> LHP Josh Hartle, MLB Pipeline's No. 22 Cleveland prospect, has yet to allow a home run in his first 7 career High-A starts. The left-hander has recorded a 2.37 ERA in 30.1 IP so far this season.

The Captains lead MiLB and MLB with 46 R in the 7th inning of games this year. This includes a 1 run in the bottom of the 7th inning in Tuesday night's 4-2 seriesopening victory over Lansing.

LAST, BUT CERTAINLY NOT LEAST: The final two hitters in Lake County's order, LF Esteban González and DH Juan Benjamin, went a combined 6-for-8 with RALPHY'S POWERFUL BAT: 1B/LF Ralphy Velazquez, MLB 3 R, 2 2B, and 2 RBI on Tuesday night. The pair hit a 2-out RBI double and 2-out RBI single in consecutive atbats in the bottom of the 8th inning, which proved to be the difference in a 4-2 win.

FAVORS' QUALITY START: LHP Caden Favors (ND) recorded the 1st quality start by a Captains pitcher this season. The southpaw pitched a career-high 6 innings, allowing just 2 hits, 1 earned run, and 2 walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 83 pitches (57 strikes). Favors tallied Lake County's first regular season quality start since RHP Carter Spivey on Sept. 7, 2024 at Peoria.

DEFEND THE 'SHIP: This season, the Captains are ooking to win back-to-back Midwest League Championships. Lake County will look to record the 7th instance of a franchise winning consecutive MWL titles.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

KNAPCZYK'S ON FIRE: INF Christian Knapczyk has become one of the Midwest League's premier hitters to begin his High-A career. The 2023 5th-round pick out of Louisville leads the Midwest League in OPS (.971) and H (44, tied), while ranking top-3 in: AVG (.344, 2nd), OBP (.455, 2nd), and SLG (.516, 3rd). He also ranks 5th in TB (66). So far this month, Knapczyk leads the Midwest League in H (25) and ranks 2nd in AVG (.410). The 23-year-old is also currently on an 12-game hitting streak, batting .413 with 19 H and a 1.074 OPS during this span.

JOSE'S HOT START: After winning the 2024 Midwest League Championship with Lake County, INF Jose Devers has excelled early to begin the 2025 campaign. The Samana, DR native leads the Midwest League with 21 XBH and 15 2B, while ranking T-6th in TB (65) and just outside of the top-10 in HR (5, T-11th). After hitting 7 HR in 102 games with the Captains last year, Devers already has 5 HR in his first 38 games this season.

Pipeline's No. 6 Cleveland prospect, ranks T-4th in the Midwest **League with 6 HR**, while ranking T-7th in RBI (25) and top-15 in R (23, T-13th) and XBH (14, T-14th).

ALFONSIN'S AWESOME OFFENSE: OF Alfonsin Rosario, MLB Pipeline's No. 25 Cleveland prospect, has had a strong start to his High-A career. The 20-year-old ranks 8th in the Midwest League with a .495 SLG and top-15 in HR (5, T-11th) and OPS *(.848, 14th),* while batting .280 in his first 28 High-A games. Rosario was the only Single-A player with 15+ HR, 70+ RBI, and 20+ SB last year with Single-A Myrtle Beach (CHC).

PÉREZ'S PROLIFIC PITCHING: LHP Steven Pérez has been one of the Midwest League's premier relief pitchers this year, logging a 0.90 ERA and 23 K to just 4 BB in 12 appearances. The San Fernando de Apure, VZ native is the only MiLB pitcher with 20+ IP, 2-or-fewer ER allowed, and a 0.70-or-lower WHIP this season.

SANTOS SAILING IN ON HISTORY: On Jan. 30, it was announced that Manager Omir Santos would return for his 3rd season as Lake County's skipper. He is now the longesttenured manager in Captains history, and 1 of just 2 to win a championship for Lake County (Ted Kubiak, 2010). With a 163-136 (.545) record at the helm, Santos is 8 victories away from becoming the winningest manager in Captains history.



