Right-hander **Joey Estes** gets the ball for Lansing in his ninth start of the year, opposed by Beloit southpaw **Patrick Monteverde**, who gave up home runs to **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Austin Beck** while striking out seven Lugnuts in five innings on May 25th at ABC Supply Stadium

Yesterday: Sky Carp 1, Lugnuts 0. **Cody Morissette** led off the ballgame with a home run over the right field wall, and that proved to be the only run of the game as Beloit prevailed in a five-hit shutout on a Wednesday matinee. The result was not without controversy; with two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Lugnuts catcher **Jared McDonald** launched a drive that appeared to hit off the top of the right field wall and bounce off the gray railings for a game-tying home run. However, bases umpire **Justin Juska** ruled that the ball did not hit the railing and remained in play for a double.

Transactions: Earlier today, P **Charles Hall** was promoted to Double-A Midland, replaced on the roster by P **Jack Owen** from Single-A Stockton in a corresponding move to aid the bullpen.

Strong First Impression: INF **Sahid Valenzuela**, promoted yesterday to Midland from the Lugnuts, enjoyed a smashing Double-A debut with a 2-for-3 performance including his first home run of the season, backing up four shutout innings from southpaw **Hogan Harris** in a 4-0 win.

Big League Nuts: 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopes** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Goose Eggs: The last three games in Lansing have ended in shutouts: a 14-0 Fort Wayne win on Sunday, a 10-0 Lugnuts victory Tuesday and a 1-0 Sky Carp win yesterday. It might have been four shutouts in a row, were it not for Fort Wayne scoring five runs in the ninth inning Saturday to wipe out a 4-0 deficit (only to see the Nuts tally twice in the bottom of the ninth for a dramatic 6-5 win).

Halfway Home: Tonight marks the end of the first half of the Midwest League season. Great Lakes and Dayton, the top two teams in the Eastern Division, have punched their playoff tickets, as have the West Division's top two teams, Cedar Rapids and Wisconsin. 66 games remain in the season after tonight.

26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Personal: Signed for \$497,500 with the Atlanta Braves as the 487th overall selection in 2019... notable names taken in the 16th round: Oraj Anu, Kona Quiggle, DJ Gladney and Jackxarel Lebron... first ever player drafted out of Paraclete H.S... at age 17, was one of the youngest players in the draft, but had velocity already touching 96 mph... signed by Braves away from commitment to Long Beach State... wearing his hair longer than he's ever worn it in his life, and says it's because of his mother, who also has very long hair.

2019 Professional Debut: Made first MiLB appearance on July 20, shutting out the GCL Rays on one hit in two innings, striking out three... gave up five runs apiece over the next two outings before recovering with three perfect innings vs. GCL Orioles on August 5... allowed .300 avg. to left-handed batters, .241 to right-handers.

2021 Breakout: Named 2021 Low-A East Pitcher of the Year... established himself as the ace of the Augusta GreenJackets, though he began season as the No. 5 starter... led Low-A East in strikeouts (127), ERA (2.91), average (.184) and WHIP (0.96)... struck out 11 Myrtle Beach Pelicans in 5 2/3 IP on June 9... twirled seven scoreless innings, allowing two hits, striking out seven vs. Myrtle Beach on July 9... whiffed 10 Columbia Fireflies in 5 1/3 IP on July 21... fired nine-inning CG vs. Kannapolis on August 14 (9 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 14 K)... emphatic home/road splits: at home in Augusta: 0.81 ERA in 10 GS, 1 CG, 55 1/3 IP, 30 H, 5 ER, 2 HR, 11 BB, 76 K, .153 avg., 0.74 WHIP... on the road: 5.56 ERA in 10 GS, 43 2/3 IP, 36 H, 27 ER, 5 HR, 18 BB, 51 K, .221 avg., 1.24 WHIP... limited lefties to .148 avg.; right-handers batted .213.

2022 to Oakland: Traded by Atlanta to Oakland with OF Cristian Pache, C Shea Langeliers and P Ryan Cusick in exchange for 1B Matt Olson on March 14, 2022... Pache is in the Majors, Langeliers is in Triple-A and Cusick is in Double-A.

- Made unofficial debut for the Lugnuts in the 2022 Crosstown Showdown presented by Delta Dental, tossing four innings against Michigan State on April 6: two hits, one run (a Peter Ahn solo HR), one walk and five strikeouts, as the Lugnuts won, 3-2.

- Made official Lugnuts debut in Game 1 of a doubleheader at West Michigan, April 14... departed one out into the 5th with a 7-2 lead (though reliever David Leal then allowed an inherited runner to score); Nuts went on to triumph, 8-5.

- April 20 vs. Fort Wayne: gave up two 2-R HRs to Joshua Mears, in the 3rd and the 5th, to spoil a solid outing; departed after 4 2/3 innings with 5 K's in Nuts' 9-7 loss.

- April 28 at Lake County: blanked the Captains on three hits and one walk over five innings.

- May 21 at Great Lakes: was spinning a gem (5 1/3 IP, 1 R, 7 K) before getting injured (hip) fielding a swinging bunt up the third base line... on the Injured List, May 23-June 12.

- Returned June 12 with two scoreless innings vs. West Michigan.

- Followed up on June 13 with three innings vs. Fort Wayne, allowing two-run homer in the first inning to Robert Hassell III and a solo tally in the second.

Evaluations:

- MLB Pipeline ranks Estes as the No. 15 prospect in the A's system and the No. 5 pitching prospect... grades: fastball 55, slider 50, changeup 45, control 50... "All of Estes' stuff is trending in the right direction. He averaged 93.5 mph with his fastball in 2021, a good tick or two harder than in 2019 when he first entered pro ball, and it has unique characteristics and good life. At times, he relied on overpowering Low-A hitters just with the fastball, and other times, he mixed in an effective slider with better depth as well. There was some variability to it, thrown anywhere in the 82- to 87-mph range, with Estes having more success with it when he started throwing it a little harder. His changeup also improved, though it's still his third pitch."

- Keith Law had ranked Estes as the Braves' No. 15 prospect: "Drafted out of a California high school, Estes has gained about 2 mph since he was drafted, topping out now at 96 with good quality on the pitch and a slew of strikes. He struck out nearly a third of the guys he faced in Low A and did that mostly with his fastball, as his slider and changeup are still works in progress, with neither an average pitch yet. He has a super-short arm action and can come from a slightly lower slot, neither of which is ideal for a starter, but neither of which is a reason not to start him — they're just atypical. If he can improve those secondaries without changes to his delivery, which might in turn affect his control, he could be a back-end starter."

- Fangraphs places Estes at No. 21: "In Estes, Oakland acquired one of the Braves' breakout players from the 2021 campaign. A 16th-round pick in 2019 out of a California high school, Estes signed for a bonus of just under \$500,000, and that investment looks to have paid off handsomely after he put up a 32% strikeout rate in his full season debut. Estes doesn't blow you away with his stuff, but all three of his offerings are average to a tick above. His fastball was up and down much of the season, as he sat in the low-90s in some outings and was more 93-95 mph at his best. His low-80s slider ranges from fringy to plus, as he'll show occasional ability to put big sweep on the pitch, while his changeup is a bit firm but features good tumble. The three-pitch mix is made all the more effective by unpredictable sequencing and command of the entire arsenal that is well advanced for a pitching prospect who doesn't turn 21 until October. Estes has a back-end starter ceiling, and only injury should prevent him from reaching that mark.
