**TIED AT THE TOP:** The Omaha Storm Chasers hit three home runs to defeat the Toledo Mud Hens, 4-2, on Saturday at Werner Park to pull into a tie for first place in the Midwest Division standings. After beginning the week trailing Toledo by 2.0 games, Omaha has won four of six against Toledo to claim a share of first place for the first time since Aug. 15. **1B/OF Ryan McBroom** blasted two solo home runs to set a new career high and now leads the league with 27 homers this season. **OF Kyle Isbel** homered for the second straight game, a go-ahead solo shot in the fourth. **RHP Grant Gavin** struck out five in 3.0 scoreless innings while **RHP Collin Snider** and **RHP Dylan Coleman** finished the game with scoreless innings. The Omaha bullpen combined to retire 15 of the 16 batters it faced, including 12 straight to end the game.

**MARVELOUS MELENDEZ:** **C/3B MJ Melendez** hit his seventh home run at the Triple-A level and 35th home run of the season on Friday to tie Miami Marlins prospect Griffin Conine for the most home runs in Minor League Baseball. Should Melendez finish the season with the most home runs in Minor League Baseball, he would be the first player to win the Joe Bauman Home Run Award—given to the Minor League player with the most home runs every season since 2002—whose primary position is catcher. He would join **Mike Moustakas** (36 HR, 2010) as Kansas City Royals prospects to win the Joe Bauman Home Run Award. Melendez has hit safely in eight straight games, batting .444 (12-for-27) with four home runs, six walks, and six strikeouts in that span. In addition to being tied for the most home runs in Minor League Baseball, Melendez is second in the minor in slugging percentage (.628) while ranking sixth in OPS (.999) and tied for sixth in extra-base hits (55).

**WUNDERKIND WITT:** **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** was named Triple-A East Player of the Month for August, batting .279/.342/.635 while leading the league in runs (25), RBIs (29), doubles (10), and total bases (66) and ranking second in the league with nine home runs. He hit safely in 20 of his 26 games and tallied at least one extra-base hit in 15 games to record a league-best 19 extra-base hits in August. He began the month by hitting four home runs in a six-game span—including his first career grand slam—from Aug. 2-8 to earn Triple-A Player of the Week honors. The following week on 8/14 vs. IOW, he stole his 20th base of the season to become the first Royals minor leaguer since **Alex Gordon** in 2006 to record a 20+ home run, 20+ stolen base season. Witt Jr. capped the month with a three-homer week across seven games from Aug. 24-29. Through 42 games at the Triple-A level, the 21-year-old is batting .301/.353/.613 with 18 doubles, 12 home runs, 38 runs scored, 34 RBIs, and eight stolen bases. The consensus No. 3 prospect in baseball and the consensus top prospect in the Royals' organization, Witt Jr. is batting .297/.362/.588 with 29 doubles, 28 home runs, 82 runs scored, 85 RBIs, and 22 stolen bases across 103 games between Double-A and Triple-A in his first full professional season. Witt Jr. is tied for the Minor League lead in extra-base hits (61), is tied for fourth in home runs (28), fourth in RBIs (85), and tied for seventh in total hits (124). He is the only player in Minor League Baseball with 25+ doubles, 25+ home runs, and 20+ stolen bases in 2021.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East with 179 home runs and have hit at least one home run in 16 of their last 18 games. The Chasers are currently on pace to hit 200 home runs during the 120-game regular season and 217 home runs in the 130 scheduled games in 2021. Neither mark would be enough to break the franchise record for home runs in a single season (231 in 141 games in 1999), but the 2021 Storm Chasers rate of 1.67 home runs/game would be a franchise best. The Chasers have recorded at least one home run in 84 of 107 games this season, notching a 56-28 record when hitting at least one home run. Omaha has recorded 49 multi-homer games, including five four-homer games, six five-homer games, and one seven-homer game.

**MINOR LEAGUE MASHERS:** The Omaha Storm Chasers roster currently includes three of the top five home run hitters in Minor League Baseball with **C MJ Melendez**, **1B Nick Pratto**, and **INF Bobby Witt Jr.** Melendez is tied with Griffin Conine for the most home runs in Minor League Baseball with 35. Pratto and Witt Jr. are tied for fourth with 28 home runs. **INF/OF Ryan McBroom** is tied for seventh in MiLB and first in Triple-A East with 27 home runs.

**FOR OMAHA:** **RHP Eddie Butler** makes his 13th start and 27th appearance of the season for Omaha and his second start in this series. Butler allowed three runs (one earned) on three hits in 5.0 innings on Tuesday with a season-high-tying four walks and zero strikeouts. The right-hander has completed at least 5.0 innings in six of his last seven starts.

**FOR TOLEDO:** **RHP Ricardo Pinto** makes his 13th start (14th appearance) for Toledo and second start of this series. He allowed seven runs (three earned) on a season-high-tying 10 hits on Tuesday in 5.1 innings, snapping a streak of five straight starts of 6.0+ innings.

- Signed with Kansas City as MiLB FA on 5/5
- Made Omaha and Royals organization debut on 5/12 @ COL
- Had recently signed with the independent Southern Maryland Blue Crabs when contract was purchased by Kansas City
- Spent the 2020 season with the independent Chicago Dogs of the American Association, posting a 5.65 ERA in 12 appearances (11 starts), striking out 40 and walking 24 in 65.1 innings
- Pitched for NC Dinos of the Korean Baseball Organization in 2019, making 13 starts and recording a 4.76 ERA in 73.2 innings with 49 strikeouts and 28 walks
- Began the 2018 season making eight relief appearances for the Chicago (NL) before being traded to Texas along with Rollie Lacy and a PTBNL for Cole Hamels
- Made 22 relief appearances for the Rangers in 2018, recording a 6.47 ERA in 32.0 innings
- Has never pitched against Omaha despite spending parts of five seasons pitching in the Pacific Coast League
- Made MLB debut with Colorado on June 6, 2014 vs. Los Angeles (NL)
- Prior to the 2014 season, was the No. 24 prospect in baseball according to Baseball America
- Drafted by Colorado in the 1st round (46th overall) of the 2012 MLB Draft out of Radford University
- Was the second first-round pick for Colorado in 2012, following David Dahl (10th overall)
- Earned Big South Pitcher of the Year honors with Radford in 2012 (shared with Aaron Burke) after posting a school-record 2.20 ERA
- Was initially drafted by Texas in the 35th round of the 2009 MLB Draft but did not sign