BIO

Mokoro (wears #43) enters her first season as Lake County's Bat Dog, and first season with the Guardians organization. The 1-year-old Chocolate Labrador Retriever is owned and trained by **Victoria Brody**. **Brody** is a professional dog trainer who started Mission Empawthy, LLC, a local dog training company which focuses on specializing in psychiatric service dogs for those whose disabilities aren't always visible. **Mokoro will retrieve bats** and balls for the Captains alongside Brody at all Thursday home games this season!

Mokoro is named after a type of dugout canoe found in Botswana. These vessels, which usually carry 1-2 passengers, are commonly used to navigate the Okavango Delta for both transport and game viewing safaris. While mekoro (plural form of "mokoro") used to primarily be made from Jackalberry, Mangosteen, and Sausage trees, they are now mainly made from fiberglass.

LAST TIME OUT: LHP Josh Hartle (W, 3-0) earned his 3rd straight win in an eventual 9-1 Captains victory at Great Lakes in Game 1 of a doubleheader back on Thursday, May 15. The southpaw pitched a careerhigh 5.2 innings, allowing 5 hits, one earned run, and no walks, while throwing 4 strikeouts in 76 pitched (52 strikes). Hartle's lone run allowed was courtesy of a two-out RBI single in the bottom of the 6th inning, when a bequeathed runner scored.

TOP 30 PROSPECT: Hartle is a Top 30 Guardians prospect by both MLB Pipeline (No. 22) and Baseball America (No. 25). MLB Pipeline on Hartle: "At his best, Hartle exhibits advanced feel for a plus slider, solid cutter and average fastball and changeup. His heater sat at 89-92 mph and topped out at 94 with less life and command last spring, and he became reluctant to throw it when it got pounded. His low-80s slider and upper-80s cutter weren't as sharp as in the past, and his sinking mid-80s changeup rarely landed in the zone." Baseball America on Hartle: "Hartle is an interesting project for Cleveland's savvy pitching development machine. If his velocity bounces back, he has the strike-throwing acumen and polish to move quickly and profile as a back-of-the-rotation starter."

CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: Hartle was named the second 2025 Captain of the Week, presented by Official League on April 21. Across 2 starts on April 15 and April 20 at Fort Wayne, the left-hander allowed just 1 unearned run and throwing 11 K to just 2 BB in 8 combined innings of work. For the week of April 15 through 20, Hartle was the only Midwest League pitcher to throw double-digit strikeouts, and 1 of just 2 to make 2 starts.

READY TO LEARN GUARDS BALL: On Dec. 10, 2024, Hartle was traded to the Cleveland Guardians from the Pittsburgh Pirates. He was traded to Cleveland along with fellow Captains LHP Michael Kennedy and current Guardians RHP Luis Ortiz in exchange for INF Spencer Horwitz.

DEMON DEACON: A 3rd-round pick in 2024, **Hartle** was a highly touted prospect coming out of Wake Forest, one of the country's premier Division I baseball programs. <u>The 2023 Golden Spikes Award</u> Semifinalist enjoyed a stellar career in Winston-Salem, earning First Team All-ACC honors in 2023, and 2024 Preseason First Team All-American honors by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game. In four years as a starter, Hartle racked up 24 wins across 246.2 IP. He also struck out 275 batters in his career, including a 140-strikeout season in 2023 that ranked fifth in the nation and second in program history. Hartle was teammates at Wake Forest with RHPs Chase Burns and Rhett Lowder. MLB Pipeline's top two Cincinnati Reds prospects, and 1B Nick Kurtz, MLB Pipeline's No. 1 Athletics prospect.

GATORADE: Following a dominant senior year in 2021 at Reagan High School (Pfafftown, NC), Hartle was awarded Gatorade Player of the Year for the state of North Carolina. In his time at Reagan, he helped lead them to a North Carolina 4A State Championship title. <u>Due to his high school success, he was rated the</u> No. 25 recruit in the country for the Class of 2021 by Perfect Game. In North Carolina, he was rated the No. 1 LHP in his class. Before deciding to attend Wake Forest, coming out of high school, Hartle was listed as the 34th-best prospect in the 2021 MLB Draft according to Baseball America.

