### RIDERS OUTRAGED BY HOOKS IN 20-14 LOSS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were outslugged 20-14 by the Corpus Christi Hooks on Tuesday afternoon from Riders Field, in a game that featured a combined 34 runs, 33 hits and nine home runs. The Hooks (10-24) scored the first nine runs, including six in the top of the first. Frisco (20-14) answered with a four-run bottom of the third. **Abimelec Ortiz** lased an RBI double, **Josh Hatcher** cranked a two-run homer and **Frainyer Chavez** grounded an RBI single to cut the Hooks lead to 9-4. Corpus Christi retaliated in the top of the fourth when Sherwin hit a sacrifice fly and Cole launched a grand slam, propelling the Hooks to a 14-4 advantage. Frisco's **Cam Cauley** then hammered a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth, cutting the deficit to 14-5. The Hooks answered in the top of the seventh when Cole smashed an RBI double, extending the lead to 17-5. Barber and Cole took over in the top of the eighth. Barber yanked a two-run triple to hit for the cycle, then Cole muscled a two-run homer for his second long ball of the day, upping his RBI total to eight and Corpus Christi's lead to 19-5. The Riders exploded for six runs in the bottom of the eighth. Chavez lined an RBI double and **Aaron Zavala** lased a two-run single. **Sebastian Walcott** then clobbered a two-run homer and Ortiz smashed a solo jack to trail 19-11. Corpus Christi plated one more in the top of the ninth when Deming scored on a wild pitch, pushing the lead to 20-11. Frisco struck last in the bottom of the ninth inning when Zavala bashed a three-run homer, finishing his day with a career-high five RBI.

### HISTORIC OFFENSIVE DAY:

When the RoughRiders fell to the Hooks 20-14 on Tuesday, they allowed 20 or more runs for the fourth time in franchise history and the first time since 5/1/18 vs. San Antonio (20-4 loss). In that game, **Fernando Tatis Jr.**, **Josh Naylor** and **Ty France** all homered for the Missions. The 34 runs were the most combined runs in franchise history and their second time losing while scoring 14 or more runs. It was their first time since 5/16/15 versus Corpus Christi (15-14 loss).

### ABIM-ELECTRIC ORTIZ:

**Abimelec Ortiz** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. While on a five-game hitting streak, Ortiz is hitting .476 (10-for-21)/.522/.762/1.284 with three doubles, a home run and four RBIs.

### NO-HITTER NOTES:

The RoughRiders completed their sixth no-hitter in franchise history on Wednesday. It was the third nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history, the first no-hitter since **Joe Wieland** no-hit San Antonio on July 29th, 2011 at Wolff Stadium and the fourth no-hitter against San Antonio in franchise history. It was also the third combined no-hitter in franchise history and first since **Neftali Feliz** and **Trey Hodges** no-hit San Antonio in six innings on August 19th, 2008 at Wolff Stadium.

### DOUBLE-A DOUBL-A RON:

**Aaron Zavala** has been on fire at the plate for the Riders. After a dreadful start, batting just .077 (2-for-26) through 10 games, he is hitting .327 (17-for-52)/.455/.577/1.032 over his last 16 games. He leads the Texas League in walks (26) and is fifth in OBP (.426) while leading the league in walk rate (25.5 percent), a mark which also ranks fourth in Minor League Baseball (min. 100 PA). He is currently on an eight-game hitting streak, batting .429 (12-for-28)/.543/.679/1.222 with 13 runs scored, a double, two home runs, seven RBIs and seven walks.

### HOOKIN CORPUS:

The Riders have played well against the Hooks this season, going 6-4 against the Astros affiliate. On the mound, the RoughRiders have a 3.99 team ERA and have struck out 122 batters over 88.0 innings. **Josh Hatcher**, **Luis Mieses** and **Sebastian Walcott** have all hit two home runs against the Hooks this season.

### THE ROAD IS WHERE MY HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season, going 11-7 away from Riders Field. **Keyber Rodriguez** (.386) is second among active Texas League players in road batting average. **Josh Hatcher** has hit four of his five home runs on the road, tied for the league lead. Frisco's 17 road home runs are second in the league. The Riders have averaging 5.2 runs per game on the road vs. 4.2 runs per game at home.

