FROM THE CROW'S NEST

POWER SURGE: Last night's win saw the Marauders match their season high with 18 runs scored home runs (last on May 9 against Fort Myers) while collecting 14 hits, two shy of matching their season-high (16 hits, also on May 9). Bradenton's .395 slugging percentage as a team ranks second in the Low-A Southeast, behind only Tampa's .454, which leads all 30 Low-A clubs. The Marauders have also homered five times in their last two games and rank third in the Low-A Southeast with 19 home runs.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES: Pirates #17 prospect **Jared Jones** turned in a spectacular professional debut on Tuesday, tossing three innings of scoreless relief. The 19-year-old from Whittier, Calif. Used his upper-90s fastball and hard slider to record six strikeouts while limiting Palm Beach to two hits. Jones threw 48 pitches (29 strikes) and retired five in a row to conclude his outing. The right-hander joins **Parker Brahm** and **Logan Hofmann** among Marauders rookies to throw multiple innings of scoreless relief in their professional debuts this season.

ALL HANDS ON DECK: Eleven of the 13 position players on the Marauders' active roster have already recorded two or more multi-hit games this season. The only exceptions, **Yoyner Fajardo** and **Blake Sabol**, have played in just two games for the Marauders. **Endy Rodriguez** leads the team with six multi-hit games.

THE STREAK CONTINUES: **Maikol Escotto** currently owns the longest on-base streak (15 games) among Marauders hitters and has hit safely in 12 of his 15 games. The 18-year-old Dominican Republic native is batting .346 (18-for-52) with 15 RBI over his first 15 games.

THE OPPONENT: The Palm Beach Cardinals are tied with Dunedin for the worst record in the Low-A Southeast at 6-13. The team has lost six of its last seven games, and have won back-to-back games just once this season (May 12-13 vs Jupiter). Palm Beach also owns the league's worst run differential at -50 (81 runs scored, 131 allowed).

HEAD-TO-HEAD: This series marks the first inter-divisional matchup for both teams this season. In 2019, the Marauders went 6-7 against Palm Beach, losing the first two series matchups before taking the final head-to-head series in August, three games to one. This series is also the only meeting between Bradenton and Palm Beach in 2021.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently boasts seven prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the organization: **Hudson Head** (#6), **Eddy Yean** (#13), **Jared Jones** (#17), **Sammy Siani** (#19), **Nick Garcia** (#21), **Endy Rodriguez** (#27), and **Alexander Mojica** (#30). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: **Santiago Florez** tossed five scoreless and hitless innings as the Marauders' piggyback starter last night, striking out seven (matches season-high by any Bradenton pitcher)... **Hudson Head** has a nine-game on-base streak and is batting .385 (5-for-13) over his last four games, including two home runs... **Sergio Campana** drew four walks last night, becoming the first Marauder to do so since Alfredo Reyes on June 4, 2018 against Florida.
