## 11-TIME GOVERNORS' CUP CHAMPIONS



Huntington Park, the home of the Columbus Clippers

- The Columbus Clippers played their first season of baseball in 1977.
- In the first year, the Clippers struggled to win very many games and finished in 7th place.
- Soon the Clippers became a great team, winning the playoffs three straight years from 1979 to 1981.
- The Clippers have won the League Championship eleven times, which is more than any other team.
- In 2009, the Clippers moved into a new stadium known as Huntington Park in downtown Columbus.
- Many former Clippers players later became All-Stars in Major League Baseball.
- Over 25 million fans have come to a game to cheer on the Clippers.

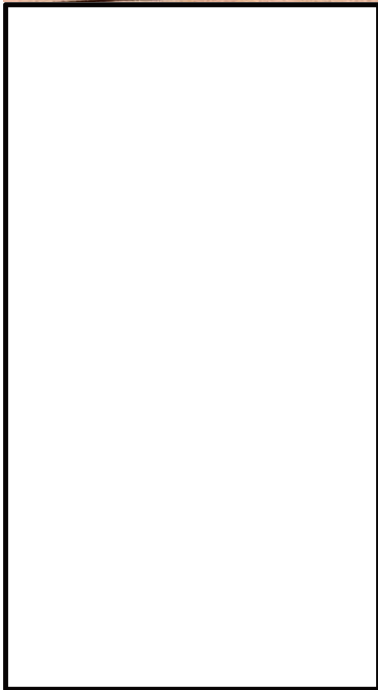

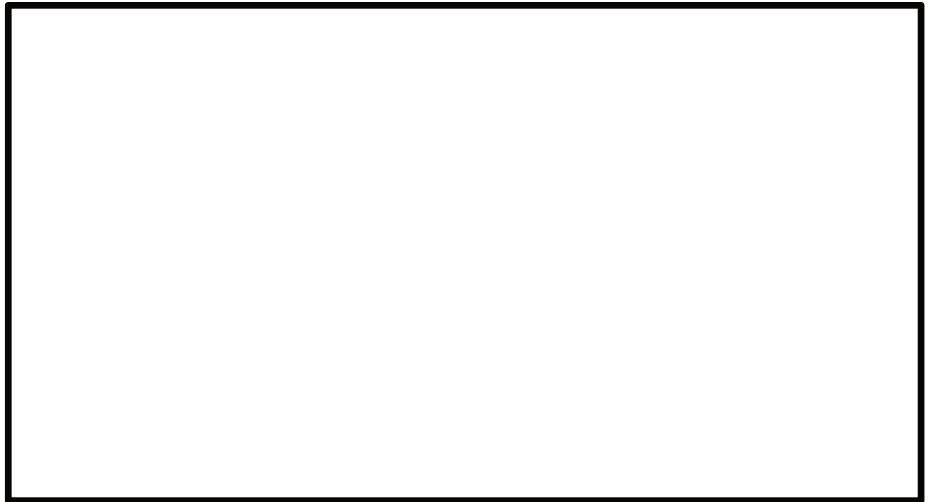
