Guerrero is in his 25th season in Minor League Baseball in 2023 and his 24th with the Brewers organization... Over his seven-year managerial career in Biloxi, Guerrero has earned a two trips to the Southern League Championship Series, in 2018 and 2019... Guerrero earned his start in coaching after a nine-year playing career from

1987-1998 in the Brewers and Royals organizations... Guerrero has managed at every level in Minor League Baseball, working from the Dominican Summer League (1995-2002), up to Triple-A (2012-13)... Guerrero also spent two years on the coaching staff with the Milwaukee Brewers at the big league level in 2014 and 2015.

YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?: The Shuckers tallied five stolen bases on Thursday night, the third time this year that they've swiped at least five in a game, all coming against the M-Braves... In 12 games against the M-Braves, the Shuckers are 39-41 (95%) in stolen base attempts... INF Tyler Black (10-10) and OF Isaac Collins (10-10) have combined to seal 20 bases against the M-Braves... In 2023, the Shuckers have stolen 98 bases, the fourth-highest total in Double-A... The Shuckers are two away from joining the Portland Sea Dogs (BOS) and the Somerset Patriots (NYY) as the third team to steal at least 100 bases in 2023.

TYLER'S GOT THE NEED... FOR SPEED: Entering today, INF Tyler Black has 28 stolen bases in 2023, the fifth-most in a single-season in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... Black is two away from becoming the fifth player in franchise history to steal 30 in a year, marking back-to-back years that a Shucker has done so... Black is currently needs 84 games to break OF Johnny Davis' franchise record of 52 stolen bases.

NEED AN ASSIST?: With a perfectly timed relay on Thursday started by OF Isaac Collins to nab a runner at the plate, the Shuckers tallied their 14th outfield assist of the year, tied for the seventh-most in Double-A and the third-most in the Southern League... OF Carlos Rodriguez leads the Shuckers with four outfield assists this year, tied for the fifth-most in the Southern League.

EXTENDING THE RECORD: INF Tyler Black extended his franchise-record on-base streak to 29 games with a single on Thursday night... Black's streak is the longest on-base streak in the Southern League this year... During his franchiserecord setting streak, Black has a .406 on-base percentage, and has drawn a walk in 21% of his plate appearances... Black has also reached base in 44 of his 45 appearances with the Shuckers this year.

CLOSING IT OUT IN STYLE: RHP Abner Uribe earned his sixth save of the year on Wednesday night against the M-Braves... In 2023, the righty has struck out 26 of the 57 batters faced, a 46% strikeout rate, which is the fifth-best mark in Double-A... Uribe has also induced a swinging strike on 20.9% of his pitches, the seventh-best mark in the Southern League (min. 10.0 IP).

TODAY'S STARTER // RHP T.J. SHOOK (2-1, 3.71): RHP T.J. Shook is set to make his second start of 2023 after striking out four and allowing one unearned run over 4.1 innings in his last appearance on Sunday against Pensacola... Shook made his first start of the year on May 28 against Montgomery, and went 3.2 innings... Today's game marks his 19th career start in Double-A, and his fourth career-start against the M-Braves.
