in MiLB in pitches per inning (13.52) and 4th in K/BB ratio (11.83).

LAST TIME OUT: Austin Peterson (ND) did not record a decision on June 5 at Beloit in the Captains' 4-3 loss to the Sky Carp. Peterson went 5.2 innings, allowing 1 earned run (2 total) and 5 hits, while striking out 8 and walking 3. The right-hander had only allowed 3 walks in his first 59 innings in 2024.

A BAKER'S DOZEN: Back on May 29, Peterson struck out a career-high 13 batters in Lake County's 6-4 win at Cedar Rapids. Peterson tied RHP Adam Plutko for the Captains' single-game franchise record. Plutko also struck out 13 vs. Bowling Green on 5/8/2014.

QUALITY CONTROL: 6 of Peterson's 8 starts since April 24 have been quality starts (6+ IP, 3-or-fewer ER). His 6 quality starts since April 24 rank tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in that span.

POUNDING THE ZONE: Peterson is the only pitcher across Minor and Major League Baseball with 70-or-more strikeouts and 6-or-fewer walks this season. The right-hander ranks 4th in Minor League Baseball (Single-A through Triple-A) with an 11.83 strikeout to walk ratio.

OFF TO A STELLAR HIGH-A START: Through his first 10 High-A starts, Peterson ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in: strikeouts (71, 1st), innings pitched (64.1, 1st), ERA (2.92, 2nd), WHIP (0.91, 2nd), and wins (6, tied for 3rd).

LAST TWO STARTS AGAINST FORT WAYNE: Peterson was named the 3rd-ever Captain of the Week, presented by Official League on May 6. He went 1-0 in 2 starts against Fort Wayne, pitching a combined 13.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 7 hits and 1 walk, and throwing 9 strikeouts in 150 pitches (115 strikes). Peterson's 13.2 shutout frames were the most from a pitcher across Minor and Major League Baseball from April 30 through May 5.

2023 IN REVIEW: Peterson made 24 starts with Single-A Lynchburg last season, which were tied for the most in the Carolina League with RHP and fellow Hillcat Alonzo Richardson, as well as Charleston RiverDogs (TB) RHP Marcus Johnson. Peterson recorded 4 quality starts, which were tied for the third-most in the Carolina League.

A STAR IN STORRS: After making 25 appearances at Purdue in 2019 and 5 appearances at Wabash Valley Community College (IL) in 2020, Peterson was a 2-time All-Big East pitcher at UConn. In just 2 seasons with the Huskies, he struck out 226 batters, tied for the 6th-most in program history. In 2022, the right-hander was named a 1st Team NCBWA All-American, NCBWA District Co-Player of the Year, New England Pitcher of the Year, and 1st Team All-Big East. In his final year with the Huskies, Peterson struck out a program-record 147 batters, the 3rd-most in the country. He also went 8+ innings in 3 starts. In 2021, Peterson was named 2nd Team All-Big East, ranking 4th in the conference with a 2.58 ERA, and leading the conference with 33 strikeouts looking.

PICANTES TO THE MAINLAND

4 former Lake County Captains have been promoted to MLB during the 2024 season.

INF Daniel Schneemann: On Sunday, June 2, **INF Daniel Schneemann** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the Washington Nationals. He started at 2nd base and batted 8th in the Guardians' order, going 1-for-3 with a 2-run double on his first MLB pitch and a strikeout. **Schneemann** played 98 regular-season games for the Captains across the 2018, 2019, and 2021 seasons, hitting .267 with 86 hits, 13 doubles, 3 triples, 5 home runs, 43 RBI, 12 stolen bases, and a .711 OPS. He also played 3 postseason games for Lake County in 2019, hitting .182 (2-for-11) with 2 runs, 2 RBI, and 1 walk.

1B/OF Trenton Brooks: On Tuesday, May 28, **1B/OF Trenton Brooks** made his MLB debut at home for the San Francisco Giants against the Philadelphia Phillies. He started at 1st base and batted 9th in the Giants' order, going 0-for-2 with 1 strikeout. **Brooks** played 29 games for the Captains in 2017, hitting .214 with 24 hits, 5 doubles, 1 home run, 8 RBI, 12 walks, and a .588 OPS.

