TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and El Paso get set for game five of the series tonight at 6:05 p.m. from Dell Diamond. Express RHP Tyson Miller is slated to start up against Chihuahuas RHP Pedro Avila.

TIME TO RECAP

Friday's battle on the mound went to Round Rock as they came away with a 4-0 win over El Paso. The Express took a 1-0 lead in the first inning, courtesy of DH Josh Jung. After a one-out walk for LF Kole Calhoun, Jung ripped a double down the left field line, on the eighth pitch of the at-bat, to score Calhoun. Round Rock added three more runs in the second inning, all with two outs. After C Matt Whatley belted a solo home run that traveled 397 feet, CF Elier Hernandez walked and Calhoun doubled. Jung batted next and hit a ground ball to El Paso 3B Kervin Pichardo. His throwing error to first base allowed two runs to score and the lead increased to 4-0. El Paso collected only four hits on the night and never had a baserunner reach third base. The Express closed out the night with six-outs from reliever RHP Tyler Duffey. Round Rock LHP Dallas Keuchel (1-0, 2.31) earned the win after he tossed 7.0 innings of scoreless baseball. El Paso LHP Jay Groome (0-1, 2.87) went 5.0 frames in his start and allowed four runs, but only two were earned.

MILLER ON THE MOUND

Express RHP Tyson Miller is slated to start Saturday night. He is 2-6 with a 5.05 ERA (37 ER/66.0 IP) in 23 games and 11 starts. The righty has issued 35 walks and struck out 89. He owns a 1.58 WHIP and opponents are hitting .263 against him.

KEUCHEL CARVES UP EL PASO

LHP Dallas Keuchel went 7.0 scoreless frames on Friday and allowed four hits, one walk and struck out six. He collected 10 ground ball outs. The left-hander has produced 32 ground ball outs in his four starts with the Express compared to four fly ball outs. In his four starts, he owns a 2.31 ERA (6 ER/23.1 IP) with 11 walks to 22 strikeouts. The southpaw has at least five strikeouts in all four outings and he owns a 1.03 WHIP.

JUNG KNOCKS IN ANOTHER

DH Josh Jung extended his hitting streak to nine games on Friday night with a 1-for-4 showing that included a double and a RBI. Jung has hit either a double or a home run in eight of those nine contests. He has 17 RBI including 11 in his last four games. The right-hander is slashing .405/.463/.946 and he's struck out only six times in nine games.

SCORELESS STREAK

While LHP Dallas Keuchel went 7.0 innings and RHP Tyler Duffey went the final 2.0 frames to earn the shutout, Round Rock pitchers have not allowed a run in their last 14.1 innings on the mound. El Paso last scored a run in the fourth inning on Thursday night while facing RHP Cole Winn. The Express bullpen has not surrendered a run in their last 11.1 innings. They last allowed a run on Thursday night in the seventh inning.

DUFFEY SLAMS THE DOOR

RHP Tyler Duffey made quick work of the Chihuahuas lineup to complete the shutout. He tossed 2.0 scoreless frames while not allowing anyone to reach base. He struck out two along the way. In two outings, Duffey has not allowed a run over 3.0 innings of work.

LATEST TRANSACTIONS

C Wilson Ramos signed a minor league contract with the Texas Rangers and was assigned to Round Rock on Saturday afternoon. OF Elier Hernandez cleared waivers and returned to the Express on Friday after he was designated for assignment by the Rangers on August 16. RHP A.J. Alexy was recalled to Texas on Friday.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Fifteen players have made their Triple-A debut as part of the Round Rock Express so far during the 2022 season. RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all played their first game at the Triple-A level on Opening Day, April 5, 2022, while RHP Hever Bueno made his debut during the April 6 contest. Martinez, RHP Seth Nordlin, C Konner Pizzo, LHP Cole Ragans, OF Josh Sale, RHP Tyree Thompson and C Matt Whatley. Members of the Express that have made their Major League debuts in 2022 include INF Ezequiel Duran, OF Elier Hernandez, LHP Cole Ragans, INF Josh Smith, OF Bubba Thompson and OF Steele Walker.

STATING THE FACTS

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
