The Nuts are currently 3-4 during their 12-game, 13-day homestand vs. Fort Wayne and Beloit. Right-hander **Stevie Emanuels** gets the ball for Lansing in his 10th start of the year, opposed by the Doctor, Beloit ace right-hander **Michael David "M.D." Johnson**, who limited the Lugnuts to one run in seven innings on May 24th, striking out nine batters in a Sky Carp win.

**Last Night:** Lugnuts 10, Sky Carp 0. Starter **Mac Lardner** tossed a season high six scoreless innings, **Denzel Clarke** slugged his first High-A home run, and the Nuts cruised to victory in the series opener over Beloit. It was quite the reversal from Lansing's previous game, a 14-0 loss on Sunday to Fort Wayne. Left fielder **Gabriel Maciel** went 3-for-4 with an RBI double and a two-run single to lead the Lugnuts' 12-hit showing. The game was played in a season high 95-degree heat, with the heat index reaching up toward 100.

**Transactions:** Earlier today, INF **Sahid Valenzuela** was promoted to Double-A Midland and OF **Jonny Butler** was placed on the Injured List.

**Big League Nuts:** 6-foot-2, 280-pound pitcher **Max Castillo** (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach The Show. He is the 8th former Lugnut to reach the Majors this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers **Zach Logue** (2018) and **Zach Jackson** (2017) and infielder **Christian Lopez** (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman **Vinny Capra** (2018) and catcher **Gabriel Moreno** (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever **Danny Young** (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher **Josh Winckowski** (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

**Lemonade League Re-Vieaux:** When the 2020 Minor League Baseball season was canceled, the Lugnuts hosted the 20-game *Lemonade League*, a college wood-bat league with yellow baseballs. One of the two pitching coaches during Lemonade League play was **Cam Vieaux**, a former MSU Spartan working his way up through the Pirates' system. This past June 17, two years later, Vieaux was called up to make his MLB debut for the Pirates, tossing 2 2/3 scoreless innings with four strikeouts.

**The Road Back to Lansing:** The Arizona Complex League Athletics has a handful of familiar names for Lugnuts fans (plus pitcher **Dhrygler Gimenez**, which is an amazing name in of itself). 2021 Lugnuts right-handers **Reid Birlingmair** and **Brandon Withers** are currently rehabbing in the AZCL, as is 2022 Lugnuts right-hander **Jake Walkinshaw**, who flew in with the rest of the ballclub in early April and was scheduled to be in the Lansing starting rotation this year, only to be placed on the Nuts' Injured List on Opening Day and flown right back to Arizona. Yesterday, Walkinshaw started for the A's and struck out three batters in three innings, allowing one run on five hits and no walks. Withers relieved him with 1 2/3 innings (one hit, two runs, one walk, two strikeouts).

**A Toast to Quality Pitching:** **Blake Beers**, due to start again on Friday, has opened his Lugnuts' tenure with four consecutive quality starts:  
 - 6 innings, 0 runs, 11 strikeouts at Beloit  
 - 6 innings, 2 earned runs, 7 strikeouts vs. Cedar Rapids  
 - 7 innings, 1 run, 4 strikeouts at West Michigan  
 - 6 innings, 0 runs, 4 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne.

## 26 PHIL POHL MANAGER

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

**1999:** Lansing hosted its second Midwest League All-Star Game, won 4-0 by the West thanks to 14 pitchers combining on a one-hit shutout. The game took just 2:09 before a crowd of 10,234.

**2018:** Ryan Noda (now in Triple-A in the Dodgers' org.) made two diving catches in right field, and hit a two-run homer and a tie-breaking three-run double in a four-run eighth, pushing the Lugsnuts to a 7-4 victory over the Great Lakes Loons at Cooley Law School Stadium.

**Hometown:** Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Clara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree house) for \$36 million.

**Glory Days:** Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

**Life as a Huskie:** Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

**2021 Professional Debut:** Opened season as the Lugnugs' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnugs franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

## 2022 - Back in Lansing:

- Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, **April 10 vs. Lake County**, striking out six Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnugs topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... made first start of the year **April 15 at West Michigan**, pitched scoreless 1st and 2nd inning and recorded two outs into the 4th, but in between, gave up five runs on six hits in the 3rd inning, including doubles by Parker Meadows, Colt Keith and Jake Holton and a triple by Andrew Navigato... that supplied the lion's share of the White-caps' offense in a 6-3 victory over Lansing... **April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2:** tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnugs' 6-2 defeat... **May 11 vs. Dayton:** dominated the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings... four of the five were perfect, with a double (Justice Thompson) and two walks allowed in the third inning before he bore down and stranded the bases loaded... tied career high with seven strikeouts... Lugnugs won comfortably against the first-place Dragons, 6-1... **May 17 at Great Lakes:** started the first game of the series against the Loons, allowing six hits and four runs (three earned) in 3 2/3 IP... gave up one run in the 1st, one in the 2nd and two in the 3rd... allowed four extra-base hits, including a pair of triples to Jorbit Vivas and a triple to Jose Ramos... trailing 4-1 when he exited, Lugnugs came back to beat the Loons, 7-4... **May 22 vs. Great Lakes:** relieved Hogan Harris with two outs in the 2nd, recording the final out, and then proceeded to pitch four more scoreless innings, striking out six while allowing two hits and one walk... after departing, however, Lugnugs bullpen allowed three runs in 7th and four in the 8th in an 8-3 loss... **May 27 at Beloit, Game 1:** Allowed one run in the 3rd and four runs in 4th, departing after 3 2/3 IP in a 5-1 loss to the Sky Carp...