OF Johnathan Rodríguez: On Tuesday, May 21, **OF Johnathan Rodríguez** made his MLB debut at home for the Cleveland Guardians against the New York Mets. He started in right field and batted 7th in the Guardians' order, going 0-for-4 with 2 strikeouts. **Rodríguez** played 103 games for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, hitting .275 with 103 hits, 20 doubles, 23 home runs, 70 RBI, and an .862 OPS. In 2022, he led the Midwest League with 21 home runs.

RHP Cade Smith: On Saturday, March 30, **RHP Cade Smith** made his MLB debut for the Cleveland Guardians on the road against the Oakland Athletics. He pitched 2 scoreless, hitless innings of relief, allowing just 1 walk and throwing 5 strikeouts. **Smith** made 23 relief appearances for the Captains across the 2021 and 2022 seasons, going 2-1 with a 2.67 ERA, 48 strikeouts, a 1.11 WHIP, and a .156 opposing batting average, converting 6 of his 7 save opportunities.

As part of its alter ego, the team uses a flaming pepper logo and wears alternate uniforms. According to MiLB.com, “Lake County’s ‘Picantes’ moniker represents the area’s spice of life, both literally and figuratively. The identity celebrates both the Chile pepper’s place in spicier LatinX cuisine and the community’s edgier, fiery personalities.”

The Captains are 4-2 as Los Picantes de Lake County this season.

Los Picantes most recently defeated the Beloit Sky Carp (Las Paletas de Beloit) on the road by a score of 5-3 on Sunday, June 9. **SS Angel Genao** hit his first career High-A home run on the first pitch of the game for his first career High-A RBI. 4 innings later, Genao recorded the 2nd RBI of his High-A career with a 2-out RBI infield single, which tied the game at 2-2. Then, in the top of the 6th, **2B Jose Devers** and **LF Guy Lipscomb** hit back-to-back RBI singles to give Lake County a 4-2 lead. Los Picantes then scored their final run of the day on a 2-out RBI double from **RF Jake Fox**. **RHP Trenton Denholm** earned his 7th win of the season, allowing 2 hits, 2 earned runs, and 3 walks, while striking out 6 in 5 innings of work. **RHP Zach Jacobs** then recorded his 4th hold of the year by pitching 2 scoreless frames of relief, striking out 5. Finally, **RHP Allan Hernández** recorded his 2nd save of the season, allowing 1 unearned run and 1 walk, and throwing 2 strikeouts in 2 innings of relief.

Los Picantes most recently defeated the Dayton Dragons by a score of 9-5 on Tuesday, May 7. **LHP Parker Messick** earned his 2nd victory of the season, allowing 4 hits, 3 runs (1 earned), and 4 walks, while throwing 4 strikeouts in 5 innings of work. Lake County scored in each of its final 7 innings of the plate, including 2 runs in both the 3rd and 4th innings. 7 of 9 Picantes hitters recorded at least 1 RBI, with **1B C.J. Kayfus** and **C Cooper Ingle** leading the way with 2 RBI each.

Before that, the team defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne) by a score of 6-0 on Sunday, May 5. **RHP Austin Peterson** earned his 4th victory of the season, allowing just 3 hits and throwing 3 strikeouts in 6 scoreless innings of work. **LF Guy Lipscomb** (2-run single), **CF Jake Fox** (RBI double), and **DH Nate Furman** (RBI single) each drove in runs for Lake County.

Los Picantes also defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps (Las Manzanas Luchadoras de Fort Wayne) by a score of 1-0 in 10 innings on Tuesday, April 30. In the bottom of the 10th inning, Lake County **SS Jose Devers** scored the game’s only run on a throwing error after **OF Justin Boyd** hit a single. On the mound, **RHP Austin Peterson** (ND) pitched a season-high 7.2 scoreless innings, allowing just 4 hits and 1 walk, and throwing 6 strikeouts.

Lake County went 4-3 as **Los Picantes de Lake County** last season, and a perfect 7-0 in 2022.
