STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

CAPS SILENCED ON SUNDAY: The West Michigan Whitecaps committed a season-high five errors and managed just two runs in a 5-2 loss to the Quad Cities River Bandits on Sunday in front of a 2024-best 4,179 fans at LMCU Ballpark. The Whitecaps drop the six-game series, four games to two, while only managing four runs through dropping each of the final four contests. The five miscues are the most for the Whitecaps since a June 1, 2021 contest at Great Lakes. The ballgame remained scoreless until the third when Deivis Nadal blasted a two-run triple off the right-center field wall to highlight a three-run frame and give the River Bandits a 3-0 edge. In the fifth, a Trevor Werner RBI-single extended the Quad Cities lead to 4-0. The Whitecaps' opportunities were scarce, but a pair of inning-ending double plays throughout the middle innings halted any potential rallies and kept the score the same until the eighth. Max Anderson helped the 'Caps break through with a two-run single, ending the Bandits shutout bid and slicing the West Michigan deficit to 4-2. After a walk to Luke Gold loaded the bases, Roberto Campos's long fly ball to the left-center field gap failed to cut through a strong wind and was caught at the wall by Nadal to end the threat. Brett Squires's solo home run in the ninth added a Quad Cities insurance run, helping the River Bandits take the series' final four games. Bandits pitcher Shane Panzini (1-0) collects his first win of the season after tossing four innings out of the bullpen, while 'Caps lefty Carlos Pena (0-2) suffers his second loss in as many appearances. This defeat brings the Whitecaps' record to 3-6, while the River Bandits jump to 6-3. Anderson, Josh Crouch, and Carlos Mendoza each reached base twice for West Michigan in a losing cause.

GETTING BLANKED: The Whitecaps pitching staff collected a Midwest League-best 15 shutouts of their opponents this season, with the most recent one occurring on August 20 in a 5-0 win over the South Bend Cubs at LMCU Ballpark. The 'Caps also hold the Midwest League record for shutouts in a season with 27 back in 2017.

SWING FOR THE FENCES: The Whitecaps totaled 109 home runs last season - breaking the franchise record of 101 set in 2022.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold five of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, and are mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps IL holds five players in Ps Aaron Haase, and Jordan Marks, IF Abel Bastidas, P Gabe Sequeira and C Colin Burgess.

HIS NAME IS CARLOS: The Whitecaps hold four players with the first name Carlos in Ps Carlos Marcano, Carlos Pena, Carlos De Los Santos & IF Carlos Mendoza, giving West Michigan more Carlos's than any team in the Midwest League or among Tigers affiliates.

Marcano, who was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2021 (the same class that featured Cristian Santana) was the youngest pitcher in the Florida State League to surpass 20 innings pitched in 2023. The teenager held his own in his first full season at the low-A level, tossing 100 innings while going 4-5 with a 4.50 ERA and generating 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (holding opposing hitters to a .237 batting average against).

LAST START: Marcano, the youngest player on the Whitecaps roster, had one of the best starts among 'Caps pitchers on the young season, allowing just one run in four innings while striking out a pair as part of a 4-3 come-from-behind Whitecaps victory over the Quad Cities River Bandits on April 10 at LMCU Ballpark.

2023: After being a full-time member of the Flying Tigers bullpen the year prior, Marcano transitioned into the starting rotation where he posted a 4.50 ERA through 100 innings pitched and racked up 78 strikeouts and reducing hard contact (allowed just seven home runs).

2022: Marcano came out of the bullpen in his first season with the Flying Tigers but struggled with hard contact, posting a 4.68 ERA while giving up 47 hits through 42.1 innings pitched. However, his strikeout-to-walk ratio stood out, generating 41 punchouts to just 18 walks on the season.

2021: Marcano enjoyed his breakout in the Dominican Summer League. Despite a 5.25 ERA, he displayed his ability to rack up his strikeout totals, punching out 41 hitters while allowing just 10 walks through 36 innings of work.

More: His repertoire includes a sinker/fastball, two breaking balls, and a changeup. The fastball/sinker is his primary pitch that sits in the low 90s which he's able to generate a ton of ground balls with. The two breaking balls are a curveball and a slider. The slider posted a 54% whiff rate in 2023, while the curveball posted a 36%.

His size is very projectible - listed at 6'2, 150 pounds, there is still plenty of room to grow into his body.
