Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Yorman Gomez** to the mound tonight, looking to open the series with a victory (5-1 in last six openers, outscoring opponents 73-31). The Cubs will counter with RHP **Kohl Franklin**. Columbus is 54-39 (.581) versus right handers this year. Franklin has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as tonight will be his sixth career game in the IL.

vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 19-19 opposing the I-Cubs (34-26 in the last 60G). Individually, **Milan Tolentino** has hit the Cubs at a .337 clip (32x95) with 9HR and 24RBI in his career (27G). **Cooper Ingle** has batted .344 (11x32) with 3HR and 9RBI in 10G, while **Kahlil Watson** has hit .308 () with 3HR and 11RBI in 14G (**Kody Huff** owns 17RBI in 19G).

Start with a Bang

Over the last 28G, the Clippers have plated 207 runs (most in the IL, 7.4 per), with 141 (68%) tallied in the first four innings of the game, including 52 in the 1st (11 multi-run 1sts). The opposition has only 68 in the first four innings of the last 28G, but is outscoring the Clippers 99-66 thereafter. Columbus is the only undefeated team in the IL when leading after the 7th (50-0, 60 straight since 8/22/25).

Back to the Launch Pad

Last week saw the Clippers hit 6HR, while giving up the same (went into series averaging 2.6 and allowing 2.1 in prior 22G), but they still lead all of pro baseball in homers hit since 7/28 (63, accounting for 51% of runs: 105 of 207) and have allowed the 5th most (53, leads IL; accounts for 47%: 79 of 167). Huntington Park has been breached 74 times in the last 16G (park record 39HR in last series, vs. St. Paul).

Chasing Down the Walks

The lineup drew 8BB on Sunday, establishing the 2nd most walks in franchise history (681 in 129G, most in the IL by 54; Iowa leads with 655BB allowed). The Clippers are pacing for 776BB, a total that would obliterate the club record set in 1983 (741 in 140G). On the mound, the staff is pacing to allow 634BB, a number that would place 5th on the all-time list (top three seasons have been the last three).

Ingle is Back

In 37G since his option, **Cooper Ingle** is 45x141 (.319), drawing 36BB (.455OBP) with 16XBH (6HR, .518SLG; 0XBH in last 13G). His 2BB game on Saturday was his 19th multi-BB game of the season, as he sits at 2nd in the IL with 77BB (400PA; **Christian Cairo** leads the IL with 82BB in 470PA). At catcher, Ingle has a 1.239OPS (.15HR) in 48G (.651OPS, 3HR in 39G between DH and LF).

Big Time Production

Kyle Manzardo has hit safely in each of 13G since 8/15 (.352, 19x54, 2HR), while collecting 18RBI (RBI in 10G of streak). In his Columbus career, Manzardo has played only 124G (546PA), but he has still managed 68XBH (.560SLG), including 30HR, against just 54 singles. Additionally, he has scored 98 times with 88RBI, while keeping his strikeout rate under 20% (104K, 19%; 83BB, 15%).

King Ralph

Dating to 7/28, **Ralph Velazquez** leads the IL in HR (17, +6), RBI (40, +12) and SLG (.864, +128) and, aside from going 0x21 in 6G at St. Paul (7/21-7/26), is hitting .341/.419/.692 since 6/18 (20HR, 54RBI). Friday night's 3-run homer snapped a 16AB homerless streak (6.1AB per in last 27G) and Sunday's RBI built on a new career high (88RBI between Columbus and Akron; 50HR and 173RBI since '25).

Another High

Kody Huff tied his career high with his 19th double on Friday, having already set personal bests in games (103, +2), runs (73, +28), hits (93, +11), triples (6, +4), HR (19, +12), RBI (72, +25), walks (62, +18) and steals (12, +5). Leading the team in runs and RBI, Huff is the fourth 70-70 Clipper since '19 (**Johnathan Rodriguez**, **Jhonkensy Noel**, **Juan Brito**). He has reached base in 19 straight (.357OBP).

Out of a Slump

The bottom third of the order, **Milan Tolentino** (.098, 4x41), **Blake Perkins** (.138, 4x29) and **Dayan Frias** (.040, 1x25), had a rough two weeks prior to Sunday, but each went deep on getaway day in Indy, combining to go 5x12 with 4HR (Frias had 2HR). **George Valera** saw his hit streak snapped at 10G (.359, 14x39, 4HR, 12RBI) on Sunday, following a 20G stretch (6/27-7/28) in which he hit .111 (8x72).

This Date in Clipper History

9/1/2008

Columbus lost to the Toledo Mud Hens 3-0 in the last game ever played at Cooper Stadium. **Tyler Clippard** (10K) and **Jim Ed Warden** (3K) combined to strikeout 13 Mud Hens and establish a new team record for strikeouts in a season with 1,089. Cooper Stadium had been home to Columbus baseball since 1932 and saw the Clippers win seven Governors' Cup Championships (most in the IL from 1977-2008).

