VICUÑA HAS CAREER NIGHT: 2B Kevin Vicuña went 2-for-4 with a home run and a career-high four RBI as the Fisher Cats rallied for a 5-2 win over the Yard Goats last night at Dunkin' Donuts Park. He singled in the fourth inning to drive in a run to make it 1-1. In the top of the eighth, after a single by Jordan Groshans and a Vinny Capra walk, Vicuña hit his first homer of the season, a three-run shot to make it 4-2. Demi Orimoloye, the next batter, then hit his first home run to make it 5-2. Graham Spraker (W, 2-0) earned the win and Kyle Johnston picked up his first save.

JOHNSTON TO THE RESCUE: RHP Kyle Johnston, who turns 25 today, earned his first save of the season with a perfect ninth inning last night. It was just the sixth save for the Fisher Cats bullpen, and Brody Rodning (two saves) is the only pitcher with more than one save. Johnston, who came to the Blue Jays in a trade with Washington in 2019 for Daniel Hudson, had two saves for Class A Hagerstown in 2018.

BULLPEN IMPROVEMENT: New Hampshire's bullpen ERA has dropped from 5.02 to 4.58 since the roadtrip started July 6 in Binghamton. In 29.2 IP in the eight games, Fisher Cats relievers have allowed just 5 ER (1.52 ERA) with 46 strikeouts. It's been needed, because the starting pitcher for the Fisher Cats has not won on the trip, and one only once since June 25.

OFFENSE ON TOP OF PACK: The Fisher Cats enter Saturday's game with a .262 team batting average, the highest in Double-A Northeast. New Hampshire also has scored the most runs in the league with 343. In 13 of the club's 27 wins, the Fisher Cats have scored at least ten runs. New Hampshire is also tops in the league in OBP (.348), stolen bases (78) and hit-by-pitches with 47.

BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY: July 17, 2016-The Fisher Cats earned a split of a four-game series in Portland with a 5-4 win over the Sea Dogs. New Hampshire scored a pair of runs in the eighth inning to win – with RBI singles by Jason Leblibijian and Rowdy Tellez. John Stilson worked an inning of scoreless relief for the win, and Chris Smith earned his fourth save with two perfect innings in relief.

Kevin Smith had three hits, driving in a pair...Hillsboro over Vancouver 12-6, Dunedin won a wild 15-10, 10-inning game at Clearwater...FCL Jays won 12-7 over the Yankees...DSL Jays lost to the Reds 12-6 on Friday morning.


