SHUCKERS NEWS & NOTES

WELCOME TO JULY!: Entering today, the Shuckers lineup is one of the hottest in Double-A during the month of July... They rank amongst the top Double-A teams in home runs (22, 2nd), extra-base hits (49, 2nd), slugging percentage (.501, 2nd), OPS (.884, 3rd), on-base percentage (.383, 3rd) and average (.297, 3rd)... The Shuckers are also one of the hardest teams to strikeout, with the third-lowest strikeout total in July (89)... In July, the Shuckers have scored at least five runs in seven of 13 games.

ACTION JACKSON'S AT IT AGAIN: OF Jackson Chourio enters today with five straight multi-hit games, the longest by a Shuckers player since OF Sal Frelick tallied multiple hits in five straight between May 14-27, 2022 and the fourth player to do so in franchise history (since 2015)... Over Chourio's streak, he's 12-23 (.522) at SHUCKERS 56 MULTI-H STREAKS the plate with three doubles, three home runs and a 1.585 OPS... Over that span, Chourio Jackson Chourio (2023); July 6-Pres.

Sal Frelick (2022): May 14-27 has also raised his OPS from .699 to .764, a 65-point increase... No player in Shuckers Brice Turang (2021): June 26 - July 1 Garrett Cooper (2015): Aug. 29 - Sept. 4

THE HOME RUN BARRAGE: On Tuesday night, OF Lamar Sparks, INF Tyler Black and OF Jackson Chourio tallied back-toback-to-back home runs, the first time the Shuckers had done so since May 14, 2022 against the Birmingham Barons at MGM Park... The Shuckers tallied four home runs on Tuesday, tied for their most in a game this year... The Shuckers have also tallied a home run in 12 of 13 games in July, hitting 22 in the month.

EXTRAS FOR WES: In Biloxi's first 18 games against the Biscuits in 2023, C/1B Wes Clarke has 10 extra-base hits, the second-most by any Southern League player against Montgomery this year... Clarke also enters this week with a 1.141 OPS against the Biscuits, the highest out of any Southern League player by 54 points.

HE'S ON THE MOVE: With a stolen base on Sunday, INF Tyler Black has 42 stolen bases in 2023, 10 away from tying OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52, set in 2017... Black enters today with 14 stolen bases against the Biscuits, the most by any opposing player this year... Black currently leads the Southern League and Double-A in the category.