First Half Wrap

Despite being eliminated from playoff contention on the penultimate Sunday of the first half, the Clippers were 41-33 and finished with their first winning record in the front half since the season was split in 2023 (averaged 32 wins from 2023-25, topping out at 34-38, .472, last season). From 4/22-6/17, they spent every day between 3.0 and 6.0 games off the lead, while occupying anywhere between 4th and 13th in the standings. A late push (15-6 from 5/16-6/9) got them to within 2.5 before derailing with a 3G losing streak at Indy to seal their fate. On the back half, Columbus has posted just one winning record, clinching a playoff berth in 2024 with a mark of 48-26 (.649).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,494 to 1,439).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 180-145 (.554) in pitch reviews, with batters going 92-87 (.514) and pitchers/catchers going 88-58 (.603). They have run out of challenges in 48G and have not challenged in 8G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 5-4 in extra innings this year, after having gone .500 in each of the last two seasons. Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 55-37 when playing past regulation (.598, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 27-17 at home (.614; 5-7 in last 12G). Of the 92G to require extra play, 73 have been resolved after one frame (including nine DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 on 9/20/22 at Toledo).

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to top 800 again (on pace for 847, would rank as 4th most all-time; record is 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 150 through 129G (on pace for 171SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 44CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing for the 2nd most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (50; nabbed 51 times in 2024).

Crazy Eighthths

From the 8th inning on, the Clippers have scored an IL-best 180 runs while crafting a .883OPS (over 60 points better than all other teams). On the flipside, Columbus has given up 120 runs from the 8th on, resulting in a +60 run differential (Clippers are getting outscored 297-186 from innings 5-7).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 80 grand slams and 1,991RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.48 through 129G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). Additionally, the staff is pacing to give up 209HR (would be 2nd most in franchise history; 214HR allowed in 2023).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 8th in the IL this year (.980), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 70G this season (41-29, .586), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Good Baseball

CJ Kayfus bunted a runner into scoring position with a single on 7/5 vs. Louisville, with that runner kicking off a 5-run inning that led the Clippers to victory. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 90-23 (.796) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 7-2 mark this season (.778, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers have the 10th most last at bat wins this year (14, four off the lead) while playing in the 13th most games decided in the last at bat (27, Norfolk has 39). Since the start of the 2024 season, Columbus has played in 101G decided in the last at bat (2nd most in the IL), going 48-53 (.475, 16th best winning percentage; 3rd most wins, 2nd most losses).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's seventh year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 455-466 (.494), 425-420 with Columbus (.503).

500K

Gomez surpassed 500K in his career on 8/20 vs. St. Paul (509K, 491.1IP). He has seen his strikeout rate tick up this season (25.4%, 64K to 252BF between Rookie League and Triple-A; 24.7% in career prior), but his walk rate has increased with it (12.3%, 30BB; was at 9.1% prior). A month ago, on 8/1 vs. Toledo, **Trenton Denholm** picked up his 500th career strikeout (542.1IP; **Logan Allen** collected his 500th minor league strikeout two days prior, 7/30 vs. Toledo, 399.0IP).

Injury Delay:

Gomez was slated to make his Triple-A debut during the season-opening series at Iowa, but injured his shoulder in his last preseason bullpen to wind up on the shelf (missed 72G; Clippers went 40-32). He was sent to Arizona at the end of May to rehab, appearing in 4G for the Guardians.

Bad Bookends:

On 7/19 vs. Indianapolis, Gomez gave up a career worst 7ER to add over two runs to his season ERA (5.06 to 7.08). He then locked in at St. Paul on 7/25 (5.1IP, 0ER) and 7/31 vs. Toledo (5.1IP, 1ER) to shave over two runs off his ERA (7.08 to 4.94), before allowing a new career worst of 9ER at Syracuse on 8/8 (ERA jumped back to 6.82). Gomez surrendered 4HR to the Mets on 8/8 (20BF) and gave up 2HR in each of 3GS from 7/2-7/19 (59BF; had 0HR to 40BF from 7/25-7/31).

Racking Up Strikeouts:

Since his Triple-A debut on 6/20, Gomez has averaged 9.7K/9IP, good for the 9th best rate in the IL (50K, 46.1IP; **Trenton Denholm** is 11th at 9.5K/9IP). In terms sheer numbers, his 50K rank 16th in the IL (Denholm is 1st, 61K, and **Logan Allen** is 29th, 44K). As a team, the Clippers have the 12th most strikeouts in the league since 6/20 (498K in 57G, 8.7 per game; ranked 12th in the IL prior, 630K in 72G, 8.8 per).

House of Horror:

Through his first six weeks in the IL, Gomez pitched at Omaha, Lehigh Valley and St. Paul, accumulating a 1.93ERA (14.0IP, 3ER) and holding hitters to a .146 average (7x48) with a .333SLG (2HR). He was then greeted rudely in a loss at Syracuse on 8/8 (3.1IP, 9ER, 4HR). Gomez has also struggled in Huntington Park, registering a 7.36ERA (25.2IP, 21ER), while opponents have hit .293 (29x99) with a .586SLG (8HR).

Right Stuff:

While in the Rookie League, Gomez mowed down opposing right-handers, racking up 10K against 21BF (48%; 4K to 23BF on the left side, 17%). When they did put the bat on the ball (5x20, .250), righties notched 3XBH (all doubles; .400SLG), compared to 0XBH from lefties (5x17, .295). His strikeout rate in Triple-A is fairly even (27K against 114BF from the left and 23K vs. 94BF from the right), but right handers are still teeing off when they do connect (21x80, 8HR, .638SLG).
