ACEVEDO POWERS DELMARVA TO THIRD STRAIGHT WIN: The Delmarva Shorebirds finished their series against the Lynchburg Hillcats with a 4-2 victory on Sunday night, earning them a third-straight win. Juan De Los Santos set the tone as he dealt five perfect innings as the starter, striking out three along the way. Delmarva spotted him a lead in the bottom of the fifth on a two-run homer by **Stiven Acevedo.** Lynchburg would tie the game in the next half inning after De Los Santos departed, but the Acevedo would deliver for the 'Birds again in the bottom of the seventh as he went yard again to left-center field to make it 3-2. Anderson De Los Santos would provide a sacrifice fly to score Carter Young a few moments later, and that would be enough for Delmarva to hold off Lynchburg as they'd go onto to earn a series split against the Hillcats.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Edgar Portes gets the start in the series opener against the first place, Carolina Mudcats on Tuesday night. He'll face right-hander Alexander Vallecillo who makes his 9th start on Tuesday and it will be the second time he will face the Shorebirds. On May 6, Vallecillo threw 4 innings and allowed just 1 run on 1 hit but did walk 5 along with 6 walks. He did not factor into the decision in a 5-2 win for Delmarva.

HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in 16 of 20 games he's played in since the break. In that stretch, Acevedo is batting .295 with an .894 OPS as he's hit four home runs, with two of them coming on Sunday night against the Lynchburg Hillcats where he homered in back-toback at-bats for his second multi-homer game of the season with his previous one coming on May 2 versus Carolina. The speed for Acevedo has also played a factor for him lately as he's swiped 9 bases and has scored 12 runs since the All-Star Break, both team-highs in that span.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK: The Delmarva Shorebirds will welcome the first group of players from the 2023 Baltimore Orioles' draft class as Enrique Bradfield Jr., Mac Horvath, Tavian Josenberger, Matthew Etzel, and Jalen **Vasquez** join the team for the final stretch of the season. Infielder **Carter Young** moves up to High-A Aberdeen in the process and he is the 12th Shorebirds from the Opening Day roster to earn a promotion.

ON THE RUN: The Shorebirds currently ranked 11th in the league in stolen bases, but have been running much more lately as they have 11 steals in their last 7 games. Stiven Acevedo has been a major part of that as he stole five bases in the previous series against Lynchburg and now the offense adds Orioles' first round pick, Enrique Bradfield Jr. to the mix who stole 130 bases in his three-year career at Vanderbilt.

A LITTLE EXTRA: The offense for Delmarva leads the league in extra-base hits this season with a total of 250. They are top five in the league doubles (152), triples (28), and home runs (70). The Shorebirds had 11 total extra base hits in the previous series against Lynchburg.

DEFENSIVE IMPROVEMENT: After a tough stretch defensively in June, the Shorebirds have been one of the best defensive units in the Carolina as of late. Since July 19, Delmarva ranks second in the league in fielding percentage (.979). Their 13 errors since that date only ranks behind their opponent this week in Carolina as the Mudcats have just 6 defensive miscues in that time as they are the best defensive team in the league with a .981 fielding percentage.

MAKE OR BREAK: The Delmarva Shorebirds face the Carolina Mudcats for the second time this season and a series that could keep them alive in the 2023 playoff hunt. Shorebirds enter the series against Carolina 7.5 games back in the North Division for the second half title with 31 games left to play. The Mudcats won four of the six game in Delmarva against the Shorebirds in the only prior series from May 2-7.