### BRATT SUMMER IS BACK:

**Mitch Bratt** has been one of the stronger arms for Frisco to start the year. Through his first six starts, his 1.99 ERA is fifth in the Texas League. It is also the second-best start to a season through the team's first 32 games (min. six games start) recorded franchise history, only trailing **Justin Grimm** in 2012, who had a 1.60 ERA through seven starts. His 3.9 percent walk rate is the best in the Texas League while 7.80 K/BB is also first.

### KEYBERRRRR, RODRIGUEZ IS ANYTHING BUT COLD:

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been fantastic at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over his 28 games this season, he is hitting .320 (33-for-103)/.379/.427/.806. He is third in the Texas League with his .320 average. In his last 20 games, he is slashing .342 (26-for-76)/.390/.474/.864 with three doubles, two triples, a home run, 13 RBIs, seven runs scored, five walks and six stolen bases. Over the season, he has seven multi-hit games.

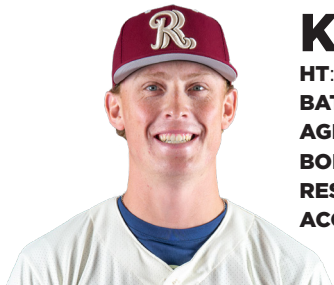

ABOUT KOHL

-While he was born in Orem, Utah, Drake grew up in Sachse, Texas (25 minutes from Riders Field) and attended Wylie High School. The Wylie Pirates produced NFL players Kyle Fuller, Chris Givens, Kameron Kelly and Nikita Whitlock.

-Began his collegiate career at Arkansas Tech (2019), spent 2020 at San Joaquin Delta College in Stockton, California and ended with his final two seasons at Walters State Community College in Tennessee. WSCC is the same program which produced Texas LHP Brett Martin.

-In 2022, he was named NJCAA D1 Pitcher of the Year with WSCC after setting a program record with 160 strikeouts (15.43 K/9) while just walking 17 batters. He went 14-0 with a 1.93 ERA (20 ER/93.1 IP) in 17 starts as a redshirt sophomore.

-He and teammate Jake Knapp (3rd TM NJCAA All-American) led the pitching staff at WSCC, tying for the national lead with 14 wins.

2025 SEASON

-Entered 2025 as the No. 13 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

-Tied a career high with 10 strikeouts in third start against Corpus Christi on April 23rd.

-He is 1st in the Texas League (min. 20 IP) in K-rate (39.1%) and batting average against (.120) while he is fifth in swinging strike rate (15.8%) and WHIP (0.90).

-On May 7th at San Antonio, threw 6.0 innings of no-hit baseball, at one point retiring 16 batters in a row. Ryan Lobus and Skylar Hales then finished out the sixth no-hitter in RoughRiders franchise history.

2024 SEASON

-Made first start of the season with Down East on 4/9/24, allowing just four baserunners (3 H, 1 BB) in 4.0 scoreless innings while striking out six.

-After spot start with Frisco on April 18th, he returned to Down East and pitched eight games for Hickory before coming back to Frisco for an August 25th start.

-Entering into August 25th, he has a 38 percent strikeout rate. That and his 131 strikeouts are first among Texas Rangers farmhands and his K/BB of 5.04 is fourth in the organization.

-In home debut with the RoughRiders on August 25th, Drake struck out six over six innings, allowing just two base runners (one hit, one walk), in win.

-In game two of the 2024 Texas League South Division Series, Drake threw 5.0 shutout innings, allowing just two hits and walking one while striking out six against Midland on September 19th.

2023 SEASON

-Made his professional debut for the ACL Rangers (Rk.) and Down East (A), totaling a 2-5 record, 6.86 ERA (33 ER/46.2 IP), and 55 strikeouts (10.6 SO/9) over 14 G/4 GS.

-His only scoreless outing of the season came in third appearance (6/22/23 @ A-MRN): 3.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 5 K.

-Participated in Rangers' Fall Instructional League program.