STARS AND STRIPES: From 2017-19. Hartle spent time as a member of the USA Baseball National Team Development Program. In 2018, he appeared in all nine games at the WBSC U-15 Baseball World Cup in David, Panama splitting time between 1B, DH, and P. In the Gold Medal Game vs. Panama, Hartle registered 2 RBI at the plate in a 7-1 Team USA win. He finished the tournament 2nd on the team in both RBI (12), and SLG (.400). On the mound, the left-hander logged a 0.90 ERA across a team-leading 10.0 innings.

LAST TIME OUT: RHP Yorman Gómez (ND) did not record a decision in a 2-0 Captains victory at Great Lakes in Game 2 of a doubleheader back on Thursday, May 15. In his 1st start of the season, the righthander pitched 4 innings in his 3rd consecutive outing, allowing just 3 hits, no runs, and 1 walk, while throwing 6 strikeouts. In 3 appearances (1 start) this month, Gómez owns a 0.75 ERA, 0.92 WHIP, and .174 opposing AVG.

CAPTAIN OF THE WEEK: On May 13, Gómez was named the Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for the week of May 6-11. Back on May 8, in his lone appearance during Lake County's series versus Quad Cities, the right-hander earned a 4-inning save in a 9-1 Captains win. The Coro, Venezuela native allowed just 2 hits, 1 earned run, and 1 walk, while throwing a season-high 7 strikeouts.

IN THE SYSTEM: Gómez's 245 strikeouts with Single-A Lynchburg and Lake County since 2023 are the 7th-most in the Cleveland Player Development System. Additionally, his 17 wins rank T-5th among Guardians Minor Leaguers during this span, while his 252.0 IP rank 9th.

SEVENTH HEAVEN: On Aug. 22, 2024 at West Michigan, in his 1st High-A road start, Gómez pitched a pro career-high 7 innings in an eventual 7-1 Lake County victory. The right-hander earned his 1st career High-A win, allowing just 3 hits, 1 earned run, and 2 walks, while throwing 5 strikeouts in 92 pitches (61 strikes). This performance is Gómez's lone career High-A quality start to date.

PROMOTED TO LAKE COUNTY: Gómez was assigned to Lake County from Single-A Lynchburg on Aug. 12, 2024, and was 1 of 4 Hillcats promoted to Lake County that day. He was the 7th Lynchburg Hillcat to earn a promotion to Lake County in 2024.

KING OF THE HILL: In 46 appearances (42 starts) across 2023 and 2024 with Single-A Lynchburg, Gómez struck out 196 batters, the most by a Hillcats pitcher since RHP Mitch Brown struck out 229 and LHP Luis Lugo struck out 232 in 2015-16.

CAROLINA IN MY MIND: At the time of his promotion to Lake County, Gómez ranked top-10 in the 2024 Carolina League in: innings pitched (104.0, 1st), starts (20, 2nd), opposing AVG (.231, 4th), wins (7, T-4th), strikeouts (96, T-5th), and WHIP (1.25, 6th).

CORO, VENEZUELA NATIVE: Gómez hails from Coro, Venezuela, the 2nd-oldest city in Venezuela (next to Cumaná) founded on July 26, 1527 by Spanish army officer Juan de Ampíes. He joins Wuilfredo Antunez (Rio Tucaní, VZ), Jaison Chourio (Maracaibo, VZ), Esteban González (Maracaibo, VZ), Steven Pérez (San Fernando de Apure, VZ), and Kevin Rivas (San Felipe, VZ) as 1 of 6 current Captains to hail from Venezuela. The lone Major Leaguer from Coro, Venezuela is César Gutiérrez, who played parts of 2 seasons with San Francisco and parts of 3 seasons with Detroit from 1969-71. Gutiérrez is 1 of 2 players in MLB history to record 7 hits without making an out in a doubleheader, doing so against Cleveland in 1970.
