YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 10-1. Chris Meyers hit a three-run homer in the top of the first innign to open the scoring. **Adrian Sugastey** pulled the score to 3-1 with a run-scoring groundout in the fourth, Richmond's only run in the inning after loading the bases with no outs. Jake Holton hit an RBI single in the fifth and Carlos Mendoza singled in two runs in the eighth to push Erie's lead to 7-2. In the ninth, a Richmond error scored two Erie runs and Gage Workman added a three-run homer to cap the scoring. **Dylan Cumming** pitched out of the bullpen in his Double-A debut and struck out seven batters over four innings, allowing one run. Richmond had one hit, a double by **Will Wilson** in the fourth inning.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the fourth of a six-game series at The Diamond. The week marks Erie's only visit to Richmond this season. The Flying Squirrels were swept in six games at UPMC Park from May 7-12. Richmond returns to Erie for a six-game series from August 27-September 1.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 11-4 in their last 15 games after going 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on the last road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won five-of-six in each of their last two series, including at home against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie last week. The Flying Squirrels have lost back-to-back games for the first time since May 11-12.

THE SEAWOLVES are in third place in the Southwest Division, one game behind first-place Akron and Harrisburg. Erie has dropped five-of-its-last-seven games dating back to last Wednesday. This season, Erie has the second-lowest team ERA (3.09) in the Eastern League. Erie's roster includes three of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Troy Melton (No. 10), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 13) and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes two Erie players, including Melton (No. 10) and Lee (No. 12).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his 10th appearance and his ninth start of the season. He last pitched on Saturday night at Bowie and threw six scoreless innings in a win, his longest outing of the year and longest since 2022. He made two starts against the SeaWolves in Erie earlier this month, going 0-2 with a 5.14 ERA (4 ER/7.0 IP). Frisbee is ranked third in Flying Squirrels franchise history in career strikeouts (263), fourth (min. 150 IP) in K/9 (8.67) and tied for fourth in wins (18). On May 13, 2021, Frisbee threw six perfect innings in a combined no-hitter with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo, the first nine-inning no hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history and the second overall no-hitter in team history. On August 10, 2022 at Portland, Frisbee set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts and allowed one hit, a fourth-inning single by rehabbing Red Sox outfielder Kiké Hernández, over six scoreless innings. Last year, Frisbee spent most of the season with Richmond, going 6-0 with a 4.54 ERA in 27 appearances, his first season working primarily as a reliever. Frisbee was selected by the Giants in the 15th round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two.

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Carlos Pena makes his fifth Double-A start of the year and his second against Richmond. Last time out, Pena threw five innings, his longest outing of the year, and allowed two runs in a no-decision on Saturday against the Curve. In his last start against the Flying Squirrels on May 8, he pitched four scoreless innings, his only scoreless start at Double-A so far. Pena began the season with High-A West Michigan and pitched two games before being promoted to Double-A on April 15. He signed with the Tigers in March 2019. He spent all of last year in the Midwest League and went 5-6 with a 3.11 ERA in 24 games (21 starts).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans last month for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked third among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance.

GRANTING WISHES: In his last 14 games since May 15, **Grant McCray** is batting .413 (19-for-46) with two homers, six doubles, three triples, nine walks, nine RBIs and 15 runs scored, raising his season batting average from .135 to .220. He picked up a season-high three hits last Tuesday night at Bowie and matched it last Friday night. For the season, McCray is batting .135 (14-for-104) when batting first in the lineup compared to .413 (19-for-46) when batting third, fifth or sixth in the order. McCray is tied for first in the Eastern League in triples (3), fifth in extra-base hits (20) and tied for seventh in doubles (11). On Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week after he hit .550 (11-for-20) with a homer, three doubles, two triples, four walks, eight runs scored and five RBIs for the series in Bowie. McCray has reached base in 14 consecutive games dating back to May 12, which is tied for the third longest active streak in the Eastern League and is the longest by a Flying Squirrels player so far this season.

AWARDS SEASON: Along with Grant McCray being named Eastern League Player of the Week, John Michael Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday. He pitched six hitless innings on Thursday night at Bowie. He also threw seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and has combined for 13 hitless innings when facing Bowie this season. Bertrand became the second pitcher in team history to win two Pitcher of the Week awards in the same season, joining Eric Surkamp (2011). Along with Surkamp, Bertrand is the fourth pitcher in team history to win the Pitcher of the Week award multiple times, joining Matt Frisbee and Matt Gage. Last week marked the fourth time the Flying Squirrels have swept the league's weekly player and pitcher awards, joining Daniel Mayora and Justin Fitzgerald (July 9-16, 2012), Steven Duggar and Andrew Suarez (July 18-24, 2016) and Brett Auerbach and Wil Jensen (August 1-7, 2022).

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE: Andy Thomas is batting .289 (13-for-45) over his last 12 games since May 15 with a homer, three doubles and 12 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .226. Thomas has picked up two hits in four-of-his-last-10 games played dating back to May 16 and has picked up three doubles in that same stretch. Last Friday at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson has base 17 times in his last eight games going back to the start of last week's series in Bowie. Last Tuesday, he went 1-for-4 with a two-run homer. He followed with a 2-for-5 performance last Wednesday and added a solo home run. Last Thursday night, Wilson went 0-for-1 but walked three times. He picked up three hits and a walk last Friday night. He went 3-for-5 on Wednesday night against the SeaWolves and had Richmond's only hit on Thursday. In his last eight games, Wilson is hitting .400 (12-for-30). Wilson is now ranked seventh in Flying Squirrels franchise history with 26 career homers.

PROSPECT WATCH: Seven of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including Hayden Birdsong (No. 6), Grant McCray (No. 10), Vaun Brown (No. 11), Eric Silva (No. 22), Adrián Sugastey (No. 25), Ryan Murphy (No. 28) and José Cruz (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), Victor Bericoto (No. 20), Sugastey (No. 24) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).
